Typical work pattern (littered with bullet drills at this track) for Baffert. Dam was a 2x Grade 1 winner as a two-year old in '07.</p> <p>VALUE: #6 CONVEX Trainer McCarthy had two 1st time 2YO starters at Del Mar last year. He got a win and a third from those starts and Van Dyke was aboard in the win. Was a 155k purchase despite just 5k sire fee. Clockers really impressed in the drills. Maldonado is back.</p> <p>VALUE: #7 DRIPPIN SAUCE Winner of his last start at PLN won the 100k CTBA by 6 lengths here at Del Mar two weeks ago and is undefeated in 3 starts (all blowout wins). Notice he had to circle 7 wide in that race to make a run. Runner-up in debut was 10 clear. Very big pedigree. Winner two back won an allw at IND next. 2nd in there won a MSW at SAR last month. 7th and 9th returned to win MSW ELP, PRM.</p> <p>VALUE: #7 POWER SOURCE He was 50-1 in the debut and that was a race that produced two runners who returned to run 2nd in Group 2's. Had a lot of trouble in the start last out when off at 9-1. Rider has won 30% in '18, '19 for this trainer. Two strong works here. Blinkers come back on after they were removed for the last 3 races. Moved to the grass in last but flopped badly. Last time she had blinkers and on dirt, she was a close 2nd at GG at 8-1. She's a 875k buy.</p> <p>VALUE: #5 ANGEL ALESSANDRA Miller shipped her out of So. Cal. When Santa Anita had their problems. She faced tougher company there. 2nd last out returned to win an opt clm at ELP by 11 lengths. Winner was third in G3 Victory Ride at 9-1. She's a fit w/ these. Callaghan 3 for 5 w/ 2nd timers who won the debut (all 5 ran in stakes).</p> <p>VALUE: #1 WRECKING CREW Word was out in the debut as he was a 2-5 favorite for Peter Miller and ran to that betting. Sire fee is 5k but he sold for 875k back in March. Picks up Smith for the but it is significant Prat opts off to ride the top choice. Sharp work 8/5.
