<p>7 GULFSTREAM R7 (3:07 ET) 42 MDN CLM 12K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>2 OH DANNY BEAR 6-1 4 VALID EXCHANGE 9-5 7 JUNIOR JUMPER 20-1 3 BYRON BAY 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 OH DANNY BEAR Really like a router that showed a touch of speed cutting back to 6.5F especially when drawn towards the rail. Ran 3rd vs similar in last (although did have front wraps for the first time). Winner ran 3rd for 12k claiming at TAM next. 6th two back won next for 20k.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 JUNIOR JUMPER Ran 2nd at 16k at LRL three back at odds of 6-1. That came from the rail, a spot he drew two back as well. Last is better than it may appear. 5th beaten 17 came back to run 2nd at 9-2 vs 20k maiden claimers here. Dam won 441k (all turf) and won G2 Blst Spa going 1M 1/16. So the 1M distance is fine here. Casse has a 36% win rate with this owner at GP (31% on the turf). Has two slow breezes (indicator of a ready runner).</p> <p>VALUE: 5 HERA Shipped in from New York for trainer John Kimmel and was favored in a similar spot. She was wide and rank in the race and that clearly cost her a better finish. Saez is back aboard after two solid drills at PM training track. Female tree produced Golden Act (on the board in all 3 Triple Crown races) who won over 400k on the grass. Slight lean in a very difficult race.</p> <p>VALUE: 11 EKATI PEACE Trainer has a good record going sprint to a route with a second timer in MSW. This one has a serious turf pedigree especially deep in the female tree. Ran well in WO debut after bumping from the gate. Really sharp worktab for this. He was sent off at 6-5 despite the race with a Chad Brown firster. Sib to Bolt D'Oro, a big name on the Triple Crown trail last year. He kept his sizzling drills up after the win. Has a bullet drill at PM. Really can be any kind.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 BLUE STEEL Went off favored in the debut last Sept but had some trouble from the gate. Validated the action in the second start with an huge run wire to wire that indicated he was very good. <p>11 GULFSTREAM R11 (5:12 ET) 29 EL PRADO 100K, 7.5F TURF</p> <p>9 KRAMPUS 6-1 5 MR CUB 9-2 2 HOLIDAY STONE 12-1 12 UNCLE B 15-1</p> <p>PICK: 9 KRAMPUS Comes out of a strong race. Winner Bricks & Mortar returned to win the G1 Pegasus Turf and is now a \$3M winner. This one got a bad trip sitting in behind runners and bottled up until too late. Projects a perfect trip in here for Bill Mott who is on fire. Price will be right.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 HOLIDAY STONE Has only beaten two since the win in Sept at Saratoga. That is problematic but there are a few excuses. Ran on dirt in one start and pressed fast paces in graded stakes in the 2 others starts. Beat Breaking the Rules in the win who won the TUP Dby over some in here.</p> <p>A) 2,5,9,12 B) 3,6,8,9,10 C) 4,11</p>	<p>12 GULFSTREAM R12 (5:43 ET) 68 MSW 50K, 1M TURF</p> <p>4 DELCAPEM 15-1 1 CAFÉ AMERICANO 3-1 11 LADY WORTHINGTON 7-2 6 MODERN MUSE 30-1</p> <p>PICK: 4 DELCAPEM Makes first start on the grass and she has a strong turf pedigree (3 graded stakes grass winners in the recent female family). Debut was pretty good as she closed while 6 wide on the dirt. Drew the rail in the next two and had serious trouble in both. Big recent drills.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 ACRYLIC Trainer is 5 for 38 (13%) with a first timer in a maiden claiming race. He's had just 1 such starter here at GG and it was a blowout win at 7-1 back in March 2015 at this same 12k level.
