 Desormeaux brothers team up here. 2nd in the debut after setting a fast pace. She was in front of a few of these in that start. They thought enough of her to try the Golden St Juv and she tired late. Bred all over for the grass. She worked quick before the stakes.

 Always have to pay attention to how a new unknown trainer does early in a meet. This trainer won the stakes on Friday but was a DQ to second with her only starter on that card. This one claimed for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time in a row in last. A repeat of that run wins easily.

 Did nothing in the debut but took no action and it was likely these connections had the turf in mind all along. The dam was all turf and was trained by Cassidy. Got a wide post in the turf try and ended up with a wide trip at 11-1. Nice close for 4<sup>th</sup>. Bullet work after.

VALUE: 4 LONDON LEGACY (5-1)  
 Shipper from Canterbury and Turf Paradise is dropping to the right level in here. He has 6 wins in 10 dirt starts this season and he's in the hands of a trainer that wins a lot. He was second to a stablemate in last and the winner been facing better. Won here in '15.

VALUE: 3 FASHION ISLAND (8-1)  
 New trainer sent out the winner of the 75k stakes on Friday before she was DQ'd to 2<sup>nd</sup> at 4-1. This one is a first timer who sold for 245k. There is a lot of turf in the pedigree and it's a good sign she gets Van Dyke here. If the trainer wins race prior note that here.

 Router cuts back in distance for this sprint. The last time she ran in a sprint was 5 back when she was second at 39-1. Doesn't face a thing in here and is back on the track she ran a career best effort. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> from two back won next out (25k, 12k and 8k). Upset.

PICK: 8 EQUAL MEASURE (7-2)  
 Second dam is a sib to Flute, '01 Kentucky Oaks winner, and earner of over \$1.1M. The sire won the Breeders' Cup Sprint. Clockers say she is working well enough and the 45k purchase price makes this 32k unveiling a good spot. Baze off outside runner for this.

VALUE: 7 LUCKY VAL (7-2)  
 Don't normally like runners like this but it's such a weak field and she is dropping here. Flipped and eased two back so there is an excuse there. Faced straight 25k 3YO's last out and this is a legit drop. Sharp work at SA on Oct 21. Should come rolling in here late.

VALUE: 5 EXTRODINARY JERRY (8-1)  
 Comes out of the same race as the top pick when he finished willingly at 9-1. Gets a big rider move to Smith who is up for first time. Only win came wire to wire but looking for Smith to take him back. Show finisher from maiden score won the G3 Peter Pan at Bel.

A) 1,6 B) 2,5 C) 3,4,7

VALUE: 4 PEPE TONO (6-1)  
 Was behind Shivermetimbers for a second time last out and really had no excuse not being a bit closer considering the fast pace he was closing into. Could see a quick pace in here again. Love the worktab since most recent start. Connections are high on him.

A) 5,7 B) 3,4 C) 1,6

VALUE: 2 OUT OF BALANCE (5-1)  
 Bred well for the turf. The dam won in her 2<sup>nd</sup> career start and that came on the grass prior to her taking multiple G1's. Debut was very good as she rolled in for 2<sup>nd</sup> at 17-1 w/ this rider aboard. The winner was 1st timer for Baltas who went wire to wire. Improves.
