She comes from off-the-pace and will need the pace to get fast early. Seems to like some give in the grass so move her up if the ground is soft. Regular rider is up. The last 4 have run 1st (6-1 odds), 2nd (6-1 odds), 2nd (5-1 odds) and 3rd (8-1 odds). Dam won 4 of 8, was 2nd in the G1 BC Juv Fillies and a 2x G1 winner on the dirt. VALUE: 12 FLAME ZAPPER Might actually have a career on turf. There is a 5x G1 turf winner from England deep in the female family.
