One of those winners was a full sib to this one (Saint's Fan) had similar works and won at CD at 6-1 two years ago. He then won a stakes next out. Late run. <u>VALUE: 10 SUPER SIMPLE (8-5)</u> She's been competitive in every start but the turf run two back. Won three back at Saratoga but was DQ'd for action in deep stretch. Winner of last was 4th in the G1 Frizette at 3-5 next. 4th won a md clm 50K at Keeneland by 6 lengths. 2nd here twice. Was beaten just a neck to Flameaway in the Kittens Joy and that one won a G3 next and has proven to be a serious graded stakes type. Ran OK in his 1st start after moving from Pletcher. <u>VALUE: 10 FRED'STWIRLINCANDY (3-1)</u> Might end up with a perfect trip behind a few speed types to his inside. Showed a good amount of speed two back but that was because he was on the rail and rider wanted to hold his position. Finally gets off the rail. Won from 10 post previously. Trainer is about 11% with this kind of comebacker but has 2 wins with a returnee in MSW at CD. Winner 2 back won G2 Jim Dandy & third by 1 in G1 Preakness. <u>VALUE: 10 FLYING THE FLAG (3-1)</u> Was bet down to 4-5 in the debut at LRL 3 weeks ago. He hopped at the start but he made a strong move to get 2nd late. This trainer is 31% with second time starter in MSW after hitting the board in the debut (75% in the money). Big name rider is up. A) 1,7,10 B) 4,9 C) 2,3,6,8</p>	<p>8 CHURCHILL RACE 8 (4:36) 65 CLM 40K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>1 ICATIRO 4-1 5 KNIGHTS KEY 8-1 9 SHUT THE BOX 6-1 4 CONCORD FAST 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 ICATIRO (4-1)</u> Connections claimed this one for 40k one year ago. Notice his best effort for these connections came at this distance, here at CD with this rider up, when he won well four back. He was a reclaim for 62k back in June. Winner in last 3 for 4 for Pletcher. <u>VALUE: 5 KNIGHTS KEY (8-1)</u> Seems pretty honest for this level. He ran 2nd in back to back starts at this level this spring at OP and KEE. The next two starts weren't bad considering he was facing tougher. Last out winner ran 2nd and 3rd in G3, G2. Third ran 2nd in 175k stakes at 7-1. It's very clear that the rail runner will go right out to the lead. This one is likely to sit just off his flank and move to him on the far turn. Has shown speed and the ability to come from just in behind. 5 wins in last 5 starts. <u>VALUE: 3 HEARTWOOD (5-1)</u> Almost had him on top but think the pick will get the better trip. The rail runner is a bit too cheap and will fade. This one may be sitting third and would move up if the top choice goes after the rail runner from the start. Sen Byrd at MNR was a key race. A) 2,3 B) 4,7 C) 1,6</p>	<p>10 CHURCHILL RACE 10 (5:36) 39 CLM 30K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 SEAUXTALE 5-1 10 BEACH BUM 3-1 9 SOUL OF DISCRETION 6-1 4 HERE'S CARLOS 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 SEAUXTALE (1-1)</u> Can't be too hard on his last race. The :46 fraction set was the fastest 4F time of the day. The runners sitting 1,2,3 early ran 6,7 and 8 and the winner came from last. His win two back was quite impressive at SAR at 11-1. He broke from the rail in the win. <u>VALUE: 4 HERE'S CARLOS (1-1)</u> Always like to see a runner like this move up in class as opposed to those who drop into a race like this. Winner in last came back to win by 6 vs straight 20k claimers at KEE with an 86 Beyer. He hit the board in both starts at CD. Will come flying late. A) 2,9,10 B) 4,5,7,8,11 C) 1,6</p>
