<p>1 CANTERBURY PARK R1 (12:45 CT) 52 CLM 4K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 GLORIA'S ANGELO 9-2 6 VANDERBILT BEACH 3-1 2 COLONIAL POWER 5-2 4 PURPLE SKY 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 GLORIA'S ANGELO</u> Moved off the turf for the Arizona races in November and he's been pretty sharp out there. Has two wins and five in the money from his last six starts. Key race three back as the winner won again vs better. Others from that race fired coming back, as well.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 VANDERBILT BEACH</u> You have to pay particular attention to any runner shipping in from Oaklawn. The field quality there was the best in the entire US during the winter/spring. This one was 2nd the last time on this track and was beaten just 6 to superstar Mr. Jagermeister 5 back. A) 1,6 B) 2,4 C) 3,5</p>	<p>2 CANTERBURY PARK R2 (1:18 CT) 69 CLM 10K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>5 NOBUTZABOUTIT 6-1 1 ROLLS ROYCE DEAL 2-1 4 LAST MINISTER 9-2 6 CLIFDEN 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 NOBUTZABOUTIT</u> Shipper from FG hasn't been out since Mar when he was 4th as the 3-1 favorite. He did get bumped at the break and lost some of his early position. Late runner is on the dirt for the 2nd time. Ran and passed better at FG previously. Top level trainer Sharp here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 LAST MINISTER</u> Fonner shipper was up the track in his first start of the year and that came in a FON alw at 12-1. Bethke not known for having them ready for the comebackers so the 2nd time out should be better here. Winner from his last start won for the 5th time in a row next. A) 1,5 B) 4,6 C) 2,3</p>	<p>3 CANTERBURY PARK R3 (1:53 CT) 83 ALLW 38K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>5 HOT SHOT KID 2-1 3 DAME PLATA 5-2 6 FRIDAYNITESTAR 12-1 1 GOT EVEN SMARTER 9-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 HOT SHOT KID</u> Classy Mn-bred has won 7 of 21 and been in the exacta in 14 of the 21 starts (and all 9 at this track). Was in tough in the comeback at Keeneland but wasn't disgraced. Was 2nd a head and well clear of 3rd in the KEE start two back. Robertson won 2x opening night.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 FRIDAYNITESTAR</u> Another runner in here for Robertson and this one was claimed by this team just two back at Hawthorne specifically for the CBY season (as a Mn-bred). Has won 4 of 11 at this track. The last start was against 10k at OP and those runners can be quite decent. A) 3,5 B) 1,4,6 C) 2</p>	<p>4 CANTERBURY PARK R4 (2:27 CT) 81 ALLW 34K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>1 MISTER BANJOMAN 3-1 6 GOTTA GO 2-1 4 CINCO STAR 6-1 2 DYNA CAT 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 MISTER BANJOMAN</u> Don't see many Mn-breds sell for 200K but this one did and the investment looks like it is paying off. He won easily in the debut before giving undefeated Dame Plata a run three back. Runner-up two back is now G3 placed twice for Mott. Inside speed in here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 GOTTA GO</u> Ran 3rd in the Swale last year and he was on the Triple Crown trail for trainer Ian Wilkes. First time gelding and owner moves him to his second tier trainer for this. Tough trip 2 back but outran his odds for 4th. Will be the main danger to the top choice if he breaks. <p>5 CANTERBURY PARK R5 (3:02 CT) 74 MSW 35K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>2 BLUE ECLIPSE 7-2 5 GENERAL MILES 3-1 3 MINNESOTA LUCKY 2-1 6 MAS TAKELA 12-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 BLUE ECLIPSE</u> Thought the 2YO Mn-bred males last year were very good. This one was a decent 3rd in the MSW won by Dame Plata. He started running when it was all over but passed a lot of nice horses. 3rd again to a good Mac runner 2 back. Trainer won here on Friday.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 GENERAL MILES</u> Was right behind the top choice in the 2nd start here, beaten by that one less than 1 length. Faced open class MSW here 2 back and was 4th of 12, a very decent effort. With open 50k last out at OP and that is a strong class there. Might be the one to beat here. A) 2,3,5 B) 6,7 C) 1,4</p>	<p>6 CANTERBURY PARK R6 (3:38 CT) 46 MSW 35K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>7 SON OF POSEIDON 6-1 6 WANNAPLAYBIGCHIEF 4-1 4 DARE FELIX 3-1 2 WINTERS RUN 9-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 SON OF POSEIDON</u> Tough race with so many unknowns here. This closer was facing some good Mn-bred two year olds here last year. Improved on the class drop third start out. This trainer started the 2017 meet on fire winning with many that looked like this. Can upset this.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 WANNAPLAYBIG CHIEF</u> Diodoro runner makes his first start of the year and as a 4YO. The works at TUP have been pretty good and it's likely Diodoro has been waiting to run for the bigger Mn-bred purses. Improved start over start last year. Jock 32% riding for Diodoro in the last year. A) 4,6,7 B) 1,2 C) 3,5</p>	<p>7 CANTERBURY PARK R7 (4:13CT) 52 ALLW 37K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>9 PENNY FOR LUCK 4-1 7 READY TO RUNAWAY 12-1 6 ARI GIA 12-1 4 HELEN'SPHOTOFLASH 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 9 PENNY FOR LUCK</u> Nice win here last September when in for a 40k tag. The runner-up returned to win in a MSW here on Friday at 3-1 odds (won by 3.5 lengths with a 55 Beyer). Notice how she'd strung them out behind her. Nice effort vs 40k claiming field at OP. Has recency edge.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 READY TO RUNAWAY</u> Wire to wire win debut last August and the runner-up in the race was 8 clear of third. Rhone has a good record with Mn-breds in 2nd start after a win. His top call rider is up and they've won many together here over the years. Sharp works in prep for this one. A) 4,6,7,9 B) 1,8 C) 3,5,10,11</p>	<p>8 CANTERBURY PARK R8 (4:50 CT) 47 MDN CLM 15K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>4 COURTING MOONLIGHT 7-2 11 MAY WE ALL 4-1 8 A. J. LOVEMAKER 9-2 10 HUNKY MONKEY 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 COURTING MOONLIGHT</u> Deep closer has had two races out for this high percentage team of Butler and Rhone and he holds a recency edge in this one. Those runs at TAM were pretty strong when in with open class company. Bumped two back at the start. He'll be flying home late.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 A. J. LOVEMAKER</u> Hasn't been out since August but was with better company in his 5 starts so far. This trainer started the meet strongly with two in the money from two starts and one was a victory on opening night. Works are slow but that is how Biehler always works them.
