<p><b>1 OAKLAWN PARK R1</b> 18 CLM 6K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>11 CHIP VAN WINKLE 5-2 3 TASHREEH 4-1 7 GREELEYS CHARM 10-1 1 NEIL'S DIAMOND 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 11 CHIP VAN WINKLE</u></p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 GREELEYS CHARM</u></p> <p>A) 1,3,7,11 B) 9,12 C) 2,4,5</p>	<p><b>3 OAKLAWN PARK R3</b> 40 CLM 30K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>3 LONG STATION 6-1 1 BOW AND ARROW 9-5 4 HARMAC 10-1 7 SHARP ART 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 LONG STATION</u></p> <p>8YO gelding is coming off a long layoff here but gets into the race protected from claim due to the higher tag and duration of layoff. Has run well here at OP and at the distance. Tailed off at the end of 2018 so maybe this is a good freshening. Should be finishing well.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 HARMAC</u></p> <p>Will likely be traveling from far off the pace in here. But the good news for him is there is a lot of speed (and need-the-lead types as well). Pace could set up well for him. Faced some very good runners in '17 and '18. Had some problem out of the gate recent starts.</p> <p>A) 1,3,4 B) 2,6,7 C) 5</p>	<p><b>4 OAKLAWN PARK R4</b> 52 MDN CLM 10K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>5 VYERA 8-1 11 DRAGON DRAGON 5-2 3 LONS GIANT 20-1 10 DATA STAR 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 VYERA</u></p> <p>Gets Canchari back and she ran well here in '18 with him aboard. Exits a productive race at CD. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> all came right back and ran in the money. 4<sup>th</sup> won two starts later for 16k at TAM. Doesn't have any speed and that could be an issue how this track is playing.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 LONS GIANT</u></p> <p>First timer with a sprint leaning pedigree cost 11k so the start in a 10k maiden claim race is fine. Trainer Danny Pish has started three first timers in maiden claiming at OP. He won once (17-1 odds), ran 2<sup>nd</sup> by a nose in one (8-1) and off the board in the other one.</p> <p>A) 5,11 B) 3,4,9,10 C) 2,6,8,12</p>	<p><b>5 OAKLAWN PARK R5</b> 35 CLM 40K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>6 WOSIE 7-2 7 JUST PERFECTION 4-1 2 MISS XIMENA 4-1 12 HEADLAND 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 WOSIE</u></p> <p>Shrewdly placed on the comeback. She gets in protected from the claim due to her last race coming over 90 days out and entered back at or above the claiming price she last ran in. Won a key race going away. 2<sup>nd</sup> in that race has since been stakes placed 2 times.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 JUST PERFECTION</u></p> <p>First two starts were awful but she ran and hid in last. Might be a bleeder as she shows speed and stops or kicks on. Trainer/owner campaigned the 750k winning dam, won G2 races on the dirt. Sharp works here and they are neatly spaced. <p><b>2 OAKLAWN PARK R2</b> 49 MDN CLM 30K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>5 CIPHERIN' SUE 3-1 2 TICKLE BUNNY 2-1 8 SKY FREAK 6-1 7 DELLA ROSE 12-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 CIPHERIN' SUE</u></p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 SKY FREAK</u></p> <p>A) 2,5 B) 4,7,8 C) 1,3,6</p>	<p><b>6 OAKLAWN PARK R6</b> 24 OPT CLM 20K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 HONEY BUNNY 9-2 4 VALIANT LADY 4-1 3 C J'S FLAIR 5-1 6 DESERT THIEF 10-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 HONEY BUNNY</u></p> <p>Last seen running a solid 5<sup>th</sup> in the Claiming Crown vs 13 foes in December. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> all came right back to win. Running style is from off the pace and the track really is not playing that way. But she has run quickly vs the others here and ran well at the distance.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 C J'S FLAIR</u></p> <p>20% trainer and a strong rider in play here. She was good in Canada running behind the 19 for 28 winner, and G3 Santa Anita winner, Escape Clause. Thompson was up for a 33-1 runner-up finish last time she was here and it came in a similar condition as this one is.</p> <p>A) 2,3,4,6 B) 5 C) 1,7,8</p>	<p><b>7 OAKLAWN PARK R7</b> 75 MSW 77K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>6 COWBOY DIPLOMACY 3-1 4 CAPTAIN VON TRAPP 5-2 8 CABOT 9-2 3 BETTER CHARGE IT 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 COWBOY DIPLOMACY</u></p> <p>First time starter is a full brother to the 3YO Horse of the Year in '18, Monomoy Girl. She won 10 of 11 (DQ'd once), the Ky Oaks, and in the running for overall HOY for Brad Cox. Fast works and B Cox goes to his main rider here. The slow start for Cox will turn around.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 CABOT</u></p> <p>Moquett is 3 for 11 (28%) with a first timer in a MSW on dirt sprinting with this rider up. 2 of the winners were at OP and 1 was for this owner. Santana up is significant as he is off Captain Von Trapp for Asmussen. He is a 1<sup>st</sup> call for Amussen. Works typical for Moquett.</p> <p>A) 6 B) 4,8 C) 1,2,3,5,7</p>	<p><b>8 OAKLAWN PARK R8</b> 38 OPT CLM 12K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>7 JUST A COINKYDINK 8-1 11 GUSKA MON SHOES 5-2 1 REEF'S DESTINY 8-1 5 BOGEY 3-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 JUST A COINKYDINK</u></p> <p>Ran well here last year vs Ark-bred company with a win and 4 in the money from 5 starts. This rider was aboard for the victory. 2 of the last 3 were on turf and the other was w/out Lasix. One of the few with speed on a track favoring runners who are forwardly placed.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 11 GUSKA MON SHOES</u></p> <p>Trainer decent with long layoff types as this one is. Claimed 8 starts back out of a win in a claiming race. He ran well vs better after that claim. Faced PRM allw in recent starts. Winner of last took a 50k stakes at ZIA two starts later. Very sharp work one week ago.</p> <p>A) 1,7,11 B) 4,5,6 C) 2,8,9,12</p>	<p><b>9 OAKLAWN PARK R9</b> 74 MDN CLM 30K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>6 PRINCESS Z OHSIX 3-1 1 MARVELLA 6-1 3 BRAVE DISH 8-1 8 GOLD ZEPHYR 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 PRINCESS Z OHSIX</u></p> <p>Second time starter has been off about two months. Trainer/rider teamed up for a win last weekend with a similar layoff type. She showed speed in there. 3 of the 6 runners from that race returned to win next out. The winner ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in AQU 100k stakes on 1/27.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 MARVELLA</u></p> <p>Tried grass in the debut but the 10 post in a field of 10 made that difficult. Blinkers were added in last and she ran decently (48 Beyer is high in this field) despite the fact that she was steadied 2x.
