1<sup>st</sup> QH STAKES 50K, 350 DIRT 79  
 1<sup>ST</sup> 9 BEEP BEEP ZOOM ZOOM 3-1  
 2<sup>ND</sup> 2 DIRT ROAD KING 6-1  
 3<sup>RD</sup> 5 WICKED 6 15-1  
 4<sup>TH</sup> 10 JESS A LIL CASH 9-2  
 PICK: 9 BEEP BEEP ZOOM ZOOM  
 Win in last is better than it looks. Inside wasn't the place to be but she broke well and was game late. 7 runners from two back start returned to run in the exacta.  
 VALUE: 1 DIRT ROAD KING  
 Dam was a three-time stakes winner at this track for the same ownership. Away slowly in last as a 2-1 fav. She did pass some with a late surge. A big rider move.

 PICK: 3 JESS DOIN TIME  
 8 of 12 in the exacta and 2 that were not in the top two were because of very bad breaks. Faced older in the last two. Third in last won a 39k stakes in the next start.  
 VALUE: 8 HOLY STORM  
 Split the field in the stakes last out at 9-1 odds with Goodwin. Beat some of these two back despite much trouble as a 9-5 fav. Rider is 3 for 3 in the money on him.

 4<sup>TH</sup> 5 CARRIAGE 4-1  
 PICK: 7 SHE B GLAMOROUS  
 Dam stakes placed on turf in '12 (won 3 of 6 on turf). Many in this female family were turfers (turf blood with Riverman in the female tree). 14-1 win in turf start.  
 VALUE: 8 DANGEROUS WAVE  
 Has some turf breeding in the pedigree and makes her first start on the grass in here. It also is her first time routing on a fast dirt track. Has a chance to jump up.

 1<sup>ST</sup> 3 RUSH HOUR TRAFFIC 5-2

 4<sup>TH</sup> 5 HOTASAPISTOL 6-1  
 PICK: 3 RUSH HOUR TRAFFIC  
 Was favored in debut but got off in a bad way and green throughout. Could barely be held back in last before crushing late. Sibling to the stakes winner Dame Plata.  
 VALUE: 5 HOTASAPISTOL  
 Was in the race won by Rush Hour Traffic but did nothing. Was bet early and in the pick 3 in last, signaling they knew there was something here. Use in the exotics.

 PICK: 2 BIG FALCON ROCKET  
 Did something last out which isn't seen much from 2YO's. Was game in coming back on the Robertson runner late while tight on the rail. Dam earned over 208k.  
 VALUE: 4 YOU SAY SO  
 Mn-bred (homebred) has a big pedigree. Sire won the Ky Derby. Sib to a G3 sprint type (who was 23 of 46 in the exacta in a sprint race) Jasizzle. Arrieta had options.

 PICK: 5 TO BE ROYAL  
 She's been in the money in 10 of 12 turf races, all here at CBY. She beat a decent group of open class 15k claimers here a year ago. Closed into slow pace last out.  
 VALUE: 8 DUSTY PRINCESS  
 Late runner was second to Gattia in last and that winner returned to take a race here on Saturday at 5-1. Bell, a long time leading rider here, has done well on her.

 4<sup>TH</sup> 4 REIGNING WARRIOR 8-1  
 PICK: 3 HOT SHOT KID  
 He's been a staple here with 9 wins from 13 starts over this track (only out of the top 2 once). 10 for 13 with 2 runner-up finishes with Mn-bred's. The one to beat.  
 VALUE: 1 FIREMAN OSCAR  
 Has run a couple of huge races at longer odds this meet. The other two were turf runs where he was in serious traffic. Has the ability to win this. Main threat to top.

 Robertson ships in from AP as the meet ends. He's looking to overtake Diodoro in the trainers standings. This one goes longer for the first time. He's bred for it.  
 VALUE: 2 WANNAPLAYBIGCHIEF  
 Won in his last two starts on the grass as the favorite in both. Gets a class test w/ these but looks like the turf is what he really likes. Regular rider is up. Late run.

