Is out of a key race. 6<sup>th</sup> won back at 10-1 vs 30k.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 UNO SUENO</u></p> <p>Was a 12-1 winner for 30k here last year w/ Court aboard. Hasn't been able to run back to that race since and saw herself drop to a career low 8k claiming in the last two. Fires could have had her lower but comes back at 16k. Should see more.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 WORLD RIOT</u></p> <p>One of 11 winners at the meet for McKnight when she shipped in from Woodbine. Was a winner while wide and that isn't something that has happened a lot this season here at OP. Runner-up came back to win next start at the same starter allw level. Layoff is certainly a bit of a concern but these works are very quick for a trainer who normally works them very slow. Top call rider. Wires with a clean break.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 GORDY FLORIDA</u></p> <p>He's eligible to move forward as this is a 2<sup>nd</sup> run off the layoff. Has always run well here (5 for 6 in the money). Thought he was game in defeat in the King Cotton. It is possible he wants fast dirt (6 for 7 in the exacta). She went right to the lead and kept opening up on a decent field in a 100k stakes here. The fractions she set that day were the fastest of the meet. Has a very good gate rider up again. Long gone today.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 SWING AND SWAY</u></p> <p>Tried to run with the top choice in last but it was too fast for her and she tired. Has speed to stay in the mix early but her last win was here sitting just off the early pace. She may win here with the same trip. That angle has been live at this meet. McKnight is winning at 24% at this meet and most of those were shipped in from WO. Works very fast over this track.</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 NEW DANCER</u></p> <p>Big run for 2<sup>nd</sup> two back at 7-2 here when off the layoff for Villafranco. Was the 6-5 fav last out but stopped in the lane. Claimed by Karl Broberg who is having another huge season win percentagewise. Trainer Moquett normally wins at a higher percentage. He is 1 for 2 at OP with a second timer in an Ark-bred MSW. Works since the debut have been very live.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 9 LEO DEL REO</u></p> <p>Took some action in the debut after a 3 wide trip. Moved up via DQ when the runner-up in that race (the rail runner here) came in late on him in the lane. Trainer is pretty good w/ those off a bit of a break like this and slower works indicate he's ready. Wide post is fine.</p> <p>A) 2,9 B) 1,3,9 C) 5</p>
