Additional also-rans fired next out.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 JAVACANDY Nothing wrong with her fifth place finish in the same key race the top choice exits. Got the 11 post in there with a low percentage rider but passed runners late. She was over 6 clear of the rail runner in here who came back to win. One to beat.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 SHABOOM Mn-bred has been on the turf 11 times but most have been at the 5F distance. The 7YO mare has some efforts vs open class which puts her in the discussion here. Winner 3rd in an open 20k claiming race at CD. 3rd was 2nd a neck 8k clm at PRM next start. Anything from OP is dangerous.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 ALTERED DREAM Was beaten by 6 to the one to her outside in the last start here. But that was on a muddy track and she got off a bit slow. One of the winners was a first off the claim 21-1 upsetter. Trainer is 6 for 19 (32%) with 11 in the money (58%) first off the claim and on this track. Late runner has outrun his odds often. Wide post challenge.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 GOLOSO Trainer has had 2 starters in a 16k claiming race here on turf. Both were shippers from PRM. One of them won at 6-1 and other ran 2nd at 4-1 (Beaten less than a length). In for a tag for the first time and picks up one of the best riders here. Trainer will heat up.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 HOLD THE SPICE Other one for trainer Rhone and this one is stretching out and draws the rail. Given the late running style of his other runner, it is possible he sends this one. Was favored in last but could only pass some late. Doesn't have much to beat here. He was pretty strong sprinting in Nebraska against the best they have there. Won the last time on this turf and Butler was aboard in 2 wins for this one. Saves ground tracking in third.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 MASTER GUNS First two starts on the turf were excellent (a win here with this rider up in debut and 2nd at KEE in an allowance at 30-1.
