<p>1 SANTA ANITA R1 66 CLM 20K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>4 LEAD STAR 3-1 1 RUNNINGWSCISSORS 9-5 5 GLYBER 5-2 2 STAY IN YO LANE 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 LEAD STAR</u> Appears to want the dirt. Didn't run well in either of his two turf starts. Won the last 2 times he was on the dirt and both of those came here at SA. Bobbled at the start four back in a tough MSW (winner ran 6th of 13 in the BC Juv). Kent has a win with him 3 back.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 GLEYBER</u> Came off the turf two back and won at 6-1 with Bejarano up. He drew the 10 post and was wide but got up for the win. Notice the field was spread out behind him. Last was not his best and willing to look past it. He's going to stalk the pace in midpack in here.</p> <p>A) 1,4 B) 2,5 C) 3</p>	<p>2 SANTA ANITA R2 46 CLM 35K, 1M TURF</p> <p>7 SPEAKERS 7-2 4 MYBLUEBELL 4-1 5 MONGOLIAN WINDOW 3-1 2 WIND TARTARE 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 SPEAKERS</u> Trainer has had a strong start to the meet with 3 wins already. This one was traveling well in last but lacked room late in the race and it cost her better. She really didn't get a chance to run the entire stretch until last 100 yards. Prat stays up. Will finish strong.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 MYBLUEBELL</u> Trainer and rider have teamed up for a lot of wins. Finally drops this one into claiming after some mediocre efforts vs allowance foes. Blinkers were added in last but they are removed right away after a poor effort. Will gain early position. Is at the right level.</p> <p>A) 7 B) 2,3,4,5 C) 1,6</p>	<p>3 SANTA ANITA R3 51 CLM 16K, 1M 1/16 DIRT</p> <p>4 AWARD IT 7-2 2 MISTRESSOFTHENIGHT 9-5 5 IPRAY 8-1 3 ROAD TEST 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 AWARD IT</u> Not sure she wants the turf. She's 2 for 5 on the main track and has 3 wins in 4 starts at the distance. Willing to excuse last on the wet surface. 6YO mare should be finishing in this spot. Gets the weight break with the apprentice rider up. Gets a good trip today.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 IPRAY</u> She's run well on this track. Claimed from the race two back and did very little in the common race last out. That race was on a wet track so she deserves another look on a dry surface. She can run on late and will be a danger if the pace develops up front.</p> <p>A) 2,4 B) 3,5 C) 1,6</p>	<p>4 SANTA ANITA R4 72 MSW 55K, 6.5F TURF</p> <p>3 PERSEPOLIS 3-1 2 MAGICAL GRAY 5-2 7 FICANAS 6-1 8 STORMING LADY 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 PERSEPOLIS</u> 3rd dam is dam of Galileo (\$2.2M winner and supersire) and Sea The Stars (\$6.8M winner won 6 1's including 2009 Arc De Triomphe). Mandella has had him for two months. He's out of a key race (3 next out winners). She's eligible to be a runner. Working very nicely.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 FICANAS</u> Have to think she is better than she ran in her last start. She was 4-1 in a race where the winner went off favored at 5-2. Fact she ran so poorly and didn't come back until 9 months later says last can be overlooked. 50-1 place vs 14 foes in debut. Sharp drills.</p> <p>A) 3 B) 2,7 C) 6,8</p>
<p>5 SANTA ANITA R5 68 OPT CLM 57K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>4 LIEUTENANT DAN 6-5 2 OCCAM'S RAZOR 7-2 5 OUR SILVER OAK 9-5 3 SAYIN GRACE 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 4 LIEUTENANT DAN</u> Could turn out to be a good one. This owner has had some real runners. This one took a lot of money in the debut and ran ok on the quirky LRC surface. He was sensational in the win over a decent field. Trainer 21 of 40 (53%) in top 3 at SA, last out maiden winner.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 SAYIN GRACE</u> Hasn't been on a dirt track yet as he's had 4 runs on the grass and 2 on the synthetic at Arlington Park. He's been working sharp on the dirt here for quite a well for trainer Eoin Harty. Prat was up for a strong effort 2 back when 5th by 2 after a slow start on turf.</p> <p>A) 2,4,5 B) 3 C) 1</p>	<p>6 SANTA ANITA R6 53 CLM 30K, 1M TURF</p> <p>1 OFFSHORE 5-2 4 ICE KAT 9-2 3 WILSHIRE DUDE 7-2 7 VAN CORTLANDT 9-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 OFFSHORE</u> Impressive in the win last time out. He was breaking from the 9 post, went wide in the move to the lead and just drew off running into a fast pace. Considered a stakes type for previous connections. Prat had choice for Baltas' two horses. Saves ground today.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 ICE KAT</u> Hasn't had a clean trip in a while and it may be the reason that Baltas has Rosario here and Prat on the top choice. Could use a fast pace given his late running style. Baltas is over 21% with layoffs of this type. Has been working a while. Check tote for more clues.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 3,4,6,7,8 C) 2,5</p>	<p>7 SANTA ANITA R7 60 OPT CLM 80K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>5 SHIVERMETIMBERS 6-1 4 EDWARDS GOING LEFT 3-1 3 CALEXMAN 7-2 2 AX MAN 2-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 SHIVERMETIMBERS</u> Proven himself to be a good runner. Was 2nd to Triple Crown winner Justify 8 starts back in the first race with blinkers on. Will get the run of the race in here as there will be 2 that will go out head to head (both are need-the-lead types). Exits a strong Grade 2 turf race.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 EDWARDS GOING LEFT</u> Appears to be one of the main closers in the race. The pace could produce a meltdown if the top two speed types go at it early. Ran 2nd to City of Light in the '17 Grade 1 Malibu. He's picked up checks in four Grade 1 races for Sadler. Gets Rosario and blinkers today.</p> <p>A) 2,3,4,5 B) 1,6 C)</p>	<p>8 SANTA ANITA R8 61 MSW 55K, 1M TURF</p> <p>10 MOBOU 5-2 1 POSTERIZE 8-1 2 SEA OF LIBERTY 7-2 5 BRIX 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 10 MOBOU</u> Showed he liked the grass with two decent efforts in the last two. Went to the lead last out on a good turf and tired late. Breeding says turf should be fine. 1980 Grade 1 Cdn International winner, Great Neck, is deep in the female tree. Expensive Cal-bred colt.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 POSTERIZE</u> Patient trainer brought him back off a bit of a layoff in last and faced a buzzsaw who ran and hid from them. He was a 2nd timer for Miyadi who was bet in the debut when he was 3rd at LRC. 8th and 7th (both far back) ran 1st and 2nd in a MSW in their next start.</p> <p>A) 1,2,10 B) 5,6 C) 4,7,8</p>
