Might not have wanted the softer footing 2 back as he made no late impact. 9th out of that race won twice since. Pace was just so slow in last. 2nd and 3rd were near the front. VALUE: 8 EL TAUR Not a ton to love here. Trainer just 7% in '18 out of 108 starts. But there are excuses in the last few. Bad break three back and just couldn't make up late ground. Was on main two back. Made an early move into a quick pace last. Stabbers may look to land here. VALUE: 7 GREELEYS CHARM Closer was about 5 behind the top choice in his most recent race (that came back in August). He was 7-1 and had to go 5 wide in that race. Has always run well at OP (6 for 10 in the top three here). Pretty honest for the level. He should get a pace to run into. He traveled well, went to the lead and then put the field away in the lane. Female tree produced the 1993 Arc De Triomphe winner (Urban Sea). Reportedly working superbly. VALUE: 4 NINETY ONE ASSAULT Deep closer makes his comeback after last running in November. He was 3rd in a stake race here as the favorite but gets credit for having to close into very slow pace. The 4th place finisher in there returned to win in a 100k stakes. Pace will be fast enough early. The winner 2 back won the 200k Mystic Lake Derby next. VALUE: 3 KING OF CANDY He'll be closing from off the pace in here. He gets blinkers on for the first time and moves back to Saez who was aboard in the maiden win over this track at 78-1. Had to make an early move in last due to the slow pace. She gets in protected from the claim due to her last race coming over 90 days out and entered back at or above the claiming price she last ran in. Won a key race going away. 2nd in that race has since been stakes placed 2 times. VALUE: 7 JUST PERFECTION First two starts were awful but she ran and hid in last. Might be a bleeder as she shows speed and stops or kicks on. Trainer/owner campaigned the 750k winning dam, won G2 races on the dirt. Sharp works here and they are neatly spaced. She owns the top Beyer. The fractions were fast and he made an early move into it and hung in gamely at 36-1. He has backclass but hasn't won for 15 months. Should get the run of the race. VALUE: 2 COLTRANE He was 35-1 with Centeno aboard in similar spot here 11 months ago and he went wire to wire to win. Two of the three turf starts since he was forced into sub :47 half mile fractions. The other was a :47 flat on a good turf. Will need a breather up front in here. He has been rank and aggressive in the early stages in many of his starts. Has talent as showed in a win here two back. Rider is 23% for this outfit. Notice a bullet drill prepping for this. VALUE: 11 BLACK SEA He's been in the money in 17 of his 28 races and almost always is making up ground in the lane. Probably the winner in last if he'd gotten room late in the race. He does have a bit of tactical speed and that should have him in right spot early. Will finish well here. He was breaking from the 9 post, went wide in the move to the lead and just drew off running into a fast pace. Considered a stakes type for previous connections. Prat had choice for Baltas' two horses. Saves ground today. VALUE: 4 ICE KAT Hasn't had a clean trip in a while and it may be the reason that Baltas has Rosario here and Prat on the top choice. Could use a fast pace given his late running style. Baltas is over 21% with layoffs of this type. Has been working a while. Check tote for more clues. A) 1 B) 3,4,6,7,8 C) 2,5</p>
