<p>1st BELMONT R8 (4:43 ET) 64 GRAND PRIX INV 300,000, 1M 1/2 DIRT</p> <p>4 REALM 6-1 8 ROCKETRY 5-2 7 MARCONI 2-1 3 ROAMING UNION 15-1</p> <p>PICK: 4 REALM He has just one win over this track in 13 starts but earned over 200k. Of the 4 in here who ran in the Suburban, he ran the best. Notice Alvarado was up for back to back wins a year ago. Fits in here with these. He will be a nice price.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 ROCKETRY Ran on at even money in last for 3rd in a underwhelming performance. The top two just went slow enough to lull them to sleep. Blinkers on two back and they came right off afterwards. Winner a serious French filly. She gets her regular rider in for this. Trainer 2nd and 3rd here at BEL with a similar French runner '17, '18 in big turf events.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 DYNA PASSER Closer might have been too far off early pace in the last two starts. They went a very slow early part of the race in the G1 Belmont Oaks two back and it cost her a better chance. Third from there came back to win the G1 Del Mar Oaks at 6-5.</p> <p>A) 1,6 B) 3,5,7,8 C) 2,4</p>	<p>3rd KENTUCKY DOWNS R8 (5:28 ET) 74 LADIES TURF-G3 500,000, 1M TURF</p> <p>2 SIMPLY BREATHLESS 5-1 7 MITCHELL ROAD 5-2 5 STORM THE HILL 3-1 8 VIVA VEGAS 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 SIMPLY BREATHLESS Really think the win in the G3 Wilshire 2 back at Santa Anita was a big run. 2nd in the race came back to upset in the G1 Clement Hersch at 4-1 and had been 2nd a neck in G1 DMR Oaks year ago. Winner in last nosed out by Vasilika week ago.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 VIVA VEGAS Winner of a 100k stakes at Indiana last time out but hasn't been seen in about 6 weeks. A G2 winner on the Ky Derby undercard in the American Turf. Wide trip two back in the G1 Belmont Derby. Better trip today.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 HENLEY'S JOY Hasn't really been in the best post draw in many of his recent turf races. Had a tough inside post in last and was trying to run down the lonely speed. Upset in the G1 win two back on this track when game to wire. Needs pace to work with.</p> <p>A) 8,9 B) 1,2,3 C) 4,5,6,7</p>
<p>5th LOUISIANA DOWNS R11 (6:07 ET) 71 SUPER DERBY-G3 300,000, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>1 ROTATION 3-1 8 KNICKS GO 9-5 4 VANGLIDER 8-1 9 LEADER OF MEN 6-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 ROTATION One of Asmussen's second tier runners was the 3-2 second choice in his most recent start, a prep for this, but went down to his knees at start. Had a tough start 2 back. Will be saving ground from inside. Report says worked well for this.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 VANGLIDER Two wins in three starts for Asmussen. Both wins came on the dirt and the loss was on turf. Not sure if he isn't a slight cut below these but he'll get the run of the race in here behind a very fast early pace. He was a 6-5 favorite and rolled over a main foe here, Peruvian Boy. Was 3-5 at Colonial last time out but weakened. The winner came back to run 2nd in a 100k stakes on turf next out for trainer Jamie Ness.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 FLAP JACK Winner of last split the field in a 300k at Kentucky Downs at 30-1 in his next out. This one was game in defeat on the turf here. The debut was ok after he broke out poorly and was 6 wide. Nice work at KEE on Aug 25. He's been fantastic for these connections since (won the G1 United Nations). 2 for last 4 starts vs similar. A sharp 2nd in this last year at 5-1. Rested.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 HELLO DON JULIO There is no way last time out was a true representation of his ability. Was quick early but came to a walk at 5-2 odds at Ellis Park. Hill was aboard for the win 4 back at Laurel in a similar spot. Has the best speed. May be allowed alone early.</p> <p>A) 5,9,10 B) 2,6,8,11 C) 3,7,12</p>	<p>8th GULFSTREAM R12 (6:39 ET) 66 MSW 60,000, 5F TURF</p> <p>9 NORMA'S LOVE 2-1 7 SONG RIVER 7-2 5 ELUSIVE MOLLY 4-1 2 DOMINEER 3-1</p> <p>PICK: 9 NORMA'S LOVE First time starter for Navarro and debut on the grass really isn't his thing. He's 0 for 6 with 0 in the money with a 1st time starter on grass. But there is quite a bit of turf in the pedigree and he's working well. Navarro is at 28% with this owner.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 ELUSIVE MOLLY One of two runners in here for M Casse. This is a 110k purchase back in Nov '17. The works have been decent and she's been on the grass twice. Casse winning at 24% with this rider. Bred to like both surfaces. Not much to beat in this race.</p> <p>A) 7,9 B) 2,5 C) 1,6</p>
