Big run from the rail here back in Aug when 2 <sup>nd</sup> at 8-1 at this distance. The winner was a Sadler firster that returned to run 6 <sup>th</sup> by 7 in a mile stakes. O'Neill is 3 for 6 with a 3 <sup>rd</sup> for Reddam 2 <sup>nd</sup> time MSW starters sprinting on turf. Dam is a half to 600k turfer Lotus Pool.			The connections paid 255k for this one just 13 months ago but he's in for 50k in his 2 <sup>nd</sup> start. Think that Desormeaux is using that poor debut showing to gamble on the class drop here. Desormeaux is 2 for 2 in the last 3 months at DMR with a mdn claiming 2YO.			Miller had her entered in the Betty Grable stakes last weekend but opts for this spot instead. She's looking to be a nice claim for Miller. Only beat 4 runners in last and it was an off-the-turf group but earned a 94 Beyer in that start. Blinkers added 3 back is a key.			These are the same connections that had My Boy Jack (G3 winner) on the Triple Crown Trail this past spring. Obviously went a bit off a year ago as we haven't see this filly in the year since. Works are good at SLR and a 62k placing is fine as a 60k purchase price.

Sire was a four-time Group 1 winner on turf in Australia and England. Dam was a stakes winner but 0 for 2 on grass. Debut was very decent when 4 <sup>th</sup> beaten three in a common race won by Velvet Queen. Anything D Van Dyke on should be respected. Strong works.			Holds an experience edge with 5 races thus far and did run well going a mile last out at Santa Anita. The winner came back to win a strong opt cl 40k next. The 4 <sup>th</sup> place finisher came back to win mdn clm 50k at 20-1 next start. Machowsky has four works since last.			Connections claimed Skye Diamonds in '16 and saw her win multiple graded stakes in 16 starts for them. They also had 22-1 upset winner of the Let It Ride (Risky Proposition) last week. Runner-up in last ran 2 <sup>nd</sup> in 100k Betty Grable. 4 <sup>th</sup> won a handicap at 3-1 next.			Notice this filly was 6 <sup>th</sup> beaten five in same race that #6 Tig Tog was 7 <sup>th</sup> just behind her. Clearly had trouble in last when she was in a pulling gate and steadied early. Blinkers are coming off as it appears that was main culprit in her bad trip. Rider is sizzling now.

She closed in well for 2 <sup>nd</sup> at 5-1 with the new rider and the blinkers. 4 <sup>th</sup> from that race dropped to this same level (non-winners of two) and ran 2 <sup>nd</sup> at 9-1. Comes in with two decent workouts.			Proctor is 5 for 40 (13%) with a MSW sprinter on the turf in their debut. Two of those wins came with Stevens up. 2 <sup>nd</sup> dam is Get Lucky who is dam of 9x turf winner and G1 Man O'War champ, Imagining, for McGaughey. Clocker reports high on her local workouts.			Debut win back in April 2017 showed there is some talent here. Found a tough race 2 <sup>nd</sup> time out. The 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 7 <sup>th</sup> and 8 <sup>th</sup> place finishers in that race all came back to win next time out. Beaten by a stablemate last who came back to crush by 5 with a 96 Beyer vs better.			Tried older once and it was a disaster back in June. He was 8-1 and stopped badly. But he showed that was an aberration after he was 2 <sup>nd</sup> at 31-1 on this turf after. Didn't care for the rail in the start four back. Key race 2 back (place won the Let It Ride afterwards).

Not much in this race and this one was just a claim for 12k last out off a decent 3 <sup>rd</sup> vs a similar field at LRC. Rider has won 25% for this trainer. Claimed in Sep and has worked five times for Puype. Doesn't have to do too much more than she's done to win in here.			O'Neill is 0 for 4 with his recent MSW debut starters on turf. But all four of them ran 4 <sup>th</sup> or better (one was second back in Aug). The rider is 8 for 35 (23%) when he's aboard for Doug O'Neill. Breeding supports a try on the grass. Check the toteboard for more clues.			Must look past his most recent start as he broke very poorly, in the air, and well back of the field. Has been off since that race in April and comes back as a first time gelding for D'Amato, who excels with first geldings here in So. Cal. Like to see Talamo stay up.			Big closer will need some help up front for a pace that benefits his style. Was steadied twice in the last three starts. He overcame that trouble three back for a strong win but couldn't make up the trouble in last. Notice all the trouble he's had earlier in his career.
