Scale Weight. 3-year-olds with an entry fee of \$5,000 to pass the entry box and \$5,000 additional to start with \$500,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 12% to third and 6% to fourth. Colts and geldings, 126 lbs. Fillies, 121 lbs.

EASY GOER, in hand and well out in the track while close up racing into the first turn, remained within easy striking distance to the end of the backstretch, moved fast from the outside to take over approaching the stretch, drew clear under brisk left handed urging nearing midstretch, then continued to increase his advantage under a hand ride SUNDAY SILENCE, prominent into the backstretch while racing outside LE VOYAGEUR rallied to head that rival just before completing nine furlongs, was replaced by EASY GOER nearing the stretch and gained the place while swerving under pressure during the drive. LE VOYAGEUR sprinted clear racing to the first turn, remained well out from the rail while making the pace to the final turn, held on well to the top of the stretch and tired. AWE INSPIRING passed tired horses while racing wide. HAWKSTER moved well out in the track after entering the backstretch, continued wide thereafter and failed to be a serious factor. ROCK POINT, raced forwardly into the backstretch while between horses, held on well until near the end of the backstretch and gave way. IMBIBE was never close while saving ground much of the way. IRISH ACTOR was without speed. TRIPLE BUCK, a forward factor into the first turn while saving ground, remained close up for almost seven furlongs and tired badly. FIRE MAKER, widest into the first turn, was finished soon after entering the backstretch.
