She'll be up with the pace here and will get a great trip.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 TODOS SANTOS</u></p> <p>Deep closer is going to get a fast pace here and she'll need it. The last time she won it came here coming from far back when the pace fell apart. Faced too tough in the two and three back starts. Off slow in last and didn't make up enough ground. Found some traffic trouble but wasn't far behind the choice. Was unlucky to lose in the race last out. Lat was Savagery by 18 lengths but returned to crush field that included #3 Spin Lightning. Very dangerous when routers with speed cut back to 6.5F.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 SPIN LIGHTNING</u></p> <p>Hasn't been on a fast dirt track since the 2nd start when 5th in the Del Mar Futurity at 21-1. Rosario up in last and he finished well despite the track favoring early speed. His debut was strong coming off the pace from the 10 post.
