PICK: 4 TEACHER'S TREASURE (8-5)
Sib to three runners who earned between 150k and 250k. Word wasn't out in the first start as he went off at 34-1 but ran a decent 3rd. Kept pace late with the winner last out and that one won back in the 200k Golden State at 4-5 for Baffert. It was 15 back to 3rd.

VALUE: 5 POSTERIZE (8-1)
First time starter for a trainer who has had only three debut two year old runners. Two of the three came here at DMR and both hit the board. One that ran second was for this owner at 16-1 last year with Baze up. Works are very decent and perfectly spaced at SA.

This is a first time starter and a homebred for this ownership. He's been working since last summer and finally makes his debut in this spot. Trainer Ron Ellis is 5 for last 6 in a maiden claimer for 3YO+ with a runner in a first start (one of the wins were this owner).

VALUE: 4 PAUL'S DIVA (20-1)
Makes his first start for trainer Puype and is coming off nearly a year layoff. There is no guarantee that he can run at all but his first two starts here last summer were not that bad. Ran 3rd at 10-1 in a mdn clm 32k in 2nd start. Rider is 27% when up for M Puype.

Been on the turf twice and has a fast close 4th beaten less than a length here two back and a good second at SA in last. That came with Baze aboard and he stays up here. 4th from last came back to win at this level in a 6.5F turf SA sprint. Winner has earned 300k.

VALUE: 2 OLD INDIAN TRICK (6-1)
Claimed two back when he was dropped in for a tag. Won first off the claim for Carava at 10-1 in a game effort. Only turf try came 4 back and it was a strong third at 10-1 at 5 furlongs here. Has enough speed to be in a perfect spot. Slow 4F move says he's ready.

He ran just too poorly to be taken seriously in last start at 3-1. He drifted in and was not a factor at any point. Eurton backed off him after and has come back with a sharp work listing. 575k purchase looks like he's going to come back strong. Haven't seen his best.

VALUE: 2 CONQUEST COBRA (5-1)
Privately purchased after last at EMD and is moved back to Cerin who had him in '17. He ran well for Cerin and was 2nd in an opt clm the last time he was with Cerin and it came with Prat up. He's 1 for 3 on this dirt. Hasn't won since a 103 Beyer here at 11-1 in 2016.

VALUE: 5 MACWINNON (8-1)
Drew the difficult rail in the debut and then made matters worse by breaking slow. He's a 140k purchase back in April despite a sire fee of just 3k. Has been gelded since most recent start and O'Neill excellent with first geldings. Rider is 33% at Del Mar for O'Neill.

VALUE: 7 SHADES OF VICTORY (12-1)
Claimed for 12k in April and this trainer has turned him into a stakes winner since. Won at 80-1 two starts back when he wired them in the Johnston and that field included one of the main players in here, Edwards Going Left. Winner of last won the BC Classic next.

VALUE: 10 CAPTAIN BUZZKILL (6-1)
Benefited from a fast pace in last to get up for third at 12-1. Has a good late kick and is getting a huge rider upgrade for this going to a top turf rider Prat from an apprentice Espinoza. Had a strong work going into last. He needs pace help up front to set him up.
