Drew wide posts in all three, as well. First two were vs stronger MSW company. 5 next out winners from the start two back and nearly every all have won multiple times. Poor start and 7 wide in last.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 AUCTIONEER</u> Makes his third start but the first two were hindered by awful starts out of the gate. He did make up ground in each of. Will be able to save ground from the inside and gets into this race very light with the apprentice back up. There are quite a few in here who need the lead but if you look at his win four back, he was able to rate just in behind. Beat a nice horse (Strolling) last out.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 KNIGHTS KEY</u> He's going to be hard to keep off the board today. There is a lot of speed and he looks to be the main closer. Didn't break all that well in last but made a middle move to the front before finishing evenly while wide. You had to be inside that day. Those traits gives her an advantage in this spot. Faced better in last and hung in well for 3rd at 10-1. 4th out of that race returned to run 2nd in an opt clm on Friday at 26-1. Trainer wins with this type.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 9 CAN'T TOUCH ME</u> Trainer has had one starter at this meet and it was a 30-1 bomb a few weeks ago (which was owned by this trainer just as this one). Asmussen has seen a few comebackers win off the shelf after last running in graded stakes. She can go out to the lead or rate slightly. Grade 1 placed filly.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 SISTER NATION</u> Other Asmussen runner was scratched out of the Spring Fever won by Amy's Challenge on Saturday for this spot. She is going to be a closer in this race and should have a quick pace to move into. Was making ground late in last. 11 for 18 in the money in her career.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 2,5 C) 3,4</p>	<p>7 OAKLAWN PARK R7 (4:14) 76 MDN CLM 30K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>4 DUSTY MILLER 3-1 1 CIPHERIN' SUE 5-2 2 GOLD ZEPHYR 6-1 7 JUST SAY MO 15-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 DUSTY MILLER</u> Drew the 11 post in her last start and had a lot of trouble out of the gate. It left her quite a ways behind and wide on a track that was favoring inside speed. She gathered herself and rallied to just miss in a 4-horse photo 3 weeks ago. Will show a bit more speed here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 GOLD ZEPHYR</u> Was bet down to 2-1 in the debut and ran 3rd with a mild rally. The winner, an Asmussen filly, returned to win by nearly 9 again with a 76 Beyer. Didn't get a clean start in the last race here vs some in this race. Think she is better than that. Could be a big price today.</p> <p>A) 1,4 B) 2,7 C) 3,8</p>	<p>8 OAKLAWN PARK R8 (4:42) 54 ALW 87K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 SHOTGUN KOWBOY 5-2 2 PIONEER SPIRIT 5-2 6 WARRIOR'S CLUB 7-2 4 ONE LINER 2-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 SHOTGUN KOWBOY</u> Millionaire returned from a layoff and ran a decent third behind a tearaway winner. The winner went off at 12-1 and had come in off a win at FG in opt clm. Has 4 wins in 9 starts over this track. Has speed but can rate just behind it, if needed. Should get the best trip.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 WARRIOR'S CLUB</u> G1 placed just four starts ago when he was 2nd in the Vanderbilt at SAR. Won a G3 at KEE about 11 months ago. Won at this distance and has two wins here. Earned 413K in 2017 with 6 in the money from 11 starts. Pace will make the difference. Use under in exotics.</p> <p>A) 1,2 B) 4,6 C) 3,5</p>	<p>3 OAKLAWN PARK R3 (1:57) 48 STR ALW 26K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>4 CANDYROCK 7-2 6 KAHRAMANI 5-2 3 BIGSHOT LACEWELL 4-1 2 KELA BREW 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 CANDYROCK</u> Was 28-1 when 4th last out in a key race won by comeback winner Dan the Go To Man. He blew out a starter 20k with a 90 Beyer next. Runner-up came back to run 2nd in a 30k clm next. 5th dropped to 6,250 and won at 4-1 in next start. Presses pace on the stretchout.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 KELA BREW</u> Two wins in his last four starts both coming at Hawthorne. Stumbled at the start of the race two back and lost all chance as the 2-1 favorite. Muddy track two starts ago. This is a trainer who starts them where they have a real shot.
