<p><b>1 OAKLAWN PARK R1</b> 52 MDN CLM 25K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>6 SUSPICIOUS EYES 10-1 9 RI RI FRENCH FRY 6-1 10 SPOT ME 8-1 4 ON RADAR 9-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 SUSPICIOUS EYES</u></p> <p><u>VALUE: 9 RI RI FRENCH FRY</u> A) 6,9 B) 1,4,10 C) 3,8,11,12</p>	<p><b>3 OAKLAWN PARK R3</b> 61 CLM 10K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>9 R H SMOAKEM 6-1 7 CALL ME RICHARD 10-1 3 SHAKURR 6-1 1 WILD WILL 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 9 R H SMOAKEM</u> Diodoro is 6 for 13 (46%) with 8 in the money going allowance to claiming at OP and is off a layoff. He is 4 for 6 with such a move when they are shipping in from TUP. Forget grass races (not bred for it). 2<sup>nd</sup> in mdn win ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in 75k stakes after MSW and allowance wins.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 CALL ME RICHARD</u> Might be the speed of the speed. He broke 22 second for the first half twice in the last 2 starts coinciding with addition of blinkers. One he dueled in last ran 8<sup>th</sup> but returned to win a 25k clm at Penn. Track favoring speed at the moment. Trainer due to heat up here.</p> <p>A) 9 B) 1,3,4,7 C) 2,6,10,11,12</p>	<p><b>4 OAKLAWN PARK R4</b> 44 MDN CLM 10K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 RAPID ASSENT 9-2 5 TAP SHOW 5-1 1 WICKED GEM 5-1 3 PAXOS 3-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 RAPID ASSENT</u> Gets the nod over Tap Show (who he was tad in front of in last) due to being more tactical speed on a track favoring those who are up on the pace. Drew the 11 post in last and he was 4 wide on the turn. Apprentice rider up again and he gets in with light weight again.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 TAP SHOW</u> This one and #2 Rapid Assent ran in the race won by 40-1 longshot Oh So Tall. This runner had the rail and came from off the pace to finish a head or so behind Rapid Assent. He probably would have caught him if not for a bit of late traffic. Drop in class is beneficial.</p> <p>A) 1,2,5 B) 3 C) 4,8,9</p>	<p><b>5 OAKLAWN PARK R5</b> 33 STR ALLW 50K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>6 SUMMER STORM 4-1 1 CURIOUSNCURIOUSER 5-2 9 WORLD RIOT 3-1 8 SUPERCEDE 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 SUMMER STORM</u> She carried her speed last out to a maiden win at 3-5 odds with this rider up. Notice she had front wraps removed for that race and it came off a layoff. Might have gotten past whatever bothered her earlier. Could be the speed of race, depending on Sweet Tatum.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 SUPERCEDE</u> These are the kind of runners that make OP the best track to handicap. She has 11 wins in 29 starts and is in razor-sharp form. She's facing the best class she's seen but has the right running style to be in perfect position if there's a duel. <p><b>6 OAKLAWN PARK R6</b> 20 CLM 6K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>8 BABAKNOWSEVRYTHING 10-1 6 COMMERCIAL APPEAL 12-1 1 CUDDLE KITTEN 5-2 9 STINA 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 8 BABAKNOWSEVRYTHING</u> Trainer/owner claimed this one out of a md claiming win in June, ran once in July at IND and won but had her claimed from them in that spot. They took her back for 5k 3 back and won 2 of three off the claim. Lone loss 2 back after being eliminated out of the gate.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 COMMERCIAL APPEAL</u> She has not handled the synthetic or grass tracks so willing to look past her recent race at TP. Almost closed to win two back at 8-1. She ran 2<sup>nd</sup> three back despite a track that played to speed and the slow fractions she had to close into. If pace is fast, she can win.</p> <p>A) 1,6,8 B) 5,7,8,9 C) 2,3,4,10,11,12</p>	<p><b>7 OAKLAWN PARK R7</b> 65 MSW 77K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 SUMMER DELIVERY 5-2 7 LADY APPLE 9-5 2 VERCRUYSE 9-2 8 FLEETERHAN 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 SUMMER DELIVERY</u> Gets a lot of credit for going out and setting 21.2, 45.1 fractions in last at CD and then she hung in well for third at 8-1 odds. There were 3 next out winners from the 5 runners who have run back (winner won an opt cl at AQU next). Well-spaced worktab for a comeback.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 FLEETERHAN</u> Sold for just 45k despite the sire fee being 40k. But that isn't all that surprising as she's a Pa-bred. Trainer is 4 for 18 (22%) with a 1<sup>st</sup> time starter here in a MSW sprinting (8 ran in the money, 44%). All 4 winners had a thing in common, a breezing work 4 to 6 days out.</p> <p>A) 3,7 B) 2,8 C) 1,4</p>	<p><b>8 OAKLAWN RACE 8</b> 71 ALLW 78K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>3 DETERMINANT 9-2 1 MERCER ISLAND 5-2 6 MARZO 2-1 8 COMMANDEERING 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 DETERMINANT</u> Only been on dirt four times in his career. 3 of the 4 were on a fast track and once was a sloppy track. In those 4 dirt races, he ran 2<sup>nd</sup> at 8-1, 3<sup>rd</sup> at 79-1, stumbled out of the gate in another and broke from 14 post in G2 Blue Grass in the 4<sup>th</sup>. Been working well for this.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 COMMANDEERING</u> Might be better for the bottom of the supers as he's a closer but not the best closer here. He is 4 for 4 in the money at the distance for a few prominent outfits. Might have been a bit too close to the fast pace in last. Trainer won with couple of prices to start the meet.</p> <p>A) 1,3 B) 6,8 C) 2,5,7,9</p>	<p><b>9 OAKLAWN PARK R9</b> 58 OPT CLM 12K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>11 FETCH'S MON 8-1 6 DUTCH TREAT 5-2 8 MISS BARHAM 10-1 12 CHILEAN QUEEN 15-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 11 FETCH'S MON</u> Trainer William Fires is 3 for 6 with two other thirds first off a layoff and in Ark-bred race here at OP. One of the winners was with this mare here last year and that was a good run as she ran up on the pace. Muddy track, bad start and open class str allw in other 3 in '18.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 9 MISS BARHAM</u> Most here were defeated by stakes winner Georgies Reward. This 6YO mare beat that one three back with Canchari up in a huge run at 32-1. Obviously has issues as she was dropped to claiming two starts after, only 8 career starts and back for a low tag.
