Ran very well in 2 other starts on this grass. Kent was able to get her to relax two back and close well out of a wide trip. Forget last on the off-track at SA. She came back with a sharp bullet work.			Cost just 52k so the run at this level makes a lot of sense. Ran well enough in the first start when 3 rd of five runners. Half sib is Smokey Image, a 5 for 11 sprinter who won 350k (5 time stakes winner in Cal).			Late runner ships in from Kentucky Downs where she was last seen rolling late to run 3 rd to millionaire On Leave. Runner-up won a Keeneland allowance next. 5 th , 7 th , 9 th all won stakes next and a few others hit the board. Proctor 19% 1M turf stakes in So Cal.			Second dam is a sib to Flute, '01 Kentucky Oaks winner, and earner of over \$1.1M. The sire won the Breeders' Cup Sprint. Clockers say she is working well enough and the 45k purchase price makes this 32k unveiling a good spot. Baze off outside runner for this.

Was bet down hard in the start two back at SAR (had a lot of late money) and won easily. Run down in last by a 12-1 price. A new unknown trainer.			Considered this filly for the top spot but the trainer, McAnally, has just been so poor for so long. 50k purchase last September is in a decent spot on a class drop. One runner has come back from the field she faced in debut. Last ran 2 nd in a mdn clm 50K at 32-1.
