<p>1 DEL MAR RACE 1 (12:30 PT) 47 OPT CLM 50K, 1M TURF</p> <p>1 HONCHO 5-2 2 SALTARIN 5-1 8 SWAMP SOUFFLE 3-1 3 LEAD STAR 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 HONCHO (5-2)</u> <u>VALUE: 2 SALTARIN (5-1)</u> A) 1 B) 2,3,6,8 C) 4,5,7</p>	<p>3 DEL MAR RACE 3 (1:30 PT) 58 OPT CLM 100K, 5F TURF</p> <p>7 CISTRON 7-2 3 ALLABOUTACTION 15-1 5 EDDIE HASKELL 3-1 1 CALCULATOR 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 CISTRON (7-2)</u> He's had three narrow misses this year in 4 turf sprints. The other turf sprint was a poor effort but came with the blinkers on for the only time (they were removed immediately). Tied with Calculator for highest turf Beyer of 100 in the field. He'll get the run of the race.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 ALLABOUTACTION (15-1)</u> He has only had one turf race thus far and it came at 1M 1/16 in a stakes at SR in 8th start of his career. He faded to last at 7-2 odds in that race. He's been consistent of late and is deserving of another turf try. Big effort in 1st off a claim last out. Rider won on him 5 back.</p> <p>A) 7 B) 1,2,3,5 C) 4,6,8,9,10</p>	<p>4 DEL MAR RACE 4 (2:00 PT) 44 CLM 16K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>7 SCHULACE 6-1 8 BUILDER 3-1 1 ISEE IT IN HIS EYES 5-1 3 DRIZZY 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 SCHULACE (6-1)</u> Worth noting that the favorite in this race, #6 Placido is coming in after being a vet scratch since last. This one finished in front of one who came back to win by 7, beating the one to his outside. That was his first start with a set of blinkers and it seemed to do the trick.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 ISEE IT HIS EYES (5-1)</u> Another one who was a vet scratch since his last start. He faced open claiming in last and was a strong 4th. The show runner won back vs the same class here at DMR. Winner was beaten a neck to that winner in the 16k race. Has starts in the past that would win today.</p> <p>A) 1,7,8 B) 3,6 C) 5</p>	<p>5 DEL MAR RACE 5 (2:30 PT) 53 MSW 53K, 1M TURF</p> <p>1 OPUS WON 12-1 3 QUEEN RYKER 8-1 4 ENAMORED 3-1 10 HELLO BUBBLES 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 OPUS WON (12-1)</u> The connections have the half sibling to this one, Markie's Water, who won the 200k turfy Snow Chief Stakes last year at Santa Anita on that turf course. Faced males in last. 2nd, 3rd and 4th ran 1,2,3 in a similar MSW. 6th won in next start vs maiden claiming 50k company.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 QUEEN RYKER (8-1)</u> This trainer is 3 for 9 (33%) with 5 in the top 2 with a foreign shipper for these owners. She was 2nd in last beating 15 runners and beat a total of 23 runners in her 2 starts in Ireland. <p>2 DEL MAR RACE 2 (1:00 PT) 68 MSW 53K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>4 CONFIDENTIALLY 5-2 1 JOHANSSON 4-1 3 GRACIOUS ME 2-1 5 SPEND SPEND SPEND 5-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 CONFIDENTIALLY (5-2)</u> <u>VALUE: 1 JOHANSSON (4-1)</u> A) 1,4 B) 2,3,5 C)</p>	<p>6 DEL MAR RACE 6 (3:00 PT) 60 STR ALLW 50K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>8 VALLESTINA 5-1 2 MONGOLIAN HUMOR 7-2 1 SAUCE ON SIDE 3-1 6 TIZ WONDERFULLY 12-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 8 VALLESTINA (5-1)</u> This new trainer has been very live with just 6 runners so far. She won a stakes in her 1st start but that runner was DQ'd to 2nd. Took this one for 35k in last and comes back with a solid string of works for this. Won by 17 in debut for trainer who doesn't win w/ 1sters.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 TIZ WONDERFULLY (12-1)</u> Really like a router with speed cutting back to this distance. This one went a bit too fast in last and now drops a furlong. Forget that turf start two back as there is really no grass breeding. Desormeaux gets back up and he has had a very good '18 meet here at Del Mar.</p> <p>A) 1,2,8 B) 5,6 C) 3,4,7</p>	<p>7 DEL MAR RACE 7 (3:30 PT) 64 HOLLYWOOD DERBY-G1 300K, 1M 1/8 TURF</p> <p>1 HAVE AT IT 6-1 4 RIVER BOYNE 5-2 6 RAGING BULL 7-2 12 PUBILIUS SYRUS 30-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 HAVE AT IT (6-1)</u> Draws the rail for the 3rd straight race and 4th time in last 6 starts. He ran very well in all 3 rail starts. Was close to the fast pace last out in the G2 where he was a close 2nd to the fav River Boyne. Race devoid of speed so he'll sit in a great spot early. Cohen here for the ride.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 12 PUBILIUS SYRUS (30-1)</u> Could turn out to be the speed of the speed. Sent into the fast pace in the G2 Twilight Dby in last and tired. All the speed stopped there. Showed talent last year with two stakes wins and another runner-up to Analyze It in the G3 DeMil. Really depends on how the pace goes.</p> <p>A) 1,4 B) 2,6,9,12 C) 3,7,8,10,11,13</p>	<p>8 DEL MAR RACE 8 (4:00 PT) 82 MSW 53K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>8 STRETFORD END 5-2 6 MY MANDATE 12-1 3 MUTINEER 20-1 9 MOONVERTHEBAYOU 20-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 8 STRETFORD END (5-2)</u> Loads of talent from this 600k purchase. He was 2nd to two Baffert runners in his 2 starts. Winner of debut took the 100k Street Sense at CD by 7 next (93 Beyer). Show runner won a MSW here by 9 last Saturday. Was 7 clear of the rest of the last field. Sitting on a big race.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 MUTINEER (20-1)</u> Trainer is 3 for 5 (60%) with another running a close second (80% in the exacta) with 2nd time two-year olds with Bejarano up. Comes out of same race as top choice, 10 post was a disadvantage. Good to see Bejarano back. \$1.4M winner, Running Stag, is in the family.</p> <p>A) 8 B) 1,3,6,7,9 C) 2,4,5,10</p>
<p>9 DEL MAR RACE 9 (4:30 PT) 39 OPT CLM 20K, 1M TURF</p> <p>1 MARJORIE E 7-2 10 THALIA 9-2 4 SAPPHIRE KID 6-1 2 SPEAKERS 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 MARJORIE E (7-2)</u> Won back to back starts on this turf course this past summer. Was favored in the start 2 back and tired a bit late. The winner of that race has since won a 75k allw and then third in the G3 Autumn Miss. Pace was too fast last out and 8 post didn't really help her chances.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 10 THALIA (9-2)</u> Worth noting that Prat is off the top choice for this filly which he'll ride for the first time in here. She won well as the favorite in start two back and earned a competitive 77 Beyer there. Forget last as it was moved off the turf due to rain.
