<p>1 GULFSTREAM R10 (4:40 ET) 42 CLM 16K, 1M 1/16 TURF</p> <p>10 STORMY JUSTIN 12-1 6 GET THE FACTS 7-2 7 JUPITER RISING 5-1 2 GOOD OLD BOY 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 10 STORMY JUSTIN Current form looks bad but he does have a few excuses. Sloppy track in last (dirt) and hit the gate two back. Very wide 3 back. He was with a zero percent trainer. Moves to a better barn, been gelded, rider a upgrade. 5 next out winners from the two back race.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 JUPITER RISING Pletcher is 5 for 11 (46%) with 7 in the top 3 (63%) with a 16k claimer at GP with Saez up. This one pressed a fast pace last out from the 10 post. Pace was fast enough to set up the winner from last. 2nd and 5th out of last won next. Her career best was a runaway win in the G2 Fritchte at LRL at 7F on the dirt in 2011 (101 fig). He might have bled in last as he gets L1 here. 11 post was his undoing in G1 Summer 2 back. He's working better than ever. Ortiz tries again.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 ARCHIDUST Always felt those drop in distance to 6.5F or 7F are dangerous. The 4th place finisher last race (beaten 13) came back to run 2nd in G2 Holy Bull at 130-1. This trainer really needs no introduction and can win with anything. Lots of early speed in here and some who aren't reliable. This one was good here in '18 with two upset wins over strong fields w Loveberry. Serious worktab for trainer who normally works them slow.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 HIGH NORTH Brad Cox has had a slow start to this meet but is likely to heat up soon. This one was working in company with one to his inside. Track favoring speed but there is so much that one who can track just in behind has an edge. Was traveling nicely on the rail when a runner came over on her and almost knocked the rider off. Steadied badly but re-rallied. Dam won 2 G1's routing in '11. Could be overbet by replay watchers.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 KID SIS Exits a key race when he was bet down to a big favorite. The winner came back to win an allowance and then a close 3rd in stakes after that. Many others in the field fired on the return. Half to G1 winner Whitmore who is campaigned by Moquett. <p>5 GOLDEN GATE R7 (6:55 ET) 60 CLM 25K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 KELLY 7-2 6 CROWN KITTEN 5-1 5 AMBER LOUISE 4-1 2 CLOSE THE SHOW LO 2-1</p> <p>PICK: 3 KELLY Came off a very long break to face many of these two back. She made a huge mid-race move to the lead, was steadied and tired at the end slightly. Made a 5 wide rally in last vs most of this field and was getting there late. Third off layoff for this consistent 6YO mare.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 CROWN KITTEN Drew the rail in last and was forced to send a bit to hold the inside and tired. Prior rider who was aboard for the win is back and she will sit off the pace here. Banking on outside runner to go with the front runner or speed could wire them. Loves GG. But the race really sets up for a late runner and she is just faster. She's 5 for 7 in the exacta at GG. Rider off others to stay. That recent slow work indicates readiness.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 TOP NOTCH Was 14-1 in the common race won by the SA shipper last out. Was checked severely in the 1st 100 yards and never got back into it. Big run at 47-1 two back after a slow break. Turf and route in the two prior. Ran 2nd at 13-1 the start 5 back. Wish a better rider was up.</p> <p>A) 4,7 B) 2,8,9,10,11 C) 1,3,5,6</p>	<p>7 SANTA ANITA R9 (7:42 ET) 39 OPT CLM 40K, 6.5F TURF</p> <p>4 ANIMOSITY 12-1 8 SPECIAL PURPOSE 5-1 6 SPY RING 7-2 3 HELEN'S TIGER 4-1</p> <p>PICK: 4 ANIMOSITY This kind of move wins often and run last as often. Route speed but hasn't been able to carry it. Cutback to a distance she won at in her debut. Had some excuses in the poor efforts and Rosario off Special Purpose is interesting (he has his choice around here).</p> <p>VALUE: 8 SPECIAL PURPOSE Was graded stakes placed in Europe. Bled 3 back and was likely the reason she came to the US (Lasix). First start here came back in May and ran 2nd with a big late run. Willing to excuse last (1st off a break and slow start on soft turf).
