It includes one at this meet. His runners have been live to start this meet and his winners have been bet down. This one has backclass and has a strong work prepping for this one.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 I'VE GOT HEART</u> Might have a bit more early speed than may appear. Was slow from the gate last start vs better from the rail. They went 22.4, 45.3 and he couldn't catch up. Win two back was near the lead. Rider was aboard for the maiden win at PRM pressing the pace. At right level. A) 1,6,11 B) 2,3,7,9 C) 5,8,10</p>	<p>4 OAKLAWN PARK R4 31 MDN CLM 16K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 LINDA LISTEN 5-1 9 DATA STAR 9-2 5 MY GIRL ROCKET 3-1 12 FORTRESSA 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 LINDA LISTEN</u> Claimed in last from a 6% trainer. She's run 3rd in all three starts and twice broke from a difficult rail. Trainer 4 for 100 here. 3 of his 4 wins at absurdly high odds (one at 84-1). She is just 1 of 3 to exceed 50 Beyer (done 2X). 2nd, 4th 5th all won next out from her last start.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 9 DATA STAR</u> Has some speed and drops in class. Those 2 things have been strong at this meet. Broke through the gate pre-start in last and ran 4th as the 2-1 second choice. Certainly been w/ better runners and good to see Court stay with her. She'll be in this throughout today. A) 3,5,9 B) 4,12 C) 1,2,8,10</p>	<p>5 OAKLAWN PARK R5 22 CLM 10K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>7 BOATHOUSE VIEW 5-2 5 MAID EASY 20-1 8 SUGAR CUBE 5-1 11 CEREMONY 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 BOATHOUSE VIEW</u> Another mid level claimer for the high strike rate trainer Norm McKnight who won three times on opening weekend (all three were bet). 14 for 25 in the money and 1 for 1 on dirt. McKnight is 31% (1 for 1 with this owner and is 2 for 2 at Oaklawn) first off the claim.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 MAID EASY</u> She knows how to win. She has 11 wins in 44 starts and in the top two 26 of those 44. She has been in the top two in 16 of 24 on a fast dirt track and not nearly as good on the wet, synthetic or turf. She's been facing top level competition. Trainer been live the last year. A) 5,7,8 B) 6,11,12 C) 1,2,3,4,9,10</p>

This one exits a strong race at CD. The winner has since run 2nd in a G1. Show finisher ran 3rd in the G3 Pat Day at CD. Dam is a full to super sire Tapit. Tab tote.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 HOME IT TIZ</u> Female tree produced quite a few excellent runners (millionaires Ironicus and On Leave and stakes winners Seal Cove, Norembega and others). Moves to the high percentage Diodoro and has been working consistently at OP. Back in a route is key for this trainer. A) 1,2,3,4 B) 7,8 C) 5,6,10</p>	<p>7 OAKLAWN PARK R7 56 OPT CLM 50K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>8 CLEVER SERVE 2-1 6 HOLD HER TIGHT 7-2 4 FIRST ALTERNATE 5-1 9 AWESOME GAL 20-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 8 CLEVER SERVE</u> Asmussen runner fits into this race despite being a stakes winner last out because two of her wins since the maiden score were in starter allowance and claiming. Third in last has won 5 of 6 including two stakes. Second is a graded stakes winner. Class in this spot.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 HOLD HER TIGHT</u> She won two of the three starts she was in that weren't stakes. Only three out of exacta came in graded stakes race. Third from last came back to win the 250k Zia Oaks which was strong race. 6th, 9th and 10th all returned to win. 2nd was 2nd in the G3 Comely at AQU. A) 6,8 B) 2,4,9 C) 1,3,7,10</p>	<p>8 OAKLAWN PARK R8 57 OPT CLM 40K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>4 MYLADY CURLIN 5-2 9 THREE CHORDS 5-1 5 PROFOUND MOMENT 10-1 2 TIME AND CHANCE 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 MYLADY CURLIN</u> Think she can tuck in midpack on the rail in a race full of speed types. While the track is playing to inside speed, a few live finishers came from just off the pace on the rail. Exits the same race 2 back as top choice in the 7th race (check on that). Cox will heat up soon.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 9 THREE CHORDS</u> Oklahoma-bred won back to back stakes in sprints two and three back. The last was at 20-1 odds. Last time she was here at OP was five starts ago and she won by over 10 at 8-1 odds. She has the right style for this race. It will set up nicely for her. Love the slow work. A) 4,9 B) 2,5,7,8 C) 3,6</p>	<p>9 OAKLAWN PARK R9 21 CLM 6K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>12 SHMILY 12-1 1 ZIMMERMAN 3-1 6 PLUMBAGO 15-1 11 MIDNIGHT SHINE 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 12 SHMILY</u> Won two straight by daylight and then was a good 2nd at 8-1 vs opt clm company 4 starts back. Pace was too fast early vs better three back and wide with traffic 2 back. Dropped and scored in last. Has tactical speed. Rider has won with him. Needs a fast break here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 PLUMBAGO</u> Inside part of the track wasn't great at TP in his last start and he broke from the rail and came up the inside. 0 for 7 in an off-track so the start two back can be discounted. Might get a fast pace to close into. Evenly matched sets up nicely for a longshot to hit the board. A) 1,12 B) 3,4,6,11 C) 7,8,9</p>
