Has a good late kick and been in the top 2 in three straight coming from far back. It could be a fast enough pace to set him up in the lane. Strong rider back at CBY.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 FORZE MAU Trainer went a long time without a win at the meet but has won with 3 of last 7 starts (2 others in the money). Taking a drop in class for this and he has fired in starts vs much tougher company. Gets a top rider aboard. Might run by them. He came off the long break and ran evenly in the last 2F race here (July 25th). May not be what he once was but he is still a danger at this distance w/ clean break. If she is going to win one at this level, it would appear this is her best chance. She has the best speed in the race and draws the rail. Trainer has an eye on training title (sitting 2nd now).</p> <p>VALUE: 4 ALTERED DREAM Been right behind the top choice in last 3 starts. Only the last two were on a fast dirt track. In fact, she has been on wet surfaces or turf in 4 in a row before the last two. Good trip if another goes after the top choice. Big fig in mdn win at FG.
