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| <p><b>1 DEL MAR RACE 1 (12:30 PT) 46</b><br/>OPT CLM 62K, 1M TURF</p> <p>4 ENGLISH DANCER 7-2<br/>6 PULPIT RIDER 6-1<br/>7 FLAMMETTA 3-1<br/>3 ONE FAST BROAD 9-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 ENGLISH DANCER (7-2)</u><br/>Last time that this ownership took a runner from the East Coast and moved to Baltas on the West Coast was Secretary of War. He won at the same opt clm 62k level here at 1 mile on turf and was bet down to 5-2 favoritism back in August. She is 2 for 7 at the distance.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 PULPIT RIDER (6-1)</u><br/>Big closer won at 12-1 the last time she was on this turf course and that came at the 1M distance. Rail was a disadvantage in her last start but she did finish in front of the one to her outside. Big rider move to the fantastic turf rider, Van Dyke. This one was 3<sup>rd</sup> in the key race won by Improbable, a Baffert colt who won the Street Sense at by 7 next out w/ a 93 Beyer. Runner-up was 2<sup>nd</sup> in MSW by 1 and 7 clear of 3<sup>rd</sup>. Fifth ran 3<sup>rd</sup> in a MSW at 35-1 next.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 ASANO (6-1)</u><br/>Worth noting that Baffert, who trains the #2 in here, is 2 for 24 with first timers at a route on dirt. This one was much better in his 2nd start after a pop and stop vs BC Juv winner, Game Winner, in the debut. Won 1st turf try over a solid field of MSW's. 3rd won back vs similar. Blinkers two back seemed to make a big difference.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 OISEAU DE GUERRE (5-1)</u><br/>Breeding suggests routing on the turf is the right spot for this one. He did that when he was with Chad Brown but has primarily been a sprinter since. Clocker reports say he has been working superbly since last start. Drew wide in 5 of his last 6. Better here. This one flashed speed in MSW and ended up tiring but split the 12 horse field in there. 10<sup>th</sup> beaten 17 was a debut runner as well and dropped to 50k and won last week.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 SEEKING REFUGE (5-2)</u><br/>This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> of two straight maidens going down into maiden claiming. Bought for 50k back in April so the move to 50k here is likely the right spot. Goes turf to dirt for a trainer who likes to start his runners on turf as it is easier on them. First try in the US was with Grade 1 company and she was finishing in style to get up for 4<sup>th</sup> despite hitting traffic in the late going. Was on the also-eligible for the BC Juv Fillies. L1 today and sharp works.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 ELSA (20-1)</u><br/>Even though she has only sprinted thus far in her 3 race career, the backbreeding says routing is where she'll do her best running. Show finisher in the debut ran 5<sup>th</sup> of 14 in the BC Juv Fillies Turf. May have bled in last, she gets L1 here. The run two back was huge considering the winner was nosed out in the Zia Park Derby next start. Winner 2 back was 3<sup>rd</sup> twice in opt clm 62k. Huge rider upgrade.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 JUNGLE WARFARE (4-1)</u><br/>Actually finished in front of the top choice in the last race won by a really promising 3YO Surfing Star. Winner two back returned with a huge 7 length win in an opt clm 62k with a 100 Beyer. Clockers high on his works coming into this.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 10 OHIO (8-1)</u><br/>He was on the vets list a few times in '16 and '17 for Lobo. Whatever those ailments were, they appear to be have been corrected with the current team. Pulled and steadied in a few of his recent starts. Confidence builder two back when he ran and hid.
