The debut at AP came on synthetic and then he went out and set the pace on a soft turf course at KEE in last. There were 3 next out winners from the KEE race, same with the debut. In those races, she has 2 wins and 6 in the money. She has excuses in many of her poor starts. Claimed 2 back by a very good outfit and she almost won 1st off the claim. Will be saving ground in here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 STINA</u> Ran well at TP and left there on a 2 race win streak. Trainer is normally a high strike rate outfit but is winless on the meet. Those with speed in here look a bit cheap and that may put this one in the prime spot stalking early and waiting for them to tire on the far turn. This track is playing heavily to those traveling inside. That was her first start off the layoff and she will improve here. Motion Emotion who beat many here was 9th in the CD MSW three back.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 SWEET GISEL</u> Watching the replay of her debut it seemed like she was never comfortable. She was 4 wide and in tight in between runners early in the lane. She tired after chasing the quick pace but felt there was more here. Breeding suggest route is fine. Strong drills since last. He ran well in the next two starts against better before a troubled trip two back. Didn't want the grass in last. Catalano is 20% with layoff of this type. At the lowest level of his career.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 FAREEQ</u> Last out maiden winner came back in April here at 5-1 with this rider up. 5YO gelding in with better company in the maiden ranks in his short career. This trainer has been more live with his runners over the last two years and does well with those coming off layoffs. This one beat MD-bred Saratoga Bob who won the 153k Maryland Classic in October. Were 9 clear of 3rd place finisher. The works are lightning fast for this trainer.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 SONNY SMACK</u> Ran 2nd to a nice Asmussen runner Lionite last out in June at PRM. Two runners from that race came back to win stakes. Like to see Von Hemel tab McMahan to ride as he was aboard for the MSW score here in the debut. Another set of works that are quick. Only start at OP was a total disaster 7 starts back but that was a route vs a strong field. Cost 90k so there upside. Possibly a spot underneath in the exotics. That one had been working in tandem with this one and she won in very impressive style at 12-1. Is bred to go short. Advantageous rail post if she breaks well.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 12 HER KINDA CANDY</u> Just one start so far and it came back at RP in November vs MSW company. She flashed a bit of speed before tiring. The winner of that race came back to win in an opt clm at RP (75k). Wide post might be a problem. If she breaks well she can get to the inside. A) 1,2,12 B) 3,5,6,10 C) 4,7,9,11</p>
