<p>1 TAMPA BAY R8 (3:45 ET) 41 CHALLENGER 100K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>5 BOURBON RESOLUTION 8-1 6 JAY'S WAY 3-1 3 KILLYBEGS CAPTAIN 9-2 1 FLAMEAWAY 3-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 BOURBON RESOLUTION</u> Was 6-1 in the Breeders' Futurity in the start four back. He ran poorly and was laid off for 6 months. Only ran twice in 2018 and was off another 8 months. Appears to have physical issues. Patient trainer had him ready to fire on return at GP. He'll get the run of the race.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 KILLYBEGS CAPTAIN</u> Going to try routing for the first time in here after he crushed the Pelican field including Imperial Hint. There is plenty of speed here but this one has been able to rate sprinting in the past and they might try that again in here. Rider is undefeated in 2 starts on him. A) 3,5,6 B) 1,2,4 C)</p>	<p>2 TAMPA BAY R9 (4:19 ET) 58 HILLSBOROUGH-G2 225K, 1M 1/8 TURF</p> <p>7 RYMSKA 5-2 8 ONTHEMOONAGAIN 7-2 2 HAWKSMOOR 3-1 4 NA PALI SPIRIT 20-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 RYMSKA</u> One of two in here for top turf trainer Chad Brown. This one was 1-5 in last but was 2nd to wire to wire winner Valedictorian. That runner set a dawdling pace and had much left to hold safe. She returned to run 2nd in a G3 at GP last week. Has won 6 of 12 starts.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 NA PALI SPIRIT</u> Won three back here at 12-1 with a strong late move and beat some in this race. Ran well in the two starts at GP since then. Got caught up in traffic two back and that may have cost her the win as she was beaten a neck in there. Dangerous with a fast pace. A) 7 B) 2,3,4,8 C) 6,9,10</p>	<p>3 TAMPA BAY R10 (4:50 ET) 61 FLORIDA OAKS-G3 200K, 1M 1/16 TURF</p> <p>10 STELLAR AGENT 4-1 2 MEGA FORTUNE 8-1 5 CONCRETE ROSE 7-2 1 LA FEVE 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 10 STELLAR AGENT</u> Upset winner of a MSW at Saratoga in debut back in August. Connections tried her in a G2 at Belmont next and she ran well. Huge 3rd in the BC Juv Fillies Turf behind a Brown superstar Newspaperofrecord. Made a bit of an early move at 72-1. Working very well.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 MEGA FORTUNE</u> Really put it together with the win on move to the grass last out. Blinkers and Landeros were new to that race, as well. Hit the gate at the start two back. Kimmel worked last Saturday on the grass and she was sharp in a 2nd of 52 drill. Eligible to go forward today. A) 1,2,5,10 B) 3,7,8 C) 4,9,11</p>	<p>4 TAMPA BAY R11 (5:25 ET) 81 TAMPA BAY DERBY-G2 400K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>4 DREAM MAKER 4-1 10 TACITUS 12-1 7 WIN WIN WIN 5-2 5 WELL DEFINED 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 DREAM MAKER</u> Two losses 2 and 3 back had some excuses. Green 3 back and had a lot of traffic when 12th as fav in G1 two back. Been favored in 3 of 4. Sib to G1 winner Dream Dancing. 3rd gen female tree includes Mecke (2.4M winner), Beautiful Pleasure (2.7M). Sharp workouts.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 10 TACITUS</u> Bill Mott/Juddmonte Farms colt hasn't been out since November when he won a MSW at AQU. He took a lot of money to go off at 3-5 there and won despite a 5 wide trip. Dam of this one was a champion in her day. This is an aggressive placing for a 3-year old debut. <p>5 AQUEDUCT R8 (4:06 ET) 72 TOM FOOL-G3 200K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>4 SYNDERGAARD 3-1 3 SKYLER'S SCRAMJET 8-5 2 DO SHARE 8-1 5 BAVARO 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 SYNDERGAARD</u> Ny-bred could have won his last 3 starts if not for back to back photo finish losses to Honor Up. Always had a lot of promise after he won his first two starts and was nosed out in the Champagne. Seems to be getting back into that form. Cuts back for this one.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 DO SHARE</u> 8 for 22 in his career and is 3 for 6 at AQU. Poor start in the G3 General George at LRL in last and then was very wide. He came on well to beat 10 runners in there. Also very wide two back. Was 2nd in this race last year at nearly 4-1. Will be passing runners late. A) 4 B) 2,3 C) 1,5,7</p>	<p>6 AQUEDUCT R9 (4:37 ET) 67 STYMIE 150K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>8 VINO ROSSO 7-2 2 SUNNY RIDGE 8-5 4 STAN THE MAN 5-2 5 TITLE READY 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 8 VINO ROSSO</u> Not a bad spot to make his 4YO debut. Was a player on the Triple Crown trail in '18. Won the Wood Memorial here (and his debut, as well) so he is 2 for 2 on this track. Pletcher is excellent with comebackers of this type. He should be closing fastest in the lane today.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 TITLE READY</u> Didn't break very well in the Jazil here back at the end of January and given the slowish type pace, he was going to have problems closing in late. Asmussen runner has been a nibbler vs decent runners. 3rd in the G3 Ohio Dby and 2nd in the G2 Discovery here at AQU. A) 2,8 B) 4,5,7 C) 1,3,6</p>	<p>7 AQUEDUCT R10 (5:09 ET) 74 GOTHAM-G3 300K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>6 INSTAGRAND 1-1 3 MIND CONTROL 9-2 2 KNICKS GO 12-1 7 NOT THAT BRADY 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 INSTAGRAND</u> Looked like one of the best 2YO's last year after he just dominated his foes in both of his starts in So.Cal. On the down side, didn't beat much in those starts (although 2nd in last did win the G2 San Vicente). Works are superb for the 1.2M purchase. Top rider up.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 MIND CONTROL</u> Has only one subpar finish and that came in the BC Juvenile after a troubled trip. He always looked best in the Jerome here last time out. Love the worktab for this. He has gone to the lead often but appears he may be able to rate. Velazquez is 2 for 2 on him. A) 3,6 B) 2,7 C) 1,4,5,8</p>	<p>8 AQUEDUCT R11 (5:40 ET) 60 BUSHER 250K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>12 ORRA MOOR 6-1 4 ENLIVEN 15-1 10 PLEASE FLATTER ME 3-1 3 OXY LADY 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 12 ORRA MOOR</u> Pletcher runner is two for two and basically unchallenged in both wins. Made a sharp 3 wide move in last and drew off. Outside 12 post could be difficult but good to have this rider aboard. Works have been strong over at Palm Beach. Should be a serious player.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 ENLIVEN</u> Dam a multiple G1 winner for McLaughlin and her sib, Enticed, did well on the Triple Crown trail last year (won G3 Gotham, 2nd in the G2 Wood). Had blinkers last out but are removed today. Always have to respect one working well before the race for this outfit. A) 4,10,12 B) 1,2,3 C) 5,7,11</p>
