PICK: 3 MARQUEE PRINCE
 Brad Cox colt is 2 for 3 on the grass. He's won 4 of his past 6 starts and a few of those by open lengths. Has turf deep in the pedigree so it isn't a surprise he has handled it well. Pace slow in start two back but he ran it down anyway there.

VALUE: 5 STIRLING DRIVE
 He has been gelded since his last start. Has bit of backclass and has run well enough against a few fields similar to this. Probably better suited for the bottoms of the exotics but the odds are going to be good enough to take a chance here.

PICK: 4 BELLE LAURA
 Connections thought enough of her to give her a shot in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf 2 starts back. She split the field at 51-1. Blinkers were added in last and she was sharp early in a G3 here. Big rider addition and strong worktab.

VALUE: 5 TRENCHTOWN CAT
 Trainer is 15 of 29 in the exacta at the meet and it includes a win by this one. Stretches out here for the first time. Breeding may lean more to a shorter race but the trainer magic will likely be a differntiator. Comes in with a strong worktab.

 Trainer Clement is 5 for 6 in the exacta (1 win) with a first timer going long on turf in MSW for this owner (3YO+). Those runners were off odds of 6-1 to 13-1 except one that was 5-2. Her work regime is very typical of a Clement first timer.

VALUE: 10 NONSENSICAL
 Was 5-2 in the debut but that was on dirt after the race moved from the grass. Ran better last out on the grass. That was a stronger race. Six from that race came back to run in the money including two winners. Joe Bravo gets aboard.

PICK: 3 POINT OF HONOR
 Bet down to favoritism in both starts and ran to the betting. She was much the best here in her debut. There wasn't much in that race but way she won was quality. Third from last ran third in the G2 Fair Grounds Oaks at 18-1 last weekend.

VALUE: 5 CHAMPAGNE ANYONE
 She has nibbled vs graded stakes company last three times out. Didn't get away well in the last start but recovered nicely to get up for 3rd. The blinkers come on here for the first time. She's worked well. Will be closing well late in the race.

 Deep closer ran 2nd in a key race two back. First place finisher returned to win in an op clm and then run 2nd a head in the 75k Columbia Stakes at Tampa. 2nd and 4th also won next out. Needs a quick pace to win this. Might get that in here.

VALUE: 6 FREEDOM'S FLIGHT
 Really outran his odds two back when 4th in his first turf start. Added blinkers in last and ran 3rd by a head in MSW here. Trainer does better with a runner who has had a few starts. Strong drills in prepping for this. Bred well for the grass, too.

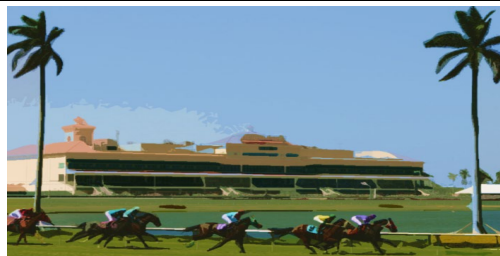

 This is clearly not the goal for this G2 winner. It is likely serving as a first step for later. However she has done well off the bench previously and is 2 for 2 over this track (won her 2nd, 3rd starts on this turf). Velazquez up and strong worktab.

VALUE: 6 TOO CHARMING
 Loads of speed for this filly coming in on a two race winning streak. Beat her stablemate last time out who is also in this race. Dam was very good on the grass in her day. Big rider gets up for the 1st time. Logical spot for her off a break.

PICK: 5 RESTORING HOPE

Was tempted to just write Jason Servis in the text box here and be done with it. This trainer is 33 for 74 at the meet (45%) which is obscene. He takes over the training for this one from Bob Baffert and he will show he is the only one able to improve on one from Baffert. Third in the Wood 3 back and flopped with blinkers in the Pat Day Mile. Slow works mean nothing with this outfit.

2nd: 11 CANDYGRAM

Came off the long layoff to run in the same race many out of (won by Be Gone Daddy). Didn't get away cleanly in that race and he rushed up before tiring in the lane. He ran well with Franco aboard in his third start when at Aqueduct. He was second in MSW as the 4-5 choice. Bred to love distance at 7F up to a mile. Rider hitting at nearly 30% for this trainer. He looks well-meant today.

