She was 3 rd at FG at 6-1 despite an 8 wide move on the turn. Rosario got up in last for the first time and it produced a win at OP. Should be closer to the pace in here.			Drawing the 12 post will be a challenge but the odds should allow for a play here. Three fast track routes in his career and all were good enough to compete here. He finished well two back after a rough start. He's been really working strongly for this comeback.			Trainer Wayne Catalano is 7 for 13 (54%) w/ a 50% or more claiming dropper (11 in the money (85%). The winner of his last start at FG came back to win an allowance race for Amoss. Didn't get the greatest of trips last two times out. 2 for 3 in the exacta at KEE.

The winner of that race came back to win an opt clm 40k at TP next. 5 th and 6 th from that race came back to hit the board at 56-1 and 50-1. She was 4-time winner in '18. Saez gets aboard.			Broke slowly in his last start which came in a strong maiden claiming race at OP. This Zito trained colt gathered himself after the bad beginning and finished well for 4 th out of 11 runners. He was up on a fast pace at CD two back before tiring. Good rider is up.			Dropped off the table to 5k following a race when he was vanned off for 32k. He's been decent vs better since that claim when w/ opt clm company at FG. This is a pretty big rider move from an apprentice. Career top came at OP for 50k a year ago wire to wire.

Sloppy track and steadied in debut, 11 post in second start and wide, chased a runaway front runner in last. Female tree produced 01 Derby runner-up Invisible Ink.			The first stakes race of the meet is a tough one. This one was a neck from being three for three before last. Drew the inside there and had a tough trip, never really getting a clean path until late. No business winning two back when closing from a mile behind.			Hard to tell if there is anything in the tank here. She was a private purchase after her last start and now drops down for this one. Picked up checks in a G2 and G1 race early in her career. Trainer has a good record for this ownership here. Top call rider gets up.

Trainer has had two here at KEE and both hit the board at odds with this rider. Excellent Louisiana work for this.			Despite being a La-bred, she fits well in this group. She has had tough trips in the most recent starts. Very wide in last and she was bottled up with nowhere to run 2 back but still almost got there at 7-1. Gets a test for class here. Trainer 5 wins over last 8 starts.			Was 202-1 and 132-1 in two Grade two races for this low percentage outfit. Won the G3 Hutcheson on the cutback in last. He does have a decent turf pedigree. Won his first 2 starts on the surface at GPW. Really like his 2nd win on it when rating just behind early.			Got a perfect pace setup two back when 3 rd at 83-1. They went fast early and set her up late. The pace was much slower in her last start and she was left with just too much to do. Her only win came over this surface in '17. Worthy of spot on the bottom of tickets.
