<p>1 CANTERBURY PARK R1 (6:10 CT) 71 MDN CLM 10K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>5 SINK THE BISMARCK 8-1 4 RICHIE GARY 2-1 2 JIMBO'S BIZ 9-2 6 KAUN TE 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 SINK THE BISMARCK</u> One of a few shippers from OP and this one is a deep closer. That track was very much speed favoring throughout their meeting. Don't think the rail runner is right after the long layoff, pop and stop with front wraps and drop. This one will be finishing strong.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 JIMBO'S BIZ</u> Comes out of the same race as the top pick in last but this one hit the gate and never really got into the race. Depends on if this track is its normal speed bias or allowing deep closers to get there. Getting an extra half of furlong will be helpful for his charge.</p> <p>A) 4,5 B) 2,6 C) 3</p>	<p>2 CANTERBURY PARK R2 (6:39 CT) 62 MSW 35K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>5 SHEZ JUST CRUSIN 3-1 6 PATRIOTIC BEI BEI 4-1 3 TRENDY NEVE 5-1 7 CLEVER CRIMINAL 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 SHEZ JUST CRUSIN</u> Comes in off a long layoff for a trainer that wins a decent amount of these MSW's for Minnesota-breds. Last race was vs straight MSW and males, as well. Th winner is going to be big runner here this summer. She's a speedy type that should get good position.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 CLEVER CRIMINAL</u> This is not a great MSW even for Mn-bred's. This one was with a different trainer in '18 and did very little. This trainer is streaky at Canterbury Park. Notice the fast 5F work at TUP a few weeks ago. Think she'll be left off of most tickets. Might use her underneath.</p> <p>A) 5,6 B) 3,4,7 C) 1,2</p>	<p>3 CANTERBURY PARK R3 (7:08 CT) 64 ALLW 38K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>4 PINUP GIRL 9-2 3 HONEY'S SOX APPEAL 8-5 2 TA KELA WARNING 9-5 6 VIDIRA 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 PINUP GIRL</u> This distance might be a bit too sharp for this closer but she was really good last year at this level. She won 4 of 6 last year and 1 of the losses came on grass and her other loss was against open class company. She will be finishing well. Could use some pace.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 VIDIRA</u> Trainer Don Schnell has had a good year w/ his filly Escape Clause. This one ran poorly vs some of these in a stakes but ran well in her two next starts including a runner-up in the 50k Frances Genter. They set her up for this comeback spot. Will be a nice price.</p> <p>A) 3,4 B) 2,6 C) 1,5</p>	<p>2 CANTERBURY PARK R2 (7:37 CT) 55 MSW 35K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>7 ARNOLD'S PATSY 3-1 4 LILA'S LUCKY LADY 2-1 6 SHARON'S TEMPER 6-1 1 DIGGER HEELS IN 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 ARNOLD'S PATSY</u> Rhone/Butler have teamed up for many of these Tampa to Canterbury shippers. They are particularly good with MSW Mn-breds who have had a start at Tampa. This one is going to show speed in here. 4YO bred well should be tough in here. A good post draw.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 SHARON'S TEMPER</u> First time starter is very well bred for a Mn bred runner. Dam won 217k mostly going a bit longer. Schnell has hit the board in 22 of 37 (59%) with a first timer and has won 7 of those starts (19%). Both of his first timers who have run at Canterbury have run well.</p> <p>A) 4,8 B) 2,3 C) 6,7</p>
<p>5 CANTERBURY PARK R5 (8:06 CT) 68 MSW 35K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>5 GIVING TREE 2-1 6 ALOTTA SOUL 8-1 1 HIDDEN REWARD 7-2 4 GRAND PRIZE 3-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 GIVING TREE</u> Ran second in all three starts here in 2018. She was 2nd in the 100k Northern Lights at 6-1 in her last start and beat 8 foes in that stakes. She is back with maidens for this and should be a big favorite. Has speed on this speed favoring track. Martin up today.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 ALOTTA SOUL</u> Trainer Francisco Bravo is 23% here at CBY with a first time starter sprinting in MSW on the dirt since 2015 (6 for 35). 3YO filly been working out at Will Rogers and has many decent drills. Bravo doesn't typically work them quickly. Butler up a clue she's ready.</p> <p>A) 3,5,6 B) 1,4 C) 2</p>	<p>6 CANTERBURY PARK R6 (8:35 CT) 74 CLM 5K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>2 ARCHIE 9-2 4 CANDY FOR THREE 5-2 1 BATTLE COLORS 4-1 6 LANGS LEGEND 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 ARCHIE</u> Banking on the race won by Family Code to be a key race as the top two choices come out of that OP race. The third place finisher won back for 6k at OP. Winner came back to run 2nd for 12k at OP. This one will be far back early and look to make a late charge.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 LANGS LEGEND</u> Ships in from Fonner Park where they were pretty weak this year. This one was at least facing starter allowance foes in the last 2. The last race was just a 4F race and he got away poorly and lost all chance. Run three back would be competitive with this group.</p> <p>A) 1,2,4 B) 6,7 C) 3,5,8,9</p>	<p>7 CANTERBURY PARK R7 (9:05 CT) 70 ALLW 37K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 MINNESOTA MIRACLE 5-1 9 JOBIM 2-1 7 NOTTE OSCURA 10-1 6 KELA BREW 15-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 MINNESOTA MIRACLE</u> Really think there is a big future here. He's hit the board in all three starts, all here at CBY as a 2YO. The winner of the two races he lost, Dame Plata, is a superstar who has won all 4 starts. This trainer works so slow just as he has been doing. He's ready here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 NOTTE OSCURA</u> All three top choices here are 3YO's. That is because the 3YO Mn-bred crop for males is very strong this year. This one cost 160k for a Mn-bred, something you just don't see. He won well in his debut, poor break in 2nd start behind Dame Plata. OP had the deepest fields and everywhere they've shipped they have been tough. This one faces very slow mdn claiming statebred company. She was not disgraced v far superior while in Arkansas.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 KATHLEEN V.</u> She's primarily been on the grass and has passed a few runners in many of her starts which is more than some in this race can say. Trainer has two in here and this one is more accomplished than the rail runner. Is not a good race and she could get a share.</p> <p>A) 4 B) 3 C) 1,2,5,6</p>
