<p>1 TAMPA BAY R7 (3:46 CT) 96 PELICAN 100K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>6 IMPERIAL HINT 2-5 1 SWEETONTHELADIES 6-1 3 TRICKS TO DOO 5-1 4 OLD TIME REVIVAL 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 IMPERIAL HINT</u> Superstar sprinter who has hit the board in back to back Breeders' Cup Sprints. Notice he used a Tampa Bay sprint to start his 2018 campaign and won for fun. Can go right out to the lead or sit just off. His works are fast. Will take something unforeseen to beat him.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 SWEETONTHELADIES</u> Always liked this runner and felt he's outrun his odds many times. Was third in the G1 A G Vanderbilt six back at 35-1 behind the main favorite here. Big run at 92-1 in the G3 at GP in the race before. He's a one run type who will be passing tired foes in the lane. Under.</p> <p>A) 6 B) 1,3 C) 2,4,5</p>	<p>2 LAUREL PARK R8 (3:17 CT) 61 GENERAL GEORGE-G3 250K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>3 UNCONTESTED 6-1 7 LAKI 6-1 6 STILL HAVING FUN 9-2 10 DO SHARE 15-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 UNCONTESTED</u> What a run in the wire to wire win at 16-1 in his last start. That was after a move to this new trainer who has won 4 of 17 overall in her career and 4 for last 13. While this race is normally tough on speed due to the fast pace, may not be so today. Wire to wire win.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 LAKI</u> 7 wins in 16 starts and is 7 for 11 over this Laurel surface. Was getting to the winner in last but just ran out of time. Think his style is more conducive to this longer distance. Trainer having a huge meet (29%) and this rider knows this one well. Presses up early.</p> <p>A) 3 B) 1,6,7,9,10 C) 2,4,8,11,12,13</p>	<p>3 LAUREL PARK R9 (3:50 CT) 53 BARBARA FRITCHIE-G3 250K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>2 LATE NIGHT POW WOW 7-2 8 MS LOCUST POINT 6-1 1 SPICED PERFECTION 3-1 4 DAWN THE DESTROYER 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 LATE NIGHT POW WOW</u> Hard not to like this one. She's won 10 of 11 in her career and the only loss was by just a half of a length. She crushed in both here at LRL. Just might be that good. Comes in with a 59 flat breezing move over this track a week ago. Will get the perfect trip again.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 MS LOCUST POINT</u> Won this race wire to wire last year with the same rider up. The fact that she was able to sit just off the pace and win in last and has a few other starts that were similar is going to give the rider options. Ran 2nd to the top choice 2 back but the track was off.</p> <p>A) 1,2,8 B) 4,7,9,10 C) 3,5,6,11</p>	<p>4 GULFSTREAM PARK R11 (4:12 CT) 69 ROYAL DELTA-G3 150K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>7 BLAMED 5-2 6 SILVER BAY 8-1 1 TEQUILITA 8-5 4 TULSA QUEEN 20-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 BLAMED</u> Really dominated the New Mexico circuit in 2017 and 2018. Moved to Mott and she ran a huge 2nd in the Raven Run. The winner came back to win the F&M BC Sprint at 26-1. The 6th place finisher Amy's Challenge returned to crush the American Beauty at OP with 96 fig.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 TULSA QUEEN</u> Could be a good use underneath in the tri or super. She's nibbled vs good company. The winner two and three back is really a good one for H Robertson (won 4 in-a-row). Gets on the dirt for the first time. Would benefit from a fast early pace. <p>5 OAKLAWN PARK R8 (4:38 CT) 52 DIXIE BELLE 100K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 ADVENTUROUS LADY 9-2 1 UNHOLY ALLIANCE 2-1 6 RAINTREE STARLET 6-1 7 SPICE IT UP 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 ADVENTUROUS LADY</u> Asmussen had her on a roll with three wins in a row and a tough second in the Zia race two back. Ran terribly in the common race last out but it can't be what her real talent is. Asmussen has worked her sharply since that race. Thinking we'll see her prior form.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 RAINTREE STARLET</u> Might have bled in the debut as she got L1 in her next start. In addition she didn't get out of the gate very well. Her 2 starts after have been superb. Gets tested for class in this spot. Has speed but showed she'll sit a trip, as well. Strong rider is up again today.</p> <p>A) 1,3,6 B) 5,7 C) 2,4</p>	<p>6 TURF PARADISE R7 (4:59 CT) 72 TURF PARADISE DERBY 50K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>1 SENOR FRIDAY 7-2 7 DR JOHN H 5-2 2 PRINCE PIERCE 5-1 3 TEQUILA COWBOY 20-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 SENOR FRIDAY</u> Dam is a half to \$1.7M winner Geri (winner of the 1996 G1 OP Handicap) and also the sib to \$1.5M winner A.P. Arrow (took 2007 G1 Clark at CD). Breeding suggests he will get better with distance (Sire is Curlin). Will be able to save ground on the inside. Career best here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 PRINCE PIERCE</u> Best runner in the female tree is Bedroom Blues (586k winner and 8 time route winner in the mid 1990's). Was game in defeat last time out and was crowded by the winner in late stages. Blazing works before last start and after. He'll follow the top choice home.</p> <p>A) 1,7 B) 2 C) 3,4,5,6,8</p>	<p>7 GOLDEN GATE R7 (5:54 CT) 72 EL CAMINO REAL 100K, 1M 1/8 DIRT</p> <p>7 EAGLE SONG 5-1 9 KINGLY 2-1 4 ANOTHER TWISTAFATE 5-2 12 MORE ICE 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 EAGLE SONG</u> Winner of two of his three starts on synth and those came vs 11 and 13 foes in Ireland in 2018. Off slow in the start two back but finished ok in what has to be deemed prep for later. Soft turf and slow pace along w/ 1st time blinkers in last. Nice placing here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 12 MORE ICE</u> Only one start off the turf and it came first time out when 3rd at 7-1. Thought she was a lot better in the last two starts after what was a bad start three back at SA. Really like the worktab for this, escalating distances here at GG. Will be finishing strongly today.</p> <p>A) 4,7,9,12 B) 2,5 C) 3,6,10,11</p>	<p>8 FAIR GROUNDS R12 (6:02 CT) 32 RISEN STAR-G2 400K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>10 LIMONITE 10-1 1 PLUS QUE PARFAIT 10-1 14 WAR OF WILL 5-2 3 MR. MONEY 12-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 10 LIMONITE</u> Asmussen colt has run well in all 3 starts. Neck behind the show finisher in G1 BC Juv Signalman in the debut. Drew the 12 post in the start 2 back and that likely cost him the win. Was motoring home last out when 3rd to Signalman in the Ky JC as a 21-1 chance.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 PLUS QUE PARFAIT</u> 4-1 second choice facing many of these in the LeComte. Drew the 11 post and lost all chance when he stumbled out of the gate and was very wide all the way. Beat a 30-1 upset winner of the Holy Bull in his maiden win.
