<p>1 SANTA ANITA R1 55 OPT CLM 80K, 6.5F TURF</p> <p>1 VANTASTIC 5-2 3 ONTHEWAYTONEVRLAND 2-1 4 STUBBINS 5-1 2 URBAN LIGHT 3-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 VANTASTIC</u> Wish he was drawn away from the rail. It is not a great spot to break from at this 6.5F distance on the turf. Has a lot of turf deep in the pedigree so not surprising that he's taken to the surface. Winner of debut won two G3's since (and 2nd in G1). Rosario is up.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 STUBBINS</u> Drew difficult rail in last at this distance at 3-1 odds but still got up to win in a very big effort. Winning rider Prat goes with W Ward on the runner to his inside. Should be able to stalk from the wider post. This one is a deep closer who has done some of his best running from a rail draw. Rider is excellent at getting runners like this to finish. 6 for 8 in top 2 on the dirt.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 BABY BEAR'S SOUP</u> He is proving himself to be game. He has 6 wins in 23 career starts and is 5 for 18 on a fast dirt track. Was really finishing strong two back but ran out of time. The wide turn didn't help. BARRON 5-2 1 TEMPLE KNIGHTS 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 GETALOADOFTHIS</u> This is a bad race. The #7 Captain N. Barron will be a popular pick but with the blinkers off, he may not be as game. This one shown speed routing and tired late. If he goes 46.3 for the half here he might be right there w/ some route stamina to kick on in the lane.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 TEMPLE KNIGHTS</u> Trainer has had a good meet with 27 of 42 in the money here. This one is coming from up North after fading as the favorite in last on the GG synthetic. Might be able to catch a quick pace and see some tired foes late. <p>6 SANTA ANITA R6 61 MDN CLM 20K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>9 ROCKANDAHARDPLACE 5-1 2 SOONER BETTER 7-2 7 NATIONS HOPE 5-1 1 JONATHANTOQUICK 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 9 ROCKANDAHARDPLACE</u> Not sure if the connections were trying to darken the form in last or just something different with this one. Blinkers were off in that start (back today) and turf. Gets Lasix for the first time (might have bled). Drops to the lowest level of his career. Late move.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 NATIONS HOPE</u> Not much speed in this race and this one was closer to the pace in last with blinkers on for the first time. Baze is a tremendous pace rider and is dangerous when there is not a clear cut pace flow. He normally picks the right spot. Use under in the superfecta.</p> <p>A) 2,9 B) 1,7 C) 3,4,5,6,8</p>	<p>7 SANTA ANITA R7 84 SWEET LIFE-G3 100K, 6.5F TURF</p> <p>6 GINGER NUT 5-2 2 THRIVING 8-5 3 SPLASHY KISSES 6-1 1 APACHE PRINCESS 5-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 GINGER NUT</u> While Sadler is 0 for 19 with Euro shippers, he was 2nd five times and beaten less than 2 lengths 8 times in the first US start. 5th out of last start came back to win a 300k stake at Doncaster at 33-1 over 19. 1981 HOL Turf Cup (G1 sprint) winner in the female family.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 SPLASHY KISSES</u> Made her first start on the turf in last. Was rank, steadied and never got comfortable in a pretty bad trip. Connections were high enough on her to try the G1 BC Juv Fillies 2 back. '01 BC Juv Fillies winner (Tempera) in the 2nd gen of female tree. Sharp workouts.</p> <p>A) 6 B) 1,2,3 C) 4,5</p>	<p>8 SANTA ANITA R8 66 SAN VICENTE-G2 200K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>2 COLISEUM 6-5 4 SPARKY VILLE 4-1 5 SAVAGERY 4-1 1 SYNTHESIS 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 COLISEUM</u> Gets the nod here based on the debut that was sensational. But he makes a very poor bet at odds of even money. He still has bad gate habits (cost him in last) and while the works are fast, they aren't Baffert-fast. Big upside and will dominate with clean break.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 SPARKY VILLE</u> Really like him here but you've got a trainer in Jeff Bonde winning at around 10% vs one who is winning 30% in spots like this. Such is the nature of racing. Didn't like how flat he went late two back but was sharp in the win 3 back. Love this rider move to Rosario.</p> <p>A) 2,4 B) 1,5 C) 3</p>	<p>9 SANTA ANITA R9 39 OPT CLM 40K, 6.5F TURF</p> <p>4 ANIMOSITY 12-1 8 SPECIAL PURPOSE 5-1 6 SPY RING 7-2 3 HELEN'S TIGER 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 ANIMOSITY</u> This kind of move wins often and run last as often. Route speed but hasn't been able to carry it. Cutback to a distance she won at in her debut. Had some excuses in the poor efforts and Rosario off Special Purpose is interesting (he has his choice around here).</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 SPECIAL PURPOSE</u> Was graded stakes placed in Europe. Bled 3 back and was likely the reason she came to the US (Lasix). First start here came back in May and ran 2nd with a big late run.
