He's 5 for 6 in top 3 on a wet track. He is quick enough to grab a great tracking spot in behind what could be a fast pace. Is 3 for 5 in the money at OP.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 CANDYROCK Stretched out in the start two back and he narrowly pulled off the wire to wire victory. The top choice got by him in there. Winner in last looks like a very good runner. He has some off-track breeding in the pedigree, is 1 for 1 in the exacta on wet surface. Been a long time since he won. That allows the connections to drop him here an angle that Diodoro has success with. Winner last out has won two straight and 4 of 5 in top 2.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 KING'S RECKONING This could be a good spot for a big dropper in class like this one. Many of these have a few questions (like going from a high strike rate trainer in last). This one cuts back in distance and drops off the table. He gets Lasix today for the first time. That was following a four week layoff. Winner 3 back returned to win a starter allowance wire to wire at 7-1 odds. He last started for a claiming price at CD in September and won that at near 40-1 odds.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 SAMBUCCA Trainer has had a huge season already and one of the top trainers by win percentage in the country. This one was second in the first start off the claim. The winner of that race returned to run a close second in opt clm 62k. The runner-up came back to run 2nd in the G3 Commonwealth at KEE. 4th out of there ran 3rd beaten a half to Quip in the G2 Oaklawn Handicap on Saturday at 11-1 odds. Hit the board in 8 of 9 on a wet track.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 HAWAAKOM Last time this one ran on an off-track came here in the G3 Razorback about 14 months ago. He came up the inside to win at odds of 9-1. His last two wins were on wet tracks and also has a runner-up in a 175k at CD on a wet surface. But he has the best early speed and the fractions he set were legitimately fast. No easy trips and he still kicked on well. Clearly better this year. Aggressive Canchari perfect rider for him.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 TONEDADDY Big closer will be looking for someone here to put a serious early challenge to the top choice. Was favored in last and was only able to split the field. If the pace develops he stands a good chance to pass tired foes in the lane. She was bet down to even money and ran gallantly but was second best. Draws the rail today and should get an easy ground saving trip. Good to see Ortiz back in the irons in here.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 ESCAPE CLAUSE Might get a bit overlooked as she comes in with Century Downs and Assinobia Downs form. Not exactly the places that the top 2 have run at. But she is a runner, and knows how to win. Destroyed overmatched foes last. Front wraps were added in last, check to see if they're back. Blocked two back in deep stretch. Better expected.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 BANDIT POINT 4YO colt provided the rider her 1st career win 8 starts ago when he won a maiden at Canterbury at 12-1. Big run for 3rd last time out in the 100k stakes sprinting. Might be sitting in the best spot early tracking from just off the pace.
