Second to last place finisher in the Melbourne Cup won a G3 in his next start. Winner two back won the G2 Dubai City of Gold on 3-9. Is the one to beat.</p> <p><b>VALUE:</b> 5 PRINCE OF ARRAN Was beaten just 3 lengths by the top choice in the Melbourne Cup. Ran better than may look in the Hong Kong Vase. He was beaten 7 to Exultant who came right back to win G1 HK Gold Cup. Winner of last runs is favored in the Sheema Classic on this card later on.</p> <p>A) 2,6,9 B) 5,10 C) 3,7,8</p>	<p><b>4 MEYDAN R4 (9:30 ET) 59</b> AL QUOZ SPRINT \$2M, 6F TURF</p> <p>2 SANDS OF MALI 8-1 8 BLUE POINT 3-5 9 CARIBOU CLUB 15-1 13 WISHFUL THINKER 20-1</p> <p><b>PICK:</b> 2 SANDS OF MALI Upset winner of the Group 1 Champions Sp at Ascot last time out. He beat 13 runners in there at 28-1 while doing so on the lead. Has good speed but doesn't need the lead to win. He's 5 for 10 at the distance for near \$1M in earnings. Looks to be getting better.</p> <p><b>VALUE:</b> 9 CARIBOU CLUB Talented US Based runner who won 3 of his last 6 starts and is less than a length from being 4 for 4 sprinting on the turf since fall of '17. Talamo has been up in the last three starts and two of those were wins. 3<sup>rd</sup> two back won the G3 FG Handicap in next start.</p> <p>A) 2,8 B) 1,3,9,13 C) 4,5,6,10,12</p>	<p><b>5 MEYDAN R5 (10:05 ET) 41</b> UAE DERBY \$2.5M, 1M 3/16 DIRT</p> <p>5 DERMA LOUVRE 12-1 6 DIVINE IMAGE 2-1 1 WALKING THUNDER 5-1 3 GOLDEN JAGUAR 15-1</p> <p><b>PICK:</b> 5 DERMA LOUVRE Never off at odds of greater than 5-2. Japan based runner faced undefeated runners in the last two starts as those winners have not lost a race yet. Good to see the regular rider ship in for this. Got away flat footed in last, held up a bit and then he finished well.</p> <p><b>VALUE:</b> 3 GOLDEN JAGUAR He's run three times and is a neck from a 3 for 3 streak to start his career. Was floated very wide in the Meydan Classic in last, got to the lead late but hung a bit and allowed the runner to his inside to surge back. That effort serves a good prep. <p><b>6 MEYDAN R6 (10:40 ET) 36</b> GOLDEN SHAHEEN \$2.5M, 6F DIRT</p> <p>8 TATO KEY 20-1 3 X Y JET 9-2 5 DRAFTED 8-1 4 PROMISES FULFILLED 7-1</p> <p><b>PICK:</b> 8 TATO KEY Argentine horse won 12 of 14 in Argentina. The two starts in Dubai have been very nice and should put him in good shape to make a run in here. There is a ton of speed here and the three fancied runners might duel themselves into submission. Rolling late.</p> <p><b>VALUE:</b> 5 DRAFTED Winner of 3 of 4 starts and beat the choice twice. Notice all four of those starts off the layoff came with blinkers removed. Clearly better horse off the break (lost to Kimbear by 14 lengths here last March but beat that one by 3 off the break). Will track the pace.</p> <p>A) 3,4,5,8 B) 2,10 C) 6,7,9</p>	<p><b>7 MEYDAN R7 (11:20 ET) 70</b> DUBAI TURF \$6M, 1M 1/8 TURF</p> <p>7 ALMOND EYE 7-5 2 DREAM CASTLE 7-2 12 WITHOUT PAROLE 15-1 4 VIVLOS 15-1</p> <p><b>PICK:</b> 7 ALMOND EYE Japanese star has won 6 straight after her debut runner-up finish. Her last 4 victories have been in Group 1 company. Those four wins in G1's were vs large fields (beat total of 61 runners in those races). Runners out of Japan have done well in spots like this.</p> <p><b>VALUE:</b> 12 WITHOUT PAROLE Winner of the St. James Place back in June at Ascot as the 2-1 favorite. Hasn't been as sharp since and got nearly 6 month break prepping for this spot. He wouldn't be here if he wasn't doing well and good to see the regular rider Dettori return for this event.</p> <p>A) 7 B) 1,2,4,6,8,12,13 C) 3,11</p>	<p><b>8 MEYDAN R8 (12:00 ET) 66</b> SHEEMA CLASSIC \$6M, 1M 1/2 DIRT</p> <p>3 MAGIC WAND 6-1 2 OLD PERSIAN 8-5 6 REY DE ORO 5-2 1 CHEVAL GRAND 10-1</p> <p><b>PICK:</b> 3 MAGIC WAND Strong runner-up finish to Bricks &amp; Mortar in the Pegasus Turf last time out. That one came back to nose out a foe in the Muniz at the FG last weekend. Winner 2 back was voted champion female turf runner in the US for Chad Brown. Gets Ryan Moore today.</p> <p><b>VALUE:</b> 1 CHEVAL GRAND Another Japanese horse who faced mainly Group 1 company of late. His real claim to fame came in 2017 when he upset at 12-1 in G1 Japan Cup with Bowman. Was rolling in last and could've won if not for steadying in upper stretch. He could use quick pace.</p> <p>A) 1,2,3,6 B) 4,7 C) 5,8</p>	<p><b>9 MEYDAN R9 (12:40 ET) 73</b> WORLD CUP \$12M, 1M 1/4 DIRT</p> <p>10 YOSHIDA 8-1 5 SEEKING THE SOUL 7-1 2 CAPEZZANO 7-2 12 THUNDER SNOW 6-1</p> <p><b>PICK:</b> 10 YOSHIDA Classy Bill Mott runner may not have loved the yielding GP turf (or the very wide trip) in his last start in the Pegasus Turf. Big move late in the BC Classic but he ran out of time in there. Reportedly working superbly and should get needed pace. Look for him late.</p> <p><b>VALUE:</b> 5 SEEKING THE SOUL Was 34-1 in the Pegasus but ran up for 2nd on that sloppy track. He's approaching \$3M in earnings now. He's a G1 winner after he won the 2017 Clark. Another who would be a beneficiary of a fast pace. Mike Smith is in to ride for the first time. Big win chance.</p> <p>A) 2,5,10 B) 1,3,12 C) 4,6,7,8</p>
