VALUE: 9 SECRET RULES
 Mott has won 3 times here this meet with a 2YO debut sprinting on the dirt after going winless the previous 4 yrs that angle. Bred to sprint with Secret Circle & Peace Rules in this pedigree.

 Career high Beyer in last when 4th as an 11-1 chance. The winner was also a Casse runner who won 760k. 2nd, 3rd were Brown G1 types, the 1st and 2nd choices. Last win came from the rail.

 Female tree produced strong turfurs, Bev Bev and Ajdal (7 for 10 on the turf in England 2 G1's). Cox won with 2 of 3 debut 2YO route turfurs at this meet. Rider at 35% for Brad Cox in last year.
