Sits a perfect position early. VALUE: 8 DOS CUERNOS Big closer was moving well late at near 18-1 last out. He is going to get a fast pace today and should be one to fear late. He did win at this track once. That came almost exactly 1 year ago when for a different trainer. This is not the strongest field. Price will be big here. VALUE: 4 GOODBYE EARL Ran in the same race as the top choice two back in that key MSW. She drew the 10 post in there and was wide throughout. That hurt her win chances. Hopped at the start and 4 wide in last. Dam was a stakes winner at the 1M 1/16 distance. Could easily win this one.