3rd: 4 ROCK DOC

Sharp win last out when he beat Ny-breds in an opt clm at 7-2. The problem is it was back in June. The good news is that he has always run well fresh. He won off a layoff in the maiden win at 5-1 and was narrowly beaten from the 11 post in the last return which came a year ago. He projects to be in a perfect pace stalking trip and is 2 for 2 in the exacta at 7F. Tab tote for any action.

PICK: 11 SECOND MATE

Claimed three back for just 35k and was in stakes in the next two starts. Ran 2nd two back in the 150k Sunshine Millions to very good Big Changes. That was his 6th win in 8 starts and the other two were runner-up's. Sports a very good record here at GP grass course (7 of 10 in the money). Castellano adds to the appeal as he gets on for the 1st time. Will have to negotiate the wide post.

2nd: 4 SPACE MOUNTAIN

Was claimed for 62k out of his last start by very astute connections. He was coming in off a 7th place finish to the Pegasus Turf winner Bricks and Mortar. Didn't handle a tough inside post draw in last and was 9th out of 11 in the end. Prior to last two starts he was 3 for his previous 6 starts and was showing strong late kick. Maker has had a good meet. Think he'll surprise at a price.

3rd: 7 BONDURANT

Banking on the race won by Dr. Edgar as a strong one as many are coming out of that race and the 2nd and 3rd picks are exiting it. Sat midpack in the race and was even late. He did beat 6 runners and a few in here he sees today. He's 7 for 11 in the money this distance on the grass. He had trouble two back when lacking room late at 18-1. Was steadied early three back going 5 furlongs.

PICK: 9 BIGGER PICTURE

Was hammered down to 3-5 in the G3 John B Connelly at Sam Houston in his last start and he romped in a big effort. He's a very consistent type (12 wins and 24 in the top 3 from 38 lifetime starts). When you look at where everyone will be sitting early, he will be hard pressed to not fall into a great trip stalking the pace. Seems well-spotted. He should get an ideal pace flow for this one.

2nd: 8 SOGLIO

He's the more fancied of the 2 runners for Maker. He comes in off a tough loss to the 2-1 favorite Zulu in the McKnight. Zulu won back in the G2 Diarmond at GP here earlier this month. Loves this track with 5 for 5 in the money on this turf. Finished 3rd to his stablemate, and top choice, in the Ky Turf Cup G3 five starts back. Lacked room when 2nd two back. He probably would have won.

3rd: 4 CANESSAR

Was 3-1 in the McKnight last time out. Trip was brutle and he ended up a decent 5th of 13 in there. They are going back to Lynch in here and he is 4 for 4 in the money aboard him (including his only US victory). He likes longer distances. 4th three back has since won a couple of stakes since then. He will need some pace to make a run into. He's 6 for 16 and is sitting on big race in this one.

PICK: 1 HIDDEN SCROLL

There was much discussion about his race in the Fountain of Youth. He was sent hard to duel with a 100-1 longshot and paid the price late. He was trying something rare in that race. He was making his second start in a graded stakes at beyond a mile and as a 3YO. Rail is no bargain but expect a more realistic trip. This Mott colt has big upside. He'll be tough to beat with any kind of trip.

2nd: 3 HARVEY WALLBANGER

Shocked a 4-5 favorite Maxiumus Mischief in the Holy Bull here back in early February as a 30-1 upset winner. That was following a sharp score in his maiden win at CD as a two-year old in November. He hasn't run a bad race yet. Love the worktab for this for trainer Kenneth McPeek. This rider is now 2 for 2 on him. Expecting a pretty good trip behind dueling, contested speed up front.

3rd: 4 BOURBON WAR

Pretty significant that Irad Ortiz is staying here and opting off of the undefeated colt for Jason Servis Maximum Security who he rode for last out and won by 18 lengths. He was a fast closing 2nd in the FOY but did get a perfect pace situation closing into pace that was falling apart late (as did the first place finisher, Code of Honor). He has the breeding and connections. Major danger.
