His winner won on opening weekend and did running against the speed bias (took a lot of early money as well). Last time Barkley had this runner, he was finishing a 3 race winning streak with a win at CD w/ Santana. Check the tote action.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 DUE TO HIS CHARM</u> Was beaten by the top choice four back but turned the tables on that one. Claimed two back by a dangerous trainer. Tried 10k foes at TP in last and ran 3rd vs a very similar field from off the pace. Last 2 wins were with this rider up. Closer could use a fast early pace. A) 3,6,12 B) 2,5 C) 1,4,7</p>	<p>4 OAKLAWN PARK R4 56 CLM 16K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>11 ETERNAL FORCE 6-1 1 ROCK N' CANDY 5-2 3 BECAUSE IT'S TIME 6-1 5 MAHALO JOHN 15-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 11 ETERNAL FORCE</u></p> <p>Exits a key race at KEE for 20k. There were 4 next out winners from that race. The winner Strolling was a very impressive winner here for 20k last weekend. Moquett had Santana up for the starter allowance win here about a year ago. They're trying to find right level.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 BECAUSE IT'S TIME</u> Sharp trainer took this one for 8k two back at CD and almost won for double the tag last out. Winner returned to take a 15k at Delta Downs for Tom Amoss. Third won a FG 15k at 5-1 next. Has a good record at the distance (5 for 6 in the money). Will be finishing here. A) 1,11 B) 3,4,5,10 C) 2,6,8</p>	<p>5 OAKLAWN PARK R5 61 MDN CLM 30K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>5 BLACKJACK JEDI 10-1 11 BLUE GEM 8-1 2 POST CLOSE 9-2 3 HONDURAS 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 BLACKJACK JEDI</u></p> <p>Trainer with just a single win in 32 lifetime starts but it came just three starts back. He adds blinkers to this one who broke poorly in the debut and found traffic in last. Really like the works coming in at LAD. 4th from last start won an IND MSW and allw 2 starts later.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 11 BLUE GEM</u> Trainer is 8 for 32 (25%) with 12 in the money (38%) with a debut in maiden claiming, dirt, sprinting. Only two of the winners went off at under 8-1 (two of them paid \$50+). One of the winners was here last year. Works very typical of his live runners. Will be a big price. LOUIE GUY 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 10 ALL ABOUT ASHLEY</u></p> <p>Trainer has had this one for five races. He's had this rider up for all five. They produced two wins and four in the exacta. Should be enough speed in here to allow him to settle in behind. In top three 6 of 8 at OP. Winner of his last start has now won 3 of 4 for Broberg.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 STORMY PACIFIC</u> He is right at home for this 30k level. Most of his career has been spent here. Doesn't win out of turn but is always competitive. Right behind the top choice four back. The winner three back just won the 50k Prairie Bayou at TP at 6-1. Rider was 2nd on him at 6-1 at IND. A) 1,4,7,10 B) 2,5 C) 3,12</p>	<p>7 OAKLAWN PARK R7 37 OPT CLM 50K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>1 FIRE FOR EFFECT 4-1 5 COWBOY CREED 6-1 9 PITCH COUNT 12-1 4 HOLLYWOOD CRITIC 12-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 FIRE FOR EFFECT</u></p> <p>Only runner to come back and run from his recent start was the 6th place finisher. That one crushed an opt clm field at TAM. Trainer is very dangerous and will win a ton of races here this meet. He'll save ground on the rail and that was the right place opening week.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 COWBOY CREED</u> Been following this one since last year. Was a winner of back to back starts vs cheaper at CBY. Really looked like a different runner at the end of 2018. Huge runs in all 3 starts after leaving Cby. Two back winner Audible was 5th of 12 in the Pegasus last week at 9-1. A) 1,5,9 B) 2,3,4 C) 6,7,8</p>	<p>8 OAKLAWN RACE 8 79 MARTHA WASHINGTON 125K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>2 MARATHON QUEEN 3-1 5 TAYLOR'S SPIRIT 5-2 4 SUNSET WISH 9-5 6 POWER GAL 9-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 MARATHON QUEEN</u></p> <p>Asmussen is 7 for 31 (23%) with 17 in the top 3 (55%) with a second timer in a non-graded stakes on dirt after winning in debut. Drew a tough post (rail) in the debut but was very much in control throughout. Dam was a G1 placed (G2 winner) for these owners in 2013.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 TAYLOR'S SPIRIT</u> Opening weekend at Oaklawn Park was very much speed and inside. This appears to be the fastest early. She came off the break in the 75k stakes at DED and was run down late by Sunset Wish. Stronger 2nd off break. Very dangerous if track is still very speed biased. A) 2,4,5 B) 6 C) 1</p>	<p>9 OAKLAWN PARK R9 58 MSW 77K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>9 VERVE'S HUMOR 6-1 8 C DUB 9-2 2 LOOPALLU 7-2 5 EAST MOON LAKE 15-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 9 VERVE'S HUMOR</u></p> <p>Have to treat this one like a first timer here. He ran once back in 2017 and was basically eased. That was an off-track and was a key race. Sib to two graded stakes runners (Tale of Verve ran 2nd to American Pharoah in '15 Preakness). Really strong 5F drills at the FG.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 EAST MOON LAKE</u> Late runner hasn't been out since last April. This is an Ark-bred who is getting Lasix here for the 1st time. Winner of last won a stakes since, earned nearly 300k. Trainer doesn't win often (9 for 191 at OP) but he can strike at boxcar odds (he won at 50-1 here in 2016). A) 2,8,9 B) 5,6,7 C) 3,10,11,13</p>
