That opt clm field is one of the better one's at the meet. Also this one was bumped out of the gate. Just a 5,000 purchase in 2017 so it's good to see the connections keep him at a higher level. Should have a pace to run at.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 NEWS FLASH</u> Trainer's 7 winners at the meet were all bet hard early (most half of morning line 10mn to post) and all 7 went off significantly lower than their morning line. He's 9 for 19 1st off claim and at OP (47%), 2 for 4 for this owner, both with Cohen. Runs with the speed bias.</p> <p>A) 5,6 B) 7,8 C) 2,3,4</p>	<p>4 OAKLAWN PARK R4 54 CLM 20K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>4 GIANT PULPIT 3-1 8 DERECHO WARRIOR 9-2 7 LUCKY BRITCHES 4-1 1 FLIGHT RISK 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 GIANT PULPIT</u> Trainer has high numbers in virtually every category. He is 33% with a last out maiden winner and has such a win at this 20k level already at the meet. Took serious early and late money last out and ran to the action. He will be up on the lead. Track favoring speed.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 DERECHO WARRIOR</u> Ran against the major inside speed bias on opening day and ran on well for third while the top two got perfect trips. Winner 2 back returned to win for 15k for Asmussen for his 3rd win in a row. Should be able to get closer to the rail given the pace scenario. Late run.</p> <p>A) 4,8 B) 1,7 C) 5,6</p>	<p>5 OAKLAWN PARK R5 35 MDN CLM 50K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>7 ONE MAN PARTY 2-1 2 FLAT OUT BEAUTIFUL 5-2 5 TRAVOLTA 9-2 1 IKON WHO 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 ONE MAN PARTY</u> Trainer Asmussen is 2 for 5 (40%) with a first time starter in a maiden claiming of 40k to 50k here at OP sprinting. Don't be turned off by the slow works as that's per usual for him with 1sters. Dam is half to '10 G1 Pat O'Brien sprint winner El Brujo (won 700k sprinting).</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 FLAT OUT BEAUTIFUL</u> Debut was good enough to win this race. 2nd at Churchill as the 3-1 second favorite. Was bothered in the race which may have cost a win. Didn't get any respect going long in the MSW and ran poor. There were not apparent excuses. <p>6 OAKLAWN PARK R6 73 CLM 6K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>8 PREACHER TIME 10-1 1 CANDY FOR THREE 3-1 4 MADE TO FIT 8-1 2 CASH FOR THE SOUL 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 8 PREACHER TIME</u> Trainer doesn't win often but is 3 for 7 with 5 in the money when dropping significantly in claiming class at OP when last out for 20k or more at OP. This one was on the rail in most recent start, steadied twice, angled out and finished well. 2nd won for 30k this weekend.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 MADE TO FIT</u> Been facing opt clm company of late. This is a pretty significant drop in class. Winner of last was a heavily bet Broberg runner that was last seen crushing 20k foes at RP and won for fun here. Key race two back. Top 3 in there won back vs. better. This one moves up as she is a proven entity on a wet track. She tried the grass in last but it was a tough ask going short in a stakes and running into a :43.1. Rider knows her well.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 BARBARY HALL</u> Been a useful check getter since she was claimed for 20k twenty-one starts ago. She has won 7 times in the last two years and is 2 for 5 on this track. She was 3rd in stakes in last at 13-1. Has to overcome a speed bias. Trainer is 5 for 7 on the board at this meet.</p> <p>A) 4,5 B) 3,6 C) 2,7</p>	<p>8 OAKLAWN PARK R8 66 ALLW 80K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>2 MALIBU MAX 10-1 6 Z ROCKET 5-2 8 HIGH NORTH 9-2 9 SHOTGUN KOWBOY 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 MALIBU MAX</u> More a process of elimination rather than conviction here. Lots of early speed in here and some who aren't reliable. This one was good here in '18 with two upset wins over strong fields w Loveberry. Serious worktab for trainer who normally works them slow.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 HIGH NORTH</u> Brad Cox has had a slow start to this meet but is likely to heat up soon. This one was working in company with one to his inside. Track favoring speed but there is so much that one who can track just in behind has an edge. Won a 150k stakes last time here.</p> <p>A) 2,6 B) 1,7,8 C) 3,5</p>	<p>9 OAKLAWN PARK R9 58 MSW 80K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>7 SUNDAYSATTHEBEACH 5-1 6 KID SIS 8-1 4 ULTIMATE MO 4-1 8 PARADISE BAY 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 SUNDAYSATTHEBEACH</u> Was 5-1 in last when the race was moved to the sloppy main at FG. Was traveling nicely on the rail when a runner came over on her and almost knocked the rider off. Steadied bad but re-rallied. Dam won 2 G1's routing in '11. Could be overbet by replay watchers.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 KID SIS</u> Exits a key race when he was bet down to a big favorite. The winner came back to win an allowance and then a close 3rd in stakes after that. Many others in the field fired on the return. Half to G1 winner Whitmore who is campaigned by Moquett.
