This is a shipper from Louisiana where she was in with better. She typically comes from back of the field. Gets a strong pace to run into.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 DEVIL LADY Mn-bred is interesting in this spot and may actually be a good claim. She has only been on a fast dirt track 5 times. She lost her first two as a 2YO while passing runners late but was two photos from winning the other 3 of them. Had absolutely no chance as the winner, and front runner, went so slow early. 1st, 2nd and 3rd, were 1st, 4th, and 2nd in the early going. More honest pace here. The winner 2 back won an opt clm at TAM next.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 SWAYZE Dam is a sib to Awesome Gem, a winner of over 2.8M (170k on turf). Nothing wrong w/ he 3rd in a strong allowance in last when he was making his first start in 11 months and first for this ownership. Has enough talent on his backclass. Trainer has won 4 out of 15 starts (27%) and these are his primary owners. 2nd in last is a stablemate and she came back to win easily vs 10k in next start.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 WHERE'S MY LUTE Ran third in debut just a head out of the 2nd place spot when off as an entry at 8-1 when at EVD. One of the top trainers here claimed her from the last start where she ran last as a 5-1 chance. Diodoro 25% first off the claim so you'd expect improvement. There aren't many here that show speed so, with good gate rider up in here, Arrieta, he might be close early. He Has hit the board in 4 of 8 here and has two local wins. He has faced better at this meet.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 ARCHARCHMONARCH Mn-bred has a major win chance on a drop in class. Winner of last won on Saturday vs opt clm company here at a price. He didn't have a great trip in that race. He got tight in the early going and shuffled. Diodoro has 2 in here. Since the conditions don't consider races under a 5k tag, his win two back is not counted. Place horse in last was 7 clear of the rest. Might be the controlling speed. Same rider back.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 FIVE STAR CREEK Mn-bred faced open class last out at the 1M distance. He made an early move then tired in the lane a bit. Those with speed at routes cutting back to this 6.5F distance are pretty dangerous. 4x local winner is 3 for 5 at 6.5F. All turf in the backbreeding and he has run well on the surface (2nd three back in a strong MSW at TAM at 6-1). One to beat here.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 GOLDEN SCEPTOR He has had excuses in every start. Tough at the break in debut and ducked into the gap at TUP but got up for a solid 2nd. Ran on wet tracks 3 straight afterwards. Temple City is a decent turf influence. It was his first start since April and he flashed some speed before tiring. The runner-up had run 2nd last year in the Mystic Lake Derby at 42-1 and 2nd again 100k at AP at 7-1. Rider up both wins.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 SMOOTH STROKE Came off a year layoff vs a strong field and tired to 5th after making an early move as a 14-1 chance. 2nd and 3rd came back to run 2nd and 3rd again vs similar last week.
