<p>1 SANTA ANITA R1 (1:00) 40 CLM 16K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>6 UPPER ROOM 3-1 1 ODYSSEY EXPLORER 8-1 8 OH MAN 7-2 7 TANIKO 5-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 UPPER ROOM</u></p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 ODYSSEY EXPLORER</u> A) 1,6,8 B) 2,7 C) 3,4</p>	<p>3 SANTA ANITA R3 (2:12) 77 OPT CLM 50K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>2 LIEUTENANT DAN 8-5 1 DADDY JONES 6-1 4 RICKEY B 7-2 5 I BELONG TO BECKY 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 LIEUTENANT DAN</u> Went off at 3-5 on the stretchout to 1M most recently. He tired rather quickly despite the slow fractions. The maiden win two back in 1:09.2 would be enough to beat these. Good to see Franco stay aboard and the two slow works indicate readiness. Presses the pace.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 DADDY JONES</u> Blinkers and turf two back but it produced his worst start to date. Blinkers were taken off in last and moved to the dirt. He finished well for 4th beaten less than 2 lengths at long odds. Finished well in all of his starts at GG including a 2 length defeat in a 64k stakes.</p> <p>A) 1,2 B) 4 C) 5</p>	<p>4 SANTA ANITA R4 (2:46) 33 CLM 25K, 1M 1/8 TURF</p> <p>3 COMES THE DREAM 4-1 4 TWENTYTWENTYVISION 2-1 2 ORIGINAL INTENT 12-1 1 BUCKSTOPPER KIT 3-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 COMES THE DREAM</u> Think he might be closer to the pace today than he normally has been. Came on for a 28-1 runner-up finish to a main player in this race last out. Has taken virtually zero action at the windows of late but continues to fire. 9Y0 is 4 for 5 in the top 3 on the main track.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 ORIGINAL INTENT</u> Strong win first off the claim in last. While he was facing weaker company, he won nicely and the race has come back pretty decently for that level (2 next out winners, 6 have run in the money). Notice his maiden win came in off-the-turf wet fast crushing a year ago.</p> <p>A) 2,3,4 B) 1,5 C) 6,7</p>	<p>5 SANTA ANITA R5 (3:20) 68 TIZNOW 100K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>1 KING ABNER 2-1 4 EDWARDS GOING LEFT 8-5 5 SHADES OF VICTORY 15-1 3 SURFING STAR 9-5</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 KING ABNER</u> Tried the turf in the last two and he ran well but might be a tad better on the dirt. Is back on the dirt in here, draws the rail and should be in the perfect stalking position and able to save ground. Baze was a nose away from being 3 for 3 aboard him. He's 2 for 2 at 1M.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 SHADES OF VICTORY</u> Upset winner at 80-1 in the E Johnston back in Sep at LRC. He beat Edwards Going Left in that win. Went to TUP and added blinkers in last but they come off here. Worth noting his last win was that 80-1 upset, the last time he went 1M. <p>2 SANTA ANITA R2 (1:38) 58 MDN CLM 50K, 5F TURF</p> <p>5 GEMAGINE 2-1 6 DERBY LUCK 20-1 3 LA PURISSIMA 4-1 1 APPOLINA 5-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 GEMAGINE</u></p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 DERBY LUCK</u> A) 5 B) 3,6 C) 1,7</p>	<p>6 SANTA ANITA R6 (3:51) 61 CLM 16K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>5 STURDY ONE 2-1 6 CINNAMON TWIST 6-1 3 SCATHING 7-2 2 CHRISTY JACKSON 5-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 STURDY ONE</u> Last two starts for this trainer produced 2nd at 25k here back in Dec and then a runaway win last out with Franco up over a foe in this race. That makes her 8 for 9 in the exacta at Santa Anita (5 wins). Like the fact that she was able to press last out and draw off late.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 6 CINNAMON TWIST</u> Had back to back wins and was claimed in the last start (in May) before the layoff. Was attempted to be claimed on the comeback two back but was a vet voided situation. She returned sharp when second to the top pick in last. Banking on that coming back strong.</p> <p>A) 5 B) 2,3,6 C) 1,4</p>	<p>7 SANTA ANITA R7 (4:21) 37 OPT CLM 40K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>1 LEROY 15-1 9 PADDOCK PICK 6-1 3 MAKE IT A TRIPLE 12-1 7 COIL ME HOME 4-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 LEROY</u> Looks like an improving sort. Comes out of a nice win which was a career best effort off the pace. Might be a few in here who will go out to try to control the pace. Could get the needed pace. Track last out was favoring speed. Scrapes paint from the inside draw.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 MAKE IT A TRIPLE</u> Keep looking back at this one despite poor finishes in the last two starts. The 5th three back from the 12 post was very good. He has blinkers added after 5 starts without them. That was a pretty good field he faced at TUP in the Gold Cup. Race sets up for a longshot.</p> <p>A) 1,3,7,9 B) 8 C) 4,5</p>	<p>8 SANTA ANITA R8 (4:51) 62 OPT CLM 40K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>5 ROUTE SIX SIX 5-1 2 CALIFORNIA JOURNEY 6-1 4 SOLOMINI 5-2 3 BEAUMARCHAI 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 ROUTE SIX SIX</u> Something happened in the start two back that put him on the shelf for 9 months. Did come back with a strong run to win. Notice the runner-up was 7 clear of third. 4th place finisher three back (Draft Pick) won the G3 Affirmed (he beat Solomini) two starts later.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 CALIFORNIA JOURNEY</u> Hollendorfer runner was sharp in the win in last start. The 3rd place finisher won back in an allowance vs Cal-breds (87 Beyer). Seems to have handled the move to the dirt nicely. Clockers indicate he's looked good in those workouts since the win. Should be finishing.</p> <p>A) 2,4,5 B) 3,6 C) 7</p>	<p>9 SANTA ANITA R9 (5:21) 81 MDN CLM 30K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>5 SEASIDE DANCER 3-1 2 TRUE VALIDITY 5-2 4 OUT OF CONTROL 4-1 6 BELLTOWN BELLE 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 5 SEASIDE DANCER</u> Shipper from FG/CD where she was facing a lot better company in the MSW races there. Beat 7 runners in her debut and many from there have fired in MSW. Desormeaux ran 2nd with only runner for this owner (just last week) at 9-2 with a troubled trip. Stands out.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 OUT OF CONTROL</u> Hard to know what, if anything, this filly has. She was 5-2 in the debut but that was likely a product of how well Hofmans was doing with first timers. Didn't get a good trip that day so gets another look here.
