ROYAL</u></p> <p><u>VALUE: 11 STARLIN</u></p> <p>A) 4 B) 9,11,12 C) 1,5,6,7,10</p>	<p>3 OAKLAWN PARK R3 27 CLM 16K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>9 BROWN EYED BLUE 4-1 4 GRATS ROAD 5-1 11 MIMI'S MONEY 12-1 12 DEAUVILLE MIST 15-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 9 BROWN EYED BLUE</u></p> <p>High percentage connections here. She was dropped in class two back and won and she ran a good race vs a few of these last out at Hawthorne. This is a major rider move from very low percentage workout rider to a very strong rider (27% for Mac). Will come on late.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 GRATS ROAD</u></p> <p>The 30k claiming company at CD is strong in this context and this one is actually facing a softer field than she beat in last. Was in too tough in her three starts over this track (and one came on the off-track). She will be a late finisher on a track favoring speed right now.</p> <p>A) 4,9,11,12 B) 2,6,7,8 C) 1,3,5</p>	<p>4 OAKLAWN PARK R4 35 CLM 10K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>11 HAPPY'S REFLECTION 5-1 3 BIG KITTY KITTY 10-1 4 FAIRLY HONEST 10-1 9 SEA SHACK 20-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 11 HAPPY'S REFLECTION</u></p> <p>Drops to the lowest level of her career. She's been facing much better company than she sees in this spot. Trainer Hartman is 5 for 13 (38%) with a double class drop here at OP in a sprint. 4th two back returned to run 2nd in a Delta Downs allw. Might be sent to the lead.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 BIG KITTY KITTY</u></p> <p>Inside part of the track and those that have been on or near the lead have dominated in the first four days of this meet. This could be fastest early. Grabbed control in last to win going away. Key race 2 back as 4 returned to win next. Trainer is 4 for 8 in the top 2 here.</p> <p>A) 3,11 B) 1,2,4,9,10 C) 5,6,7,8,12</p>	<p>5 OAKLAWN PARK R5 47 MSW 77K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>7 SUBIACO 5-1 2 BELLEINTHECITY 5-2 1 PRETTY AT WAR 3-1 3 U. S. CURRENCY 9-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 SUBIACO</u></p> <p>She's run just once and it was a muddy CD sprint where she broke first, went wide on the turn and finished 3rd. Dam was a router having won 3 stakes at 1 mile (all were turf) about 10 years ago. 5th from debut won by 8 at GP MSW next. 6th ran 2nd MSW here at 27-1.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 U. S. CURRENCY</u></p> <p>Never worse than 4th in five starts. She went off favored in last when the race moved to the main track. Never tried a fast dirt track but is bred for it. Trainer has been live so far at this meet (3 for 7 in the money, 3 who hit the board went off at 4-1, 8-1 and 13-1 odds).</p> <p>A) 2,7 B) 1,3,5 C) 4,6</p>
<p>6 OAKLAWN PARK R6 40 MDN CLM 30K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>11 BOSS DIXIE 12-1 4 FAKE SOLUTION 4-1 1 GRANDGRAN 9-2 9 DEFENDER 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 11 BOSS DIXIE</u></p> <p>Going against the inside speed bias here as this one is drawn widest of all and should be coming in from far back. Beat half the field in two 50k at CD, stronger than this group. 3rd, 4th two back won vs MVR MSW and FG md clm 40k. Trainer won w/ a TP shipper on Sat.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 FAKE SOLUTION</u></p> <p>First two starts came vs MSW on the grass in Kentucky. Dropped to mdn clm 12k in start two back and was sent off at 2-5. He got into a lot of traffic trouble in there and really had no chance. Improved in last for 2nd at 6-1 at TP despite a stumble out of the gate there.</p> <p>A) 1,4,11 B) 8,9 C) 2,3,6,10</p>	<p>7 OAKLAWN PARK R7 45 STR ALW 6K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>1 ONLY LIQUOR 5-2 8 OSO READY 4-1 2 GREELEYS SPIRIT 5-1 4 GOOGLEADO 2-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 ONLY LIQUOR</u></p> <p>Think this 9YO will get the run of the race in behind three dueling leaders and he will be able to save ground on a track that has a big inside bias right now. 5th, 6th, 7th from last all came back to run in the money (str allw, alw and clm 6k). Loves OP (is 3 for 9 here at OP).</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 OSO READY</u></p> <p>One of three in here with blazing speed and might be a need-the-lead type. Trainer had him previously and did well with him. Was 1 behind the top choice in last when he didn't make the lead. 5 for 7 at the distance. Might need to outbreak other speed to win today.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 2,3,4,8 C) 5,6,7</p>	<p>8 OAKLAWN RACE 8 73 STR ALLW 50K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 FIREHORN 2-1 3 NUCLEAR OPTION 7-2 1 EL ASESINO 5-2 4 SOUTHSIDER 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 FIREHORN</u></p> <p>Didn't break well from the 10 post in the CD allowance in last but finished strongly for 3rd at 15-1. The winner came back to win here in a romp with a 99 Beyer. 4th beaten 11 came back to run 2nd at 5-2 in an allw 78k here last weekend. Shouldn't be too far back early on.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 NUCLEAR OPTION</u></p> <p>Not sure he wanted the inside post in most recent start. That was the same race the top choice came out of. Really like the style he employed two back when he rated in back of the speed and rolled home in the lane. He will be very dangerous if left alone up front.</p> <p>A) 2 B) 1,3,4,5 C) 6,8</p>	<p>9 OAKLAWN PARK R9 27 CLM 6K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 MY DARLING SOFIA 9-2 5 GEMINI JOURNEY 5-2 7 UNION OBSESSION 20-1 12 BROADWAY STICKER 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 MY DARLING SOFIA</u></p> <p>Blinkers come off this speedy mare which is a 21% win move for trainer Robertson. She looks like she needs to rate a bit as she has tired in the lane of late. This is a huge class drop and Robertson goes with his first call rider here. May forget to stop with this field.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 UNION OBSESSION</u></p> <p>Very dangerous trainer especially with a big price. He's been on the board in 5 of 6 local stars at odds of 13-1, 12-1, 7-1, 7-1 and 5-1. He took this one for 8 k out of last. Has a couple of big runs that would put her in the win mix.
