<p>DEL MAR 1ST (2:00 PT) 45 CLM 25K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>1ST 2 AND COUNTING 7-2 2ND 3 SUPER KLAUS 4-1 3RD 6 FUEGA 4-1 4TH 5 SHEZA FACTOR 3-1</p> <p>PICK: #2 AND COUNTING Claimed two back for 30k in a race where she ran away from that small field. Didn't finish in last as something went wrong in there. Connections have won twice with the "last-out eased" angle. Comes in with a strong set of drills for this comebacker.</p> <p>VALUE: #3 SUPER KLAUS She was 5-1 in the same race where pick was 9-1 last out. This is her second start off a mini layoff and moves to rider who won 5 of 33 for this trainer (win odds 25-1 13-1, 10-1, 8-1 and 7-2). Forget the turf as she's not bred for it. Makes a late charge. Once SA ended, they had to wait until Del Mar to get back to the turf and this is the first condition that fit for him. Gelded since last. Faced better last 2 at SA and ran well in both. One to beat.</p> <p>VALUE: #4 FIRST IN SHOW Tried going long and without blinkers in the most recent start. He went too quick early and tired in the lane. Cuts back to a distance he won at to break his maiden at GG. Prat back in from NY and gets up. He may have more bottom off the route. A) 5 B) 1,3,4,6 C) 2,7</p>	<p>DEL MAR 3RD (3:11 PT) 28 OPT CLM 20K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>1ST 7 DR WYSONG 3-1 2ND 2 QUIT KVETCHING 6-1 3RD 4 PAPACLEM'SMIDNIGHT 5-1 4TH 5 WISHFUL 7-2</p> <p>PICK: #7 DR WYSONG Absolutely like this one a lot more for the dirt than the grass. All sibs combined are 0 for 9 on turf. Good second three back in the 200k Evening Jewell. Winner of that race is 7 for 7 in the exacta and was 2nd in a G2 in next start for Keith Desormeaux.</p> <p>VALUE: #2 QUIT KVETCHING Was 15-1 in the debut for a trainer who is not all that proficient with firsters. Loved the way she sat off the pace and moved into the field when the rider asked her in the late stages. Really sharp drill here at 5F (6th of 64). May have some real talent. There is a lot of speed but he could stalk in a good spot early. 1st, 2nd two back both came back to win in alw in next start. Will be prominent throughout.</p> <p>VALUE: #1 GABO'S MACONDO Comes in from Northern California when last seen running 3rd in a 40k claimer on the dirt. He was favored in there but had little left in the lane. He's 6 for 13 in top 2 on the grass and should be able to save ground from the rail. Can sit a good trip. A) 1,8,9 B) 2,4,10 C) 3,5,6,7</p>
<p>DEL MAR 5TH (4:17 PT) 72 MSW 61K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>1ST 7 EXPRESS TRAIN 5-1 2ND 1 SHOOTERS SHOOT 2-1 3RD 3 PHAST PHAROAH 8-1 4TH 6 EIGHT RINGS 8-5</p> <p>PICK: #7 EXPRESS TRAIN Nicely bred firster. 2nd dam, November Snow, won the G1 Test and earned 550k. Her sib was a G1 placed sprinter. Trainer is 3 for 4 in the top two (one win) with 1st time 2YO's at DMR on dirt sprinting. The 3 in the exacta went off at 65-1, 7-1 and 5-1.</p> <p>VALUE: #3 PHAST PHAROAH Another first time starter with a strong pedigree. Sire won the Triple Crown. This trainer is 3 for 11 with a debut 2YO sprint on the dirt in MSW company. One of the winners was 3 weeks ago here at 3-1. He has shown speed in the morning works. A) 1,7 B) 3,6 C) 2,4</p>	<p>DEL MAR 6TH (4:47 PT) 68 OPT CLM 40K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>1ST 6 LANDESKOG 5-1 2ND 4 RAFAL 6-1 3RD 2 MORGAN S. 15-1 4TH 12 DISTINCTIVE B 7-2</p> <p>PICK: #6 LANDESKOG Comes out of the G1 Woody Stephens, a very strong race. 10th beaten 18 from the race came back to win a stakes at LRL in his next start. The 3rd place finisher won opt clm at SAR. O'Neill 5 wins and 3 place from last 11 starts at DMR. Working fast.</p> <p>VALUE: #4 RAFAL Clocker reports are very high on how he has been working here since his last out at SA. Winner of the Desert Code won the G3 Quick Call at SAR for his 3rd stakes win in his next start. Baffert is 5 for 20 in opt clm dirt here at Del Mar for 3YO's and up. Connections were going to ship to NY for the \$1M BEL Derby which is an indication of what they feel about this one. Been working nicely w/ Van Dyke. Saves ground from the rail.</p> <p>VALUE: #5 STUBBINS Trainer Doug O'Neill has been on fire at this meet (5 wins, 3 runner-up finishes in his last 11 starts). Good run behind older superstar sprinters in last. Breeding says he'll want the added ground. Bejarano is back up, was aboard for win at SA 4 back. In watching replay of that race, he had run in the lane after a bad trip on the rail and was stopped in the late going. Moves to a 26% trainer in 2019, Wong. New rider gets up this time.</p> <p>VALUE: #7 VERMEER Been in the money in all three starts for Hollendorfer since moving from Parx. He drops to the lowest level of his career in here and gets in with the least weight he has carried. Decent clocker comments for this race type. Doesn't face anything.
