<p>1st MSW 28K, 5.5F DIRT 82</p> <p>1ST 4 WINNING WALK 5-2 2ND 1 INSANE MACLEAN 9-2 3RD 2 DANCING AWESOME 3-1 4TH 3 DIXIE NATION 2-1</p> <p>PICK: 4 WINNING WALK Took action in debut as this trainer has been on fire with first timers. He's won 7 of his last 12 in debut (58%) and in the exacta 9x (75%). This filly will likely have a turf future. Sib is the \$2M turf winner Twilight Eclipse (ran 3rd in 2014 BC Turf).</p> <p>VALUE: 1 INSANE MACLEAN Would be surprised if this filly goes off at anywhere near the 9-2 morning line. She was 3rd in a MSW at KEE in her only dirt race. The winner came back to run 2nd in opt cl at OP at 10-1. Trainer 1 for 8 with layoffs on the dirt sprinting at CBY.</p> <p>A) 1,4 B) 2,3 C) 5,6</p>	<p>2nd CLM 25K, 1M 70 TURF 65</p> <p>1ST 7 ACCORDING TO ASPEN 5-2 2ND 4 STEAL THE THUNDER 7-2 3RD 1 LADY LANGFUHR 10-1 4TH 6 BLUES TOUCH 6-1</p> <p>PICK: 7 ACCORDING TO ASPEN Projects to go off favored in here after she was a close 4th in an allowance race that 2 others are out of. She clearly is a turfer and should be downgraded if the race was rained off. She has a couple of sibs who combined to win 300k on turf.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 LADY LANGFUHR She won in her first start off a layoff to start the 2019 campaign but has been bad since. She should love the grass as her sib, Ragged Edge, won 5 times over this grass course. Maybe drawing down inside instead of wide will wake her up.</p> <p>A) 4,7 B) 1,3,6 C) 2,5,9</p>	<p>3rd MDN CLM 40K, 1M 70 TURF 71</p> <p>1ST 2 TALENT AND TRICKS 9-2 2ND 7 HOLD THE SPICE 3-1 3RD 6 SAISON 7-2 4TH 10 SWEET SPRING 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 TALENT AND TRICKS Should love turf. He has a mare named Passing Mood in the female line. She is the dam of the \$2.8M turf winner, With Approval. Got shut off twice looking for a spot in midstretch in last costing him a better placing. Gets Loveberry today.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 SWEET SPRING Not sure he can win this as he's been a few lengths behind the main players in multiple starts. But he does seem to be improving with racing and does make up some ground in the lane. Would look for him on the bottom of a tri or super.</p> <p>A) 2,6,7 B) C) 3,4,5,8,10</p>	<p>4th CLM 16K, 7.5F TURF 42</p> <p>1ST 9 LINK 12-1 2ND 10 TREVORS CALL 7-2 3RD 2 SUPERIORS BOY 20-1 4TH 3 CHARLIE IRISH 20-1</p> <p>PICK: 9 LINK Trainer 11 for 21 (52%) w/ a returnee of 300 days off or more. He is 4 for 4 with that type of comebacker for this owner and he's won 7 of his last 10 overall with that angle. Dam was 6 for 10 in top 2 on grass (twice 2nd in the Princess Elaine).</p> <p>VALUE: 2 SUPERIORS BOY As of Saturday, Biehler had 1st or 2nd in 5 straight starts and 3 of those were at 6-1 or higher (2 wins). These connections took him from Mac Robertson and he's beaten just one runner in two starts since. Tried tougher company last start.</p> <p>A) 2,3,9,10 B) 1,7,8,12 C) 4,5,6</p>
<p>5th CLM 10K, 6.5F DIRT 53</p> <p>1ST 2 REIGNING WARRIOR 5-2 2ND 3 LUCKYNSUCCESSFUL 2-1 3RD 6 ON THE LAM 9-2 4TH 1 FORZE MAU 10-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 REIGNING WARRIOR This Minnesota-bred has run well here at Canterbury Park. He wants the extra half of a furlong as 6.5 furlongs is his best distance. Closed well while wide in last to just miss. Inside was the place to be so he was against that inner bias.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 ON THE LAM There is enough talent and backclass to win this but he hasn't been out for two months and was a stewards scratch on July 11th vs opt clm 15k company. He's come back with two works after being a stewards scratch. Can win if he's right.</p> <p>A) 2,3 B) 1,6 C) 4,5,7</p>	<p>6th CLM 5K, 1M DIRT 35</p> <p>1ST 1 DYNAMITE DAUGHTER 5-2 2ND 3 SHINE ON ME 10-1 3RD 4 HAMAZING HONOR 2-1 4TH 5 GIO'S LIL ANGEL 9-2</p> <p>PICK: 1 DYNAMITE DAUGHTERS Fairly obvious selection as she's beaten many of these already and importantly the runner-up effort 2 back came at the mile distance. She seems comfortable down on the inside as she's had either the 1 or 2 spot in the last 3. One to beat.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 SHINE ON ME Was 10 lengths off the top pick in race won by a Robertson Arlington shipper, Diva Banker. No obvious excuse for the poor effort by this one. She did take 30 tries to win her first race but has run in money 9 of 15 going this 1 mile journey.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 3,4,5 C) 6</p>	<p>7th ALLW 35K, 6F DIRT 79</p> <p>1ST 1 WILD MUNNY 9-5 2ND 5 IMA HARLEY TOO 5-2 3RD 6 DERBYS MONEYMAKER 4-1 4TH 4 NOTTE OSCURA 10-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 WILD MUNNY Her debut was one of the better efforts by a first timer all season. She was bet from 8-1 to even money. She was rank early but when the 2nd place finisher caught her, she spurted away. May not have wanted turf or routing in last two.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 DERBYS MONEYMAKER Lower percentage connections ensures an overlaid price here. He was 2nd three back at long odds and a repeat of that effort might win this. Off slow two back in a tougher race and ran well enough last time out for 3rd on the turf at 56-1.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 5,6 C) 2,3,4</p>	<p>8th CLM 7K, 6.5F DIRT 51</p> <p>1ST 6 CANDY WOMPUS 8-1 2ND 3 HOLD THAT THOUGHT 5-2 3RD 4 RAJAS APPEAL 7-2 4TH 2 MARCOS TRIBUTE 2-1</p> <p>PICK: 6 CANDY WOMPUS If we didn't see those last two starts, he would be going off at 2-5 in here. But we do see them and they are not good. He didn't like the rail two back and got off very poorly in last. Has run well enough to beat this field. Needs form reversal.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 HOLD THAT THOUGHT Faced much better company in 8 starts before they dropped him down to a low level and he ran off by 10 (but that was a poor field). Seems to be one the main speed and Hamilton might try for a wire to wire win here. Use him on all tickets.</p> <p>A) 3,6 B) 2,4 C) 5</p>
