VALUE: 1 LAUGHABLE Other Pletcher is a first timer and he has 2 wins and 7 in the money with a first time router on turf in MSW here at SAR from 18 starters. He was 2nd in his last 2 at this meet. VALUE: 10 SLAM DUNK Took an awful lot of money to go off a favorite over the Chad Brown 1st time starter, and winner. Got away slowly and never recovered. Picks up a top rider for second start. Will see more. Made bit of a run for 4th in last at 9-2. Trainer is normally much better when a young horse has a few runs under their belt. VALUE: 1 TURFMEISTER Trainer only one turf router for a 2YO in debut and that was a few years ago as this is just not his game. The works are good and long for a trainer who is one to work them slowly. Check tote. VALUE: 2 LIBERATE Competition just wasn't there for him in the Ohio-bred division as he won 3 times by many lengths. This is a step up in class but figures players will see he towers over these. He looks too good. VALUE: 7 DROP OF GOLDEN SUN He's outrun his odds in 6 of his last 7 starts with four wins at long odds this meet. Rider has 4 wins here and all 4 were aboard this one. Cuts back here after routing which is a strong angle. VALUE: 7 SHIPPY Sold privately after the 11 length win in the debut at LRL. Owners gave her to Doug O'Neill only to watch him win the G3 last out with his other filly. She gets new trainer here.
