That winner is now 4 for 5 with the loss coming in the G1 BC Juv Fillies Turf. Likely moves forward off the comeback race. Didn't care for drifting in and out and run down easily in last start.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 CHOCOLATE KISSES</p> <p>Dam was G1 placed on dirt behind Zenyatta but won her only graded stakes on turf in a career that saw her take 6 of 14 on the sod. Split the field in the G1 Ky Oaks in last start at CD. Strong move at CD on the dirt since that race. This rider has been on fire lately.</p> <p>A) 3 B) 4,5 C) 1,6</p>	<p>4 BELMONT PARK (4:38 ET) 47 MSW 90K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>1 LIZA JAMBALAYA 5-1 9 DALEELATY 12-1 3 MY HAPPY PLACE 8-1 5 STIFLE YOURSELF 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 LIZA JAMBALAYA</p> <p>Firster for Rodriguez who is 3 for 5 with a debut 3YO or older on dirt at a distance of 6.5 to 7F and in NY. Winners all had very slow drills. Sib to two G1 sprinters. One of them, Dad's Caps trained by Rodriguez and won in his debut for fun with similarly slow works.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 DALEELATY</p> <p>These connections (trainer/owner) had the sire, Daaher, a G1 winning miler in NY about a dozen years ago. McLaughlin hits at 17% with a debut runner on dirt in NY sprinting. He normally works them slow. Sib to New Money Honey, won her 2nd start. She won the BC Juv Fillies Turf. Winner of debut wired in a slow pace. This filly tried to close into that pace.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 DATING GAME</p> <p>Pretty big pedigree with the dam being half to \$2M winner, Commentator. Also deeper in the female family is Hot Novel, the dam of \$3M winner Behrens. Might not want the off track or sprint and today she goes long on new surface. Third came over on him in the lane and forced him to clip heels. He re-rallied and was getting to winner (who was 2nd in the '18 G1 Malibu behind McKinzie). Half to 770k winner, Vertical Oak. Top level connections.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 HERSH</p> <p>Ran a strong second to the top choice in his debut. He had run, slowed due a line of four in front of him, waited and then ran on well late. He gamed out a second place finish in there over two others. Huge him in 2nd start at Saratoga. She beat 7 foes rather easily at 3-1. She won by nearly 10 lengths and the runner-up was another 3 in front of third. Casse has had success w/ second time two-year olds who won in their first start and into stakes. A 220k purchase.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 DIXIE MO</p> <p>Also entered in the Tremont on Friday here. Won in the debut over an overmatched field at Indiana Grand. She was 1-5 and had zero trouble. She won by 4 and the one who ran 2nd was nearly 6 clear of third. Rider has a 43% win rate for Ward. Most recent start was moved to dirt. That can be tossed. Steadied on a soft turf going 1M 1/8 at SAR. Another toss. Her starts prior to that are good enough to win this. Working nicely for this and keeps 30% Ortiz for Brown here.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 RAVEN'S LADY</p> <p>Rather poor run in the G2 on the Kentucky Derby undercard. That was following a very decent effort behind superstar Vasilika two back. Notice she beat multiple Group 3 filly Pretty Baby five starts back and she rolled over on Binti Al Nar by 13 lengths.
