<p><b>1 GULFSTREAM R8 (3:19 CT) 61</b> MSW 45K, 6F DIRT</p> <p><b>10 QUIZZICAL CAJUN 3-1</b> <b>14 BURLY BOY 15-1</b> <b>12 JAMAICAN 9-2</b> <b>3 GLORY OF FLORIDA 8-1</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 10 QUIZZICAL CAJUN</u> Moves to this ultra super trainer Servis for the first time here. He's won over 40% with a runner he's taking on for the 1<sup>st</sup> time. He gets one here who has been in the money in all four starts on the dirt and three of the four were with Beyers at 70+. Wire to wire.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 14 BURLY BOY</u> Interesting longshot here. Claimed in last for 75K by an outfit who has hit at 25% this year. Exits a key race. Winner came back to win and then run 2<sup>nd</sup> in back to back stakes races. Three others out of that race won in next start. Notice the blazing move on 4/8. A) 10,14 B) 2,3,12 C) 1,6,7,8,13</p>	<p><b>2 OAKLAWN PARK R7 (4:09 CT) 62</b> MSW 100K, 6F DIRT</p> <p><b>12 MALIBU MO 7-2</b> <b>5 BREAKING NEWS 5-2</b> <b>1 AROUND THE DIAL 12-1</b> <b>11 LOST IN LIMBO 12-1</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 12 MALIBU MO</u> Dam is half to the multiple stakes winning sprinter Cinco Charlie. Cox has 3 wins and 7 in the exacta in his last 11 first timer MSW sprinters at OP. Gets a big name rider here for the first time. Been working very sharp. 2nd fastest work 3/30 (Wonder Gadot first).</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 AROUND THE DIAL</u> Robertson can be very good with first time starters mostly at Canterbury but is 1 for 6 with 3 in the money with a MSW debut here at OP. The win came in 2018 with Loveberry aboard. Robertson works slowly but these drills are fast. 100k purse says confidence. A) 1,5,12 B) 2,11 C) 4,8</p>	<p><b>3 AQUEDUCT R8 (4:21 CT) 67</b> TOP FLIGHT 200K, 1M 1/8 DIRT</p> <p><b>4 FROSTIE ANNE 5-2</b> <b>3 JUMP RULER 9-2</b> <b>6 FOREVER LIESL 2-1</b> <b>1 MIDNIGHT DISGUISE 6-1</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 4 FROSTIE ANNE</u> There are really two speed runners in this race. This 6YO mare and the one inside of her. Think they'll allow this one to make all of the pace in here. This rider is two for two on her and both were crushing wire to wire wins. 15-time winner six wins on this track.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 JUMP RULER</u> Really holds the key to this race. If they end up sending her to the lead it will take a toll on the top choice and neither of these will hit the board. If they allow her to track just as she has of late, these two will likely run one-two. Trainer is at 39% for 2017 season. A) 3,4,6 B) 1 C) 2,5</p>	<p><b>4 SANTA ANITA R4 (4:39 CT) 79</b> MSW 55K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p><b>7 ONE EIGHTY 3-1</b> <b>3 DUCHAMP 4-1</b> <b>1 GRIT AND CURIOSITY 5-2</b> <b>4 ALWAYS FORGIVEN 8-1</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 7 ONE EIGHTY</u> First time starter cost \$300,000 roughly 13 months ago. Has speed bred into the blood on both sides of the tree (Distorted Humor and Speightstown). O'Neill 3 for 11 with first timers in MSW sprint on dirt for this owner. Stayed w/ G1 winner Pavel in a recent drill.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 DUCHAMP</u> Came running on well after a slow start in the debut, the same race where the horse on the rail ran 2<sup>nd</sup>. Trainer Shirreffs has had a big meet. Dam won 440k for these same connections (won the G1 Santa Margarita in 2005 here going long). Major win player. A) 1,3,7 B) 2,4 C) 5,6</p>
