<p>1 AQUEDUCT RACE 4 (1:02 ET) 78 DEMOISEL-G2 250K, 1M 1/8 DIRT</p> <p>7 MOLTO BELLA 3-1 1 ENLIVEN 6-5 6 AFLEET DESTINY 15-1 4 POSITIVE SPIRIT 6-1</p> <p>PICK: 7 MOLTO BELLA (3-1) Might have bled in the debut as she took bit of action and got L1 next out. She has fired 3 straight times since then. Second to Baffert trained Mother Mother in the Rags to Riches last time out. Huge rider move to Castellano. Fast workouts for Wilkes at Skylight Training.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 AFLEET DESTINY (15-1) Just a 35k purchase earlier this year and she has already won more than that amount. 3rd in a key race two back. The top two also won back next (allw and MSW). She's had excuses (altered course, clipped heels, sloppy track and bled). Picks up a superstar rider for this.</p> <p>A) 1,7 B) 3,4,6 C) 2,5</p>	<p>2 AQUEDUCT RACE 6 (2:06 ET) 74 GO FOR WAND-G3 250K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 MARLEY'S FREEDOM 1-1 8 PACIFIC WIND 6-1 2 BROWSE 15-1 5 YOUR LOVE 4-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 MARLEY'S FREEDOM (1-1) She was one of the lowest priced favs on the Breeders' Cup two-day card. She was a game 4th beaten less than a length despite getting the 13 post. All 4 of prior wins would be good enough to win this. Smith retains the mount today. Looks tough in this spot from the rail.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 BROWSE (15-1) It looks like sprinting is going to be her best distance. Drew the rail in back to back starts and outran her odds in both. Got off slowly in last but came with a strong late run. There is going to be a fast pace and she could get the run of the race from far back. Ortiz back up.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 2,4,5,8 C) 3,7</p>	<p>3 AQUEDUCT RACE 8 (3:12 ET) 81 REMSEN-G2 250K, 1M 1/8 DIRT</p> <p>6 MAXIMUS MISCHIEF 6-5 1 JUNGLE WARRIOR 8-1 5 NETWORK EFFECT 7-5 3 BOURBON WAR 5-1</p> <p>PICK: 6 MAXIMUS MISCHIEF (6-5) Of all the 1st timers this trainer has sent out the 94 Beyer this one got is 16 points higher than his second fastest. There has been big buzz about the talent this one has. The place runner in last returned to run 2nd in a 100k AQU stakes next. Distance the only question.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 JUNGLE WARRIOR (8-1) Dam was a multiple stakes winner on dirt for Michael Husion. She won the G2 Frichte with a 101 Beyer at LRL on dirt. Moves to a higher strike rate trainer, James Jerkens, for the 1st time here. 4th in last returned to win back to back 225k WO stakes. Huge workout pattern.</p> <p>A) 6 B) 1,5 C) 3</p>	<p>4 AQUEDUCT RACE 9 (3:45 ET) 69 CIGAR MILE-G1 750K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 MENDELSSOHN 2-1 2 SUNNY RIDGE 9-2 5 COPPER TOWN 5-2 7 TIMELINE 10-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 MENDELSSOHN (2-1) Been a long and winding road since he took the G2 UAE Derby in track record time. Been in three straight G1 races and really outran his odds in all of them. Big try in the Classic after setting a fast early pace. Won't get any breathers early but class pulls him through.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 SUNNY RIDGE (9-2) Broke the 100 Beyer mark in 2 of last 3 starts for this high percentage Servis outfit. There should be a fast early pace and that would play right into the hands of this closer. Was not able to run down the wire to wire winner in the Kelso but pace here is more favorable.</p> <p>A) 1,2,5 B) 7,8 C) 3,6</p>
<p>5 GULFSTREAM PARK RACE 11 (5:06 ET) 64 CC JEWEL 200K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>8 CHRIS AND DAVE 8-1 6 AZTEC SENSE 2-1 5 RACE ME HOME 9-2 1 RICH DADDY 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 8 CHRIS AND DAVE (8-1) Was drilled by Aztec Sense in the 100k stakes four back but something obviously went bad in there. Won well in two of last three starts and only poor run was caused by a stumbled break. 4th and 6th from last won next in high claim races at AQU at odds. Gets a good trip.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 RICH DADDY (12-1) Game runner has hit the board in 38 of his 56 starts. He's compiled a superb record at GP. He's 9 for 21 on this dirt track and has run in the money in 16 of 21. Had to move early last time out because of the slow pace and track favored speed. The winner went wire to wire.</p> <p>A) 6,8 B) 1,5,7,14 C) 1,3,6,9,10</p>	<p>6 DEL MAR RACE 7 (6:30 PT) 64 HOLLYWOOD DERBY-G1 300K, 1M 1/8 TURF</p> <p>1 HAVE AT IT 6-1 4 RIVER BOYNE 5-2 6 RAGING BULL 7-2 12 PUBILIUS SYRUS 30-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 HAVE AT IT (6-1) Draws the rail for the 3rd straight race and 4th time in last 6 starts. He ran very well in all 3 rail starts. Was close to the fast pace last out in the G2 where he was a close 2nd to the fav River Boyne. Race devoid of speed so he'll sit in a great spot early. Cohen here for the ride.</p> <p>VALUE: 12 PUBILIUS SYRUS (30-1) Could turn out to be the speed of the speed. Sent into the fast pace in the G2 Twilight Dby in last and tired. All the speed stopped there. Showed talent last year with two stakes wins and another runner-up to Analyze It in the G3 DeMil. Really depends on how the pace goes.</p> <p>A) 1,4 B) 2,6,9,12 C) 3,7,8,10,11,13</p>	<p>7 GOLDEN GATE RACE 7 (6:45 ET) 65 GOLD RUSH 75K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>3 SPIN LIGHTNING 7-2 6 TIVAN 5-2 5 THE CREEP 5-1 2 SUENO 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 3 SPIN LIGHTNING (7-2) Show runner in debut returned to run a solid 3rd to talented stakes winner improbable in next start and then won a MSW at DMR by 9 after that. 6th from the DMR Fut won a stakes at SA and was 3rd in the G3 Bob Hope. Mullins has had success shipping to GG. Fast works.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 THE CREEP (5-1) Another shipper from So. Cal for this stakes. This one wired a starter allowance field two back and then tired late at 27-1 vs a stronger field on the grass. O'Neill won the last time he shipped one to Golden Gate. This one is a speedster that'll try to go wire to wire today.</p> <p>A) 3,6 B) 2,5 C) 1,4,8</p>	<p>8 DEL MAR RACE 8 (7:00 ET) 82 MSW 53K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>8 STRETFORD END 5-2 6 MY MANDATE 12-1 3 MUTINEER 20-1 9 MOONOVERTHEBAYOU 20-1</p> <p>PICK: 8 STRETFORD END (5-2) Loads of talent from this 600k purchase. He was 2nd to two Baffert runners in his 2 starts. Winner of debut took the 100k Street Sense at CD by 7 next (93 Beyer). Show runner won a MSW here by 9 last Saturday. Was 7 clear of the rest of the last field. Sitting on a big race.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 MUTINEER (20-1) Trainer is 3 for 5 (60%) with another running a close second (80% in the exacta) with 2nd time two-year olds with Bejarano up. Comes out of same race as top choice, 10 post was a disadvantage. Good to see Bejarano back. \$1.4M winner, Running Stag, is in the family.</p> <p>A) 8 B) 1,3,6,7,9 C) 2,4,5,10</p>