<p>1<sup>ST</sup>: 1 MR. JAGERMEISTER                  Possibly the best Minnesota-bred of all-time. He's ripped up very strong open class stakes runners (like last time out at Colonial Downs). He has enough speed to get into the race if he needs to but can rate, as well. Is 6 for 7 over this dirt. Looks too good.</p> <p>2<sup>ND</sup>: 5 MISTER BANJOMAN                  Speedball cost 200k and that isn't a small amount for a Mn-bred. He is 5 for 7 on the dirt and 4 for 5 on a fast dirt track (only loss to Dame Plata in the Northern Lights here last year at 6-5). Dangerous if left alone up front as he has the best early speed here.</p> <p>3<sup>RD</sup>: 7 DROP OF GOLDEN SUN                  He's outrun his odds in 6 of his last 7 starts. Won four times at long odds at this meet and was 3<sup>rd</sup> to Hot Shot Kid in the Blairs Cove at 15-1 last out going long. Rider won 4 times, all on this one. He cuts back in distance in here after showing speed at a route.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 DROP OF GOLDEN SUN                  A) 1 B) 3,5,6,7 C) 4</p>	<p>1<sup>ST</sup>: 3 LAST MINISTER                  Comes in off a strong victory vs 25k open class company. 5<sup>th</sup> out of there won at 4-5 vs 16k next. Has run well on this turf (6 for 8 in the money on grass here) and he beat a main foe 3 back (Kela Brew). Perfect running style for how this race will shape up.</p> <p>2<sup>ND</sup>: 6 MINNESOTA LUCKY                  Thought he was very game in a wire to wire win two back over a runner who returned to win easily in a grass MSW next. 6<sup>th</sup> beaten 14 out of same race won a dirt MSW at 4-1 next time out. Pace just too fast in his last out. Think he sits more comfortable trip.</p> <p>3<sup>RD</sup>: 6 KELA BREW                  Forget his last start as he looks like the turf is what he wants. Blinkers come on for the first time for the second leading trainer here. If the pace develops he becomes a very big win candidate in the lane. Is 5 for 8 in the money over this turf course.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 HARRY THE HITMAN                  A) 3,4,6 B) 2,8 C) 1,7</p>	<p>1<sup>ST</sup>: 1 FIRSTMATE                  A lot of people were on her last time out as the 6-5 favorite (me included) but she was a flat, well-beaten, third in there. Have to assume she wants a first dirt track and the wet track in last cost her. Won two stakes here, including in her debut. Expect more.</p> <p>2<sup>ND</sup>: 5 READY TO RUNAWAY                  Quite a story as this one was taken out of a claiming race three back for 25k and has won two stakes races in a row for the new connections. Does get a stronger field than she saw in either of those stakes. Can win this but think she might be a bit overbet.</p> <p>3<sup>RD</sup>: 2 PINUP GIRL                  She's 8 for 16 on this dirt course but really hasn't been the same runner this year as she was in the past. May be due to the turf and muddy tracks she has seen at this meet. Last time she went long on a dirt track was a win in this in 2018. Will be flying late.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 DOUBLE BEE STING                  A) 1,5 B) 2,3,4 C) 6</p>	<p>1<sup>ST</sup>: 1 WILD MUNNY                  Only two dirt starts produced wide margin wins. She rated just a bit last out vs males and then drew away at 1-5 odds. There wasn't much in that race and she gets a serious test for class here but she is nicely bred for sprints. Can turn out to be any kind.</p> <p>2<sup>ND</sup>: 2 CLICKBAIT                  Just one start but it was a good one. She came into the maiden win after a 57.3 Hg work for a trainer who isn't normally working them that quickly. They come back on such a short rest that you have to think that race did not take much out of her. Nice odds.</p> <p>3<sup>RD</sup>: 5 ARI GIA                  Clearly the one to beat. She has won four times at the meet. The only two losses were three back in the Hoist Her Flag vs open class when she had a horrible trip and in last on a good track vs males when off slowly. She's awfully fast early. Beat her to score.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 CLICKBAIT                  A) 1,2,5 B) 4 C) 3</p>
