Doesn't face a lot in this spot and the drop could make all the difference. Bumped at the break at the start of last and was off slow. Also had bad start 2 back. Slight improvement wins this. Ward 41% at 4.5F with a 2YO MSW 1st timer.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 MUSTA NEVER MET U</u>                  Trainer is 4 for 7 in the top two at 4.5F with a MSW debut runner. He works them slowly which is why the 4 who hit the exacta went off at 86-1 (here at KEE last year), 50-1 (here in 2017), 34-1 (here in 2017) and 9-2 (a win at PIM in '16). Could be a viable exotics add. This trainer not normally known for having debut runners cranked up but has won 2 of his last 14 with debut runner sprinting (12-1 and 7-1 odds). Sib (Are You Kidding Me) won 12 of 41, 1.2M.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 CLUB CAR</u>                  Another debut runner who has some nice works coming into this. Trainer Colebrook is about 10% with a first time starter going short in a MSW. Dam won 11 of 19 including 8 stakes (7 of which were La-breds). Works indicate she has handled this surface well. May not have wanted the off-track two back at FG and 14 post hurt him in the Risen Star. Patient rider is up and works are serious. Gun Runner and Saint Liam close relations. This one took 3 of 4 as a two-year old which included two stakes. He didn't get a great start in the G1 Summer and may have bled as he got Lasix next out. Works have been superb (1:09.3B at Palm Meadows on 3/11).</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 THE BLACK ALBUM</u>                  Ran in the BC Juvenile Turf back in Nov and didn't run all that badly. He was out of the 9 post and steadied late in the race on that yielding turf. Was a G3 winner in the prior race. He's worked well for the new trainer at Payson and gets Ortiz. Some class here. He ran well in two sprints following that before the last place finish 2 back on the Dby undercard. Surely needed comeback. Goes back to the regular rider. Worked well at CD. He will get a pace set-up.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 STRIKE REVENGE</u>                  Has a sprint leaning pedigree with a bunch of stakes winners for this ownership in the female family. The best of which is the \$2M winner, Soaring Free, who won the G1 Atto Mile (\$1M purse) back in 2004. He's worked well for this comeback and gets Geroux up.
