<p>1 CANTERBURY R1 (12:50 CT) 84 MSW 30K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>2 WHATA SHOW OFF 5-2 1 ROCKNROLL ROCKET 2-1 3 INVASOR GOLD 10-1 4 FRIDLEY 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 WHATA SHOW OFF</u> Trainer is 3 for 9 (33%) with 8 in the money (89%) with a shipper to Canterbury Park for this owner. Dam was G1 placed at 7F and a stakes winner for Todd Pletcher (won over 400k). Ran 2nd to Harvey Wallbanger by just a half (that one took the G2 Holy Bull at GP).</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 INVASOR GOLD</u> One of two in here for Diodoro. Both were claimed but this one for just 20k meaning he could have started him for a tag. He has him protected. Key race in last. Runner-up won a md 50k claimer at CD on Friday at 5-1. 5th won a mdn clm 12k at LAD a week ago. A) 1,2 B) 3,4 C) 5,6</p>	<p>2 CANTERBURY R2 (1:20 CT) 67 MSW 29K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 NOVO AZUL 5-2 6 VIVACITAS 2-1 1 CHICKANELLA 12-1 4 MELODY ROSE 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 NOVO AZUL</u> Mac Robertson is 7 for 15 (47%) w/ 10 in the money (67%) with a MSW 1st timer for this ownership. He doesn't typically work them fast so the sub 1:01 move at OP is good. Might have a grass future. Medici Code ('07 DMR Derby turf winner) in the female tree.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 CHICKANELLA</u> Michael Biehler has 3 in here and his top 2 riders are on the first timers. This one and his other 1ster have been working together w/ similar results. His other 1ster (Melody Rose) is bred to route. This ones sire won a G1 sprinting (12 Malibu). Check the betting. A) 2 B) 1,4,6 C) 3,5</p>	<p>3 CANTERBURY R3 (1:50 CT) 60 CLM 5K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>3 PERFECT MOVEMENT 9-2 6 VANDERBILT BEACH 2-1 5 GENEROUS KITTEN 3-1 1 BLUE BOMBER 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 PERFECT MOVEMENT</u> Trainer just 1 for 67 (1%) with 5 in the top 3 (7%) at CBY with 22 straight losses here and only one on the board (this one ran 3rd here by a neck with Butler Sep 1st). Drop to the 5k tag makes sense after nibbling vs allw foes at Fonner. Butler was up for his last 3 wins.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 BLUE BOMBER</u> Diodoro trains and owns this one who last won 25 months ago when he took the 30k Wildcat Stakes at TUP. Since then he's only run once in a claiming race and it was last out vs. better 10k company at TUP. Moves to the dirt for the first time since 3rd start. A) 3,6 B) 1,5 C) 2,4</p>	<p>4 CANTERBURY R4 (2:20 CT) 77 OPT CLM 34K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>5 TAPSOLUTE 9-5 3 TOP OF THE PAGE 6-1 2 ON THE LAM 8-1 4 IZZY THE WARRIOR 8-5</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 TAPSOLUTE</u> Two of the main players in this race appear to be "need-the-lead" types that will set up this one nicely. Winner 2 back returned to win the G3 Excelsior (94 Beyer) and the 4th place finisher (Fight On) won the 150k Fifth Season at OP at 10-1 (93 Beyer). Late move.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 ON THE LAM</u> Was 73-1 in his last start at OP. He ran 7th in there but wasn't really disgraced beaten 7 lengths. Trainer is 4 for 4 on the board here at this meet and they all came in from OP. Only real chance is if the speed goes head to head early and slows up late in the lane. A) 5 B) 2,3,4 C) 1,6</p>
<p>5 CANTERBURY R5 (2:50 CT) 52 MDN CLM 40K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>2 BRANDY CHASER 7-2 1 FUNKY 2-1 4 HOLD THE SPICE 3-1 3 YEAH YEAH 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 BRANDY CHASER</u> Sib to Fireman Oscar winner of the 85k No. Lights Futurity in 2nd start (was 2nd by a half at 32-1 in debut). Trainer is 5 for 40 (13%) w/ a firster and 2 for 10 (20%) with a firster in a maiden claimer (one win here at CBY in 2015). Loveberry aboard and 1st time Lasix.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 HOLD THE SPICE</u> He's had just one start and it came here in MSW as a two-year old at the end of the '18 meet. He was 4 wide but plugged along for 4th beaten just two lengths. Cost just 6,000 so the move to 40,000 is realistic. One of 3 in here for Rhone. He figures in the exotics. A) 2,5 B) 1,6,7 C) 3,5</p>	<p>7 CANTERBURY R7 (3:50 CT) 24 OPT CLM 17K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>1 UNLEASH THE BEAST 6-1 4 MASTERFUL STRIDE 8-1 2 LONDON LEGACY 6-1 5 MAN U 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 UNLEASH THE BEAST</u> This kind of a race can be very difficult for a handicapper given how quickly the gain and lose form when they move from track to track or trainer to trainer. This one was with a 0% outfit before this 28% trainer got him 2 back. Similar tactics to last wins this.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 MASTERFUL STRIDE</u> Claimed from last for 10k and comes back into this at the same price. The trainer had a winner on opening weekend. That winner was bet down early and ended up winning at 6-1 odds with this rider up. Stumbled in the start two back. Will get pace to run into. A) 1,2,4,5 B) 3,6,8 C) 7</p>	<p>8 CANTERBURY R8 (4:20 CT) 55 CLM 10K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 WHY GOD 4-1 5 SPIRIT OF CALEDON 2-1 2 SPIRIT MISSION 9-2 6 FAMILIAR RHYTHM 3-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 WHY GOD</u> Shipper from Tampa won last out at 1-5 in a weak 8k claimer. He did it well when he came on wide to get up in time. The third place finisher won back at the same level by 3 lengths. There were 3 next out winners from the race previously. Seems a good fit.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 SPIRIT MISSION</u> Last win came wire to wire three back with this rider aboard. Last two starts were with much better at Turf Paradise and the drop in class should help. Only 3 runners to have run back (2nd, 4th, 7th) all ran in the exacta in their next starts. Trainer won at this meet. A) 1 B) 2,5 C) 3,4,6</p>