<p><b>5 HAWTHORNE R5 (5:02 CT) 65</b> OPT CLM 20K, 1M TURF</p> <p><b>5 BIG DINNER 9-2</b> <b>7 ANTRIM'S GIANT 3-1</b> <b>2 SAILING SOLO 5-1</b> <b>1 PURELY BOY 4-1</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 5 BIG DINNER</u> Trainer has won 4 of 6 here this meet. This one is 3 for 10 on the grass with two of the wins on this turf. Likely ships out of OP due to the lack of a turf course there. Gets his regular rider back for this. Has been going much longer. Will be running on in the lane.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 SAILING SOLO</u> Lightly race 4YO colt hasn't been on the turf since the first two starts when he was with Bill Mott. The dam won 3 straight Grade 1's on the grass for Mott. This is deep breeding for the turf on both sides of the tree. He's looked like a different colt for this trainer. A) 5,7 B) 1,2,3 C) 4,6</p>	<p><b>6 FONNER PARK R9 (5:22 CT) 66</b> MIZDIRECTION 75K, 5F TURF</p> <p><b>7 AWESOME EMMIT 7-2</b> <b>2 SENATOR ROBERT 12-1</b> <b>4 LADDIE BOY 10-1</b> <b>6 SMARTY PARTY PAPA 9-2</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 7 AWESOME EMMIT</u> Trainer had this one for 2 starts at CBY last summer and won this both. Had a difficult trip in the Tondi when he drew a wide post and was wide the entire way. Was a bit rank in the lane but once straightened he was really getting to the winner. Right distance.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 SENATOR ROBERT</u> 6YO used to route in So Cal and Louisiana but has been running short of late here in Nebraska. Beat a nice sprinter in his most recent start. That runner-up was the main speed and needed to be run down. He was 10 clear of third. Will get a great trip today. A) 2,7 B) 1,4,6,8,9 C) 3,5</p>	<p><b>7 KEENELAND R11 (5:45 CT) 51</b> MSW 79K, 6F DIRT</p> <p><b>9 UNSHAKEN 9-2</b> <b>12 FLAME ZAPPER 9-2</b> <b>6 PERLMAN 7-2</b> <b>11 HOMETOWN SALUTE 6-1</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 9 UNSHAKEN</u> Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin has won 2 of 9 with a 1st timer in MSW sprinting on dirt for this ownership. The last 4 have run 1<sup>st</sup> (6-1 odds), 2<sup>nd</sup> (6-1 odds), 2<sup>nd</sup> (5-1 odds) and 3<sup>rd</sup> (8-1 odds). Dam won 4 of 8, was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the G1 BC Juv Fillies and a 2x G1 winner on the dirt.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 12 FLAME ZAPPER</u> Might actually have a career on turf. There is a 5x G1 turf winner from England deep in the female family. Casse hasn't had a good start to this meet but has done well overall with first timers on dirt sprinting. Love his worktab here. He'll stalk from the 12 post. A) 6,9,12 B) 2,4,11 C) 3,5,8</p>	<p><b>8 GOLDEN GATE R7 (6:00 CT) 39</b> MSW 30K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p><b>5 HURLEY 8-1</b> <b>7 ABLE TO SMILE 5-1</b> <b>4 ILLAPAWNIE 9-2</b> <b>3 SUGARCHARGED 20-1</b></p> <p><u>PICK: 5 HURLEY</u> Trainer is 8 for 14 (57%) with a runner he's taking over for the first time. She was with better company in So Cal for Eric Kruljac in the four starts as a two-year old. Love this work pattern coming in here for this 110k '17 purchase. Think she'll fire off the shelf.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 ABLE TO SMILE</u> Might be better with distance as her 2 sibs were G1 routers (House Rules and Win the Space). Has been working for quite a while for this debut. She is a 385k purchase and with a trainer hitting at 22% here. He's a bit above avg with firsters. Check the betting. A) 5,7 B) 3,4,6,8,9 C) 1,2,10,11</p>
