<p>1st CANTERBURY PARK (6:10 CT) 57 CLAIMING 10K, 1 MILE DIRT</p> <p>6 HAMAZING VISION 5-2 1 ONE BET FROM EVEN 6-1 2 ROLLS ROYCE DEAL 8-5 3 LAST MINISTER 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 6 HAMAZING VISION Shipper from Oaklawn Park. Won for the 1st time four back when stretched out to over one mile. Faced too strong of company in the start three back. Third from the start 2 back won 15k at PRM next. 8th beaten 22 ran 2nd vs 8k at OP. Trainer/rider needing a win.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 ONE BET FROM EVEN This trainer can be hot or cold. This season he has yet to win with 22 starts. This one is coming from OP where he was facing much better following a claim for 12k three back. This is by far the weakest he's seen and the drop in class will help. A top rider is aboard. She dueling with the very speedy Ari Gia who went on to draw off from that field and then destroy the Lady Slipper field Saturday as the 9-5 favorite. 7th beaten 17 in that one came back to run 2nd by a head next at 25k.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 DUSTY PRINCESS She faced much better last year but those starts were on the grass. She does have a win on the dirt and her last dirt effort came against open 7500 claimers and she fanned 6 wide in there after a slow start. Could use the pace to be contested to set her up late. This one was on the dirt in most recent start and ran a big race. She was 3rd vs opt clm company at Turf Paradise when she took them most of the way on the front end. Winner of that has now won 3-in-a-row.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 HONOR'S PARADE This is off the turf here. This one is coming off a short break after nibbling vs a better company at Tampa. This trainer gets her back after having a strong season with her last year having won one year ago off the break with Eikleberry aboard. Will fly home. Winner of debut ran 2nd in KEE allw at 34-1 next. Runner-up won a turf MSW. Butler had other options in here but rides for Van Winkle which he isn't prone to do. Will stick with him on the main.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 WANNAPLAYBIGCHIEF High percentage connections in play today with this gelding. He ran a decent 4th in last start in a key race. The winner won in allw in next star rather easily at long odds. May be better on the grass but this isn't a tough group and moves forward 2nd off the break. A) 5,10,12 B) 3,7,9,11 C) 4,13</p>

This runner looks a standout on dirt after a starter allowance win at OP vs much, much better. Will likely get a perfect set-up tracking behind speed from Fonner. No business losing this race.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 SPIRE Another shipper from Oaklawn and this one was claimed last out from D Wayne Lukas. He ran 6th but was passing runners late. He was 8 behind the top choice two back but it was a race that was deeper than this. First time gelding, top notch rider. May surprise. The one claiming race he was in was three back and he won easily by 6 lengths wire to wire. Consider that the purse was 8,500. This purse here is 14,250.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 LOOTN AND SHOOTN This is not a reliable bunch and as the top choice and favorite is a big speedster with no guarantee he'll kick on, it could open up to one tracking and waiting as this one will. Won here at 7-1 last year with a stalking trip vs similar foes. He's 2 for 3 at this distance. This one tried the MSW company in last and flashed speed in the early going before tiring. Trainer is 6 for 13 (46%) MSW to maiden clm with Mn-bred.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 SHE'S NOT THE POPE She did pass a few runners in her 2nd start when 5 wide last year. Hard to tell how good the MSW race was that she comes out of as the top two were Michael Biehler first time starters. This one had a bit of traffic early in there. Deserves a glance on the class drop. While this one went out to early lead in last, it was more an attempt to try and steal it at 11-1. He's actually better just off the speed.
